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At the outset, the Vice Chancellor welcomed all the members present and thanked them for being present for the meeting. After this he requested the Registrar to carry on with the proceedings of the meeting as per agenda.

Item No. AC 7.1: (a) To confirm the minutes of the Sixth Meeting of Academic Council held on 28 May 2013.

(b) Action taken on the Minutes of the Sixth Meeting.

The members, after a brief discussion, confirmed the minutes of sixth meeting of Academic Council held on 28 May, 2013 and also the action taken report on the same. Mentoring Program was discussed and it was decided that a workshop will be planned in December / January 2014.

Item No. AC 7.2: To review Admission status so far.

The matter was discussed in details and respective Directors / Dy. Directors and HOIs briefed the members about the number of students enrolled in the new programs and the current status. It was heartening to note that quite a reasonable number of students have enrolled for the recently introduced programs like Amity School of Hospitality (ASH), Amity School of Liberal Arts & Foreign Languages (ASLA) and Amity Institute of Design (AID) etc.

Item No. AC 7.3: To review the status of new Academic Programs introduced during 2013-14 session.

The word lateral was withdrawn from the agenda due to its mistaken inclusion.

The agenda was discussed at length as this was concerning all the Institutions / Schools / Departments. Prof B P Singh recommended that it is advisable to introduce a research program on Laser Technology rather than as an academic course. The issue about setting up a research based center including Laser, Nano Technology etc. which had been discussed earlier, was re-discussed and it was decided that the same (Advanced Centre for Science & Technology) will be taken forward in due courses.

Item No. AC 7.4: To recommend the Result of the Examination for Ex-post-facto Approval.

While reviewing the various activities included in conduct of the examination, it was pointed out that timely declaration of result is important.

On the issue of delay due to the non submission of marks by the faculty, it was felt that concerned Director's will have to take appropriate action on the matter and for future, respective Director's involvement would be appreciated.



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It was also suggested that in the no dues certificate, a column must be created to be signed by the COE at the time of relieving any faculty on resignation / transfer etc. to confirm that all marks / score cards have been submitted.

Item No. AC 7.5: To review status of Patent & Research Activities Programs. Prof. SMP Khurana & Prof. AK Raghav to brief the members.

Prof. BP Singh suggested that this agenda item need not be included for discussion, but can be a reporting item, in order to avoid any complication in future. It was resolved that the Faculty Development Program for younger faculty will be strengthened.

Item No. AC 7.6: To review the current status of Scholarships

Registrar briefed members about the current status of scholarship.

Item No. AC 7.7: To review the status of Campus Placement of B.Tech Students. Dy. Director (CRC) to brief the members.

This was also proposed for deletion from Agenda Points as it is not directly concerned to Academic Council.

Item No. AC 7.8: Any other Agenda item with permission of the Chair.

Approval of new Programmes, Schools and Institutes for the Academic Session 2014-15.

Syllabi Revision for Academic Session 2014-15 is attached as per Appx 'D'

The Member Secretary read out the a/m appendices and after some discussions and deliberations the council accorded in principle approval for the same.

The Pro Vice Chancellor suggested that all necessary and relevant details must be worked out before any new program is projected / introduced by any Institution / School in future. This will include cost, expected student intake, availability of laboratories and availability of faculties. The Dy. Vice Chancellor remarked that space infrastructure must also be taken into account, as that could be a serious issue for next year.

Maj Gen (Retd.) VK Narang had requested for inclusion of certain agenda items related to Amity School of Engineering & Technology (ASET). The point that was accepted to be introduced was specialization in M.Tech Program for which he was requested to submit relevant details.



Mr Mehta proposed a one year program of two semesters in Broadcast Equipment Maintenance. The Pro Vice Chancellor suggested that Dy Director ASCO and Mr Mehta will do more research on this and submit report for final discussion. He was also advised by the Vice Chancellor to submit the entire project for approval by the Academic Council through PVC and VC.

Prof. Dube mentioned that an Integrated Program in M.Sc. Economics for 5 years duration may be considered in the next meeting.

The Council decided to include "Stem Cell and Gene Therapy" to be introduced as an optional subject in Amity Institute of Biotechnology - Masters Programs (M.Sc / M.Tech).

A proposal was made by Dr. J R Luthra for introduction of a new 5 years Integrated Program in Environmental Science & Management in ASEES. He was requested to submit the relevant details for discussion and approval.

After a vote of thanks to the chair, the meeting was declared closed.

In addition, Maj Gen. B.S Suhag, Dy VC, Dr Sanjay Jha, Dr M.L.Bansal, COE were invited to attend the meeting as special invitees.

At the outset Prof P.B. Sharma, Chairperson extended a very hearty welcome to the members. He addressed the members to apprise them of the achievements of the University since its last meeting as also the road ahead in future. His address included the following salient points:

Brief Report on Recent Initiatives at AUG

- A Centre of Excellence and Innovation in Biotechnology has been transferred to AUG from JNU by DBT, Govt of India with an outlay of Rs 2 Crores to Dr Rajendra Prasad, Director AIB based on his track record in Research and Innovations in Biological Sciences. This is a major breakthrough for AUG for Scientific Research and Innovation.



- An Interdisciplinary R&D Project on “Development of Prototype Chromium Filtration System Using Silica Based Chemibiosorbent matrix for Potable Water in Rural areas” has been submitted to DST for Rs 42 Lacs in June 2015. Principal Investigator: Dr Biswarup Sen of Biotechnology Co-PIs: Dr Kushagra Rajendra of ASEES and Dr Seema Pathak and Rakesh Kumar of ASAS. This is in response to Water Technology Initiative of DST as informed by Prof. Selvamurthy, President ,ASTIF
- A Consultancy Project for Contract Research on “Evaluation of The Biological activity of Heparin Attached to Hollow Fiber Memberane” has been submitted by Dr Anurag Sharma and Dr Seema Pathak to M/S Applied Membrane Technologies Inc., Minnosota, USA for Rs 5 lacs, June 2015

The Vice Chancellor / Chairperson informed the Hon'ble members of the Academic Council that around fifty new faculty members have joined the Amity University, Haryana; notably among them are:

Dr Rajendra Prasad, former Professor and Rector , Jawaharlal Nehru University, renowned Scientist and Sr Vice president INSA as Director of AIB.

Dr Brijesh Kumar, formerly at National University of Singapore as Professor and Head, Centre of Excellence in Nano Science & Technology in ASAS.

Dr Burra L. Prasad, Ph.D. from IISc, Bangalore as Professor in AIB.

Dr Anek Pal Gupta, Former Professor, Polymer Science & Technology at Delhi Technological University as Professor and Head, Centre of Excellence in Polymer Science and Technology in ASAS.

Dr Sanjay K Jha as Professor of Linguistics and Director ASLA.

Dr R.K. Thakur as Associate Professor and Dy Director, ASAS.

Dr Archana Shukla as Professor and Director, AIBAS.

The Chairperson also emphasized on the following ideas and requested the members present (All HOIs / HODs) to actively look into the following aspects for betterment of the University:

- Submission of More research projects by the faculty.
- Promotion of quality innovation and research to be encouraged.
- Creation of interest and motivate the faculty is required and HOIs to play an active role.
- Participation in Conference /seminar is to be encouraged.
- HOIs to identify Five (5) good projects in which higher level of innovation has been done
- Faculty have to be more enthusiastic and HOIs/HODs to create the enthusiasm in them by encouraging to be more involved in research and publication.
- HOIs to conduct a reality check on the research publications before submission.
- HOIS must have regular dialogue with the Faculty as also students.
- All Faculty must start feeling excited about improved performance and research.
- Internationalization have to be extended through more activities.

Following the address by the Chairperson, the Council took up the agenda items:

Item No 10.1: a)To Confirm the minutes of the Ninth Meeting of Academic Council held on October 28, 2014 b) Action taken on the minutes of the Ninth Meeting.

The Minutes of the Ninth meeting of Academic Council & Action taken report were confirmed by the Council. At this point of time the Chairperson suggested that the following senior officials may be invited



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for the meeting of the Academic Council because of their expertise which can be shared for dissemination in the interest of the University:

Item No 10.2: Report on the Status of Admission for session 2015-16

Dr Vikas Madhukar, Director (Admission) presented the basic data in connection with the current admission status as follows:

- 12 admission tests conducted sofar.
- 13th admission test is scheduled on August 17.
- 5846 applications were received (5811 in 2014).
- 3286 were selected as on date.
- 1408 students have taken admission so far (1544 in 2014).
- Except three schools where the percentage of students joining is deficient, other Institutes / schools have done well.

The Chairperson suggested that from the academic session of 2016-17 a final date may be decided by which date all admission forms may be submitted and the entrance test may be scheduled on a particular day after scrutiny of the application is completed. General Discussion and Personal Interaction can follow. He was also of the opinion that HOIs must be actively involved in admission process and devote enough time for this purpose. He also emphasized that the functioning of CRC is much below average and as a result the placement of the students is getting affected. He suggested that HOIs should get seriously involved with the placement activities of CRC also for better representation and placement.

Dr Padmakali Banerjee, Pro Vice Chancellor suggested that the admission of Amity Business School must be done before the normal schedule and she suggested December/January as the prime time for ABS admission. She requested all the HOIs / HODs to involve themselves in marketing and admission procedures more actively and depute the faculty to visit all the state capitals alongwith marketing personnel for spreading increased awareness about Amity University, Haryana among prospective students.

The Chairperson also informed that he had held a meeting with senior officials of Prasar Bharti for linking up their National Academies and all Amity Institutions in the country for mutual benefit.

Some members expressed their concern about the time gap between the date of Entrance Test and the declaration of results which cause many students to take up admission in other Universities/Institutes. They pointed out that an impression is gaining ground that admission is always available as the University doors are always open. This impression must be done away with and hence the entire schedule of admission process must be specific and adhered to strictly. The Council members agreed to these points and requested Director (Admissions) to consider the same seriously.



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Item No 10.3: Update on Syllabi of Programs to be introduced in 2015-16

After a brief discussion, the Member Secretary informed the Council that the detailed syllabi which were deliberated during the 9th Academic Council meeting have been submitted to the authorities at DGHE office.

Item No 10.4: To review the result of Examination 2014-15.

The Controller of Examinations made a brief power point presentation to the members and the general observation was that the results of most of the Institutes /schools was not encouraging. The Chairperson expressed his concern over this matter. Most of the members including the Pro Vice Chancellor felt that this has happened because of lack of internal monitoring of internal marks and not keeping a tab on the progress of each student periodically.

The Chairperson mentioned that the following three components need to be monitored by the HOIs/HOD to provide better result:

- Students Attendance in the class
- Number of classes held as per calendar
- Internal Assessment
- Analysis of result by the HOIs regularly.

The Members felt that the results must certainly not be less than 80% to 90% in Professional courses and other subjects must have a progress of 70% to 80%. However, Prof SMP Khurana was of the opinion that overall results are bad due to the student's lack of interest in attending value added courses, not attending the classes, not interested in exams and thus the overall results look poor.

Item no 10.5: Recommendation of Number of Teachers to be appointed

The Registrar mentioned to the members that as per the list 55 positions of Faculty were to be recruited across the schools and that the major portion of the recruitment has been completed. Some members mentioned that some additional faculty will now be required. The Chairperson requested them to send their requirement to HR for doing the needful, The appointment of 55 faculty for 2015-16 was approved.

Item no 10.6: Report of Deputy Dean, Academic on academic activity of the Academic Session 2014-15 and for AS 2015-16.

Dr Bhavana Adhikari, the Deputy Dean, Academics circulated a report to the Chairperson and other members. She also briefly mentioned the salient features of the report which included:

- AUG at a Glance.
- Faculty of Studies & List of Schools for the Academic Session 2016-16 attached as Appx 'A'.
- New programs introduced for the Academic Session 2015-16 attached as Appx 'B'.
- List of Programmes & Schools for Academic Session 2015-16 attached as Appx 'C'.



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- Computer Forensics and Cyber Security.
- Military Training Foundation.
- Technology Enhancement.
- Skill Development Program.
- Recent Major Events.

The Pro Vice Chancellor mentioned that the accreditation process by CRISIL was conducted recently which is a prestigious accreditation agency in the country and that this will also add to the academic excellence. The Director, AIB & AISHE mentioned that excellence must be justified and to do so visibility, recognition and address to the cause of Academic dedication of faculty and staff are to be total. The Chairperson suggested the following necessities for achieving excellence:

- Address to the cause of Academic Excellence.
- Address to the Global Cause.
- Assessment and Integration.
- Industry Readiness.
- Process of assessment.
- Achieving global eminence through Research, Innovation and Relevance.

At this stage, the Director, AIB remarked that for each Institution / school funds for research should be allocated every year. No activity can take place if basic funding is not made available for research. The Chairperson agreed to this suggestion and agreed to take it up further with the competent authority.

Item No 10.7: To ratify the Academic Calendar for the Academic session 2015-16

The Academic calendar for Odd & Even semesters for the academic Year 2015-16 was approved by the Council

Item No 10.8: To Report on the achievements, ranking, recognition and accreditation awarded to AUH

The Chairperson remarked that the list is quite impressive. Members congratulated Prof Khurana for having been awarded Sir J.C. Bose Memorial Medal by the Hon'ble Prime Minister for his exemplary contribution to the area of Plant Pathology.

The Dy. Dean Academic added that Amity University, Haryana has also signed a number of MOUs on Skill sectors as also with their principal NSDC, which should find a mention in this list. The members noted the remark with appreciation.

Item No 10.9: Annual Progress Report

The Chairperson remarked that the Annual report was prepared in a hurry and the same needs to be redrafted with more inputs as per following:



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- Vision and Mission of the University.
- Institute /school activities.
- Details of ongoing academic programs.
- List of Publications.
- Academic Achievement.
- New Faculty Joined.
- Achievements / awards.
- Research activities.
- Examination results.
- Placement details.
- MOUs /Accreditations.

Item No 10.10: To consider and approve induction of a new Course " Skill Enhancement Course" in the model framework of various Program groups of the existing and New Batches.

The Chairperson remarked that during the meeting of Executive Council of AUUP,NOIDA, he chanced upon this item in the agenda and advised the Registrar to include it in the agenda as he found the same very relevant.

The Dy Dean, Academics informed the members that skill based courses are already included in the Flexi credit system under track items. The Chairperson suggested that the details of such programs may be forwarded to the Secretary, Academic Council.

Item No 11.11: To Formulate additional Guidelines

The Chairperson informed that this item was also included from the agenda item of the Executive Council meeting of the AUUP. He informed the members that he has already constituted two committees to prepare relevant guidelines under two broad categories of Academic (headed by the Pro Vice Chancellor) and Administrative (headed by the Dy. Vice Chancellor).



The Pro Vice Chancellor mentioned that she will be able to discuss the detailed guidelines under her purview only during the next Academic Council meeting. Dy Vice Chancellor informed that he had already held the first meeting of the committee and assigned members of the committee to prepare the first draft of the Guidelines on or before August 31. Once the same is finalized (expected by Mid-September), he will submit the same to the Vice Chancellor, AUH.

Item No 10.12: Any other item with the permission of the Chair

The Dy Director, ABS informed that there are some marks improvement cases in ABS, which can be categorized as borderline and they want another opportunity to appear for a supplementary examination for improving their marks.

The Chairperson felt that our Examination policy needs amendment on certain provisions and rectify the anomaly. The matter needs to be looked into by the COE and other senior officials.


The Registrar placed an application received from three pass out students of MAE dept. (received through Dr A.K. Raghav) stating that they missed out on an employment opportunity as the concerned PSU wanted graduates from mechanical Engineering department and not from MAE dept.

The matter was discussed at length. Members expressed their anguish over the statement of the pass out students. Many members voiced their concern and after due deliberation, the Academic Council passed the following resolution:

“ The Academic Council of Amity University Haryana in its tenth meeting resolved that the existing Academic program namely” Mechanical & Automation Engineering” should be reclassified as “Mechanical Engineering” as the same nomenclature of Mechanical Engineering is used by all leading Technological Institutes and Universities like IITs.

Since it has been brought to the notice of the Academic Council that students have been denied employment because of the difference in nomenclature alone, the Council unanimously decided to adopt this resolution effective from the academic session 2015-16 and the students of this batch will be awarded Degree in Mechanical Engineering alone”

There being no other points for discussion, the meeting was declared closed after exchanging thanks to and from the chair.

At the outset the Chairperson welcomed all the members present and especially extended a warm welcome to Dr Sunil Saran for being present in the meeting. He then advised the Registrar to take up the agenda items for discussion.

Item No AC 11.1: To induct four members in the Academic Council against vacancies arising out of resignation of the former members/ induction of new members.

The Registrar sought the permission of the Academic Council to induct the following new members to the Academic Council:

He also mentioned about the resignation submitted by Prof S.Arul, Former Dean Faculty of Arts. The Council unanimously agreed to admit the above four new members to the Academic Council and noted the resignation of Prof Arul.

Item No 11.2:

a) To confirm the minutes of the Tenth meeting of the Academic Council held on August 12, 2015

b) Action taken on the minutes of the Tenth meeting.

The members while approving the item, also discussed the following items:

Prof Rajendra Prasad briefed the members about the status of the Annual Report. Dy Vice Chancellor informed that by February 15, 2016, the final draft of the Annual Report would be submitted to the Vice Chancellor.

The Chairperson informed that Hon'ble Chancellor has approved the recommendation of the Academic Council made in its last meeting that "the Mechanical and Automation Engineering course (MAE) will be now re-designated as Mechanical Engineering (ME).Registrar was accordingly advised by the Council to issue the notification for the change of nomenclature from MAE to ME with immediate effect.



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Item No AC 11.3: To report on just concluded admission process in July 2015.

Director Admission made an oral presentation about the admission process in July 2015 and highlighted the relevant points which are important for the Admission session 2015. Some of the highlights are enumerated below:

Overall impression was that the admission scenario was brighter than the previous years. The Academic Council advised Director (Admissions) to sustain, if not improve this pace in coming years to enable us to achieve our yearly goal of admission.

One of the member pointed out that in the absence of a clear cut deadline for submission of the result for the qualifying examination, some students who have not cleared their qualifying examination / result of the same not submitted, continue to study in the M.Sc. program. It was decided that 30th September of each year will be the cutoff date for submission of the result of the qualifying examination failing which the provisional admission shall stand cancelled.

The Chairperson made a suggestion that the marketing team should be able to get more students through Education Fairs as quite a good number of Fairs are being attended by the team. He observed that although AUH has participated in 41 fairs, the number of students admitted through these fairs was too low. Director (Admissions) responded by saying that there is only one Amity Stall for all the Amity Universities and the stellar role is played by NOIDA. This is the reason that even with a good footfall the number of students taking admission is less.

Prof Rajendra Prasad suggested that the advertisements for admission should highlight the individual Institutions/schools of AUH so that the students are informed in detail about the salient features of the University as also the Institution concerned. This is expected to generate further interest among the students desirous of seeking admission at the University.

As this will be a part of University /Institution branding, the Pro Vice Chancellor commented that apart from external branding, some kind of internal branding will also be essential.

Prof Anek Pal Gupta suggested that PG / UG course on Mechatronics may be introduced from the coming session which was accepted by the council.



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The Pro Vice Chancellor mentioned that Pharma industries are also interested to set up centers at the campus. The Chairperson was of the opinion that this is welcome news but this can be done only after AUH has carried out some ground work.

The discussion continued regarding setting up of various Testing Centers at AUH campus to facilitate the institutional R&D activities and finally it was decided to establish the following Centers:

1. "Test House for Lighting". This has to be set up before the next Academic Council meeting. Prof Dudeja will be the Advisor. It will be mentored by Maj Gen V.K. Narang and coordinated by Dr Priti Singh.
2. "Fluid Power Systems Laboratory". The major activity of this laboratory will be to test & develop low horsepower pumps (Up to 1hp). Prof A.K. Raghav will steer this lab to establish and manufacture the pump.
3. "Food & Nutrition Testing Center". This center will be mentored by Maj Gen (Dr) Mahavir Singh and activities coordinated by Dr Luxita Sharma.

The Chairperson mentioned that through these laboratories and testing centers, we shall usher a renewed interest in research and innovation at the University and shall attract industrial consultancy.

Item No AC 11.4: To approve syllabi of B.Ed. and six other programs to be introduced in the academic session 2016-17.

The Pro Vice Chancellor briefed the Council about the current status of the B.Ed. program. She informed the Council that an expert team of NCTE will be visiting the University on February 2, 2016 in connection with according permission for launching the courses during the coming academic session.

She further informed the Council that:

1. The Registrar, AUH has already submitted a draft Syllabi and Curriculum details to DGHE on January 15, 2016. This will be updated and resent after more work is carried out on the same.
2. 8000 books have been procured and are expected to reach the campus soon for setting up the Library.
3. Infrastructure areas have been identified and will be spruced up in next two days.

She informed the Council that apart from B.Ed., six more programs have also been applied for in connection with the study of Education at AUH. This, she suggested, is a challenge for us to take



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up. The members appreciated the effort made in this direction and hoped that the AUH will succeed in this area also.

Post deliberation the council accorded in principle approval of the following appendices

- (a) List of Schools / Institutes for Academic Session 2016-17 - Appx 'A'.
- (b) List of New Programs to be introduced for the Academic Session 2016-17 - Appx 'B'.
- (c) List of Programmes & Schools for Academic Session 2016-17 - Appx 'C'.
- (d) Students Intake Academic Session 2015-16 - Appx "D".
- (e) Syllabi Revision for Academic Session 2016-17 - Appx 'E'.

All the concerned HOIS/HODS were informed to submit the syllabi, curriculum details and other relevant data to the Registrar & Dy Dean (Academics) by February 15 as the same needs to be submitted to the concerned authorities of Govt of Haryana at least three months in advance.

The Chairperson suggested that the course on M.Sc. (Engineering) and M.Sc. (Electronics) should be jointly operated by ASET & ASAS as interdisciplinary courses.

Item AC No 11.5: To review Academic activities till December 2015

The Deputy Dean (Academics) presented the report on the item. Detailed discussion was held by the members on the report especially regarding the credit system for open elective. A question was raised whether the minor degree for those students who have opted for open elective and became successful in the examination will be issued separately or incorporated in the main degree.

The Pro Vice Chancellor explained the nitty gritty of minor tracks of CBCS/Flexi system and mentioned that it is the choice of the students to choose the minor track. This flexibility makes it unique she explained.

The chairman intervened and suggested that Dy Dean (Academics) will verify our flexi system with the CBCS system of UGC and submit a report to the Vice Chancellor soon. Members suggested various alternatives and the Chairman ruled that it will be finalized only after Deputy Dean (Academics) submits her report.

The Chairman also requested the Council to authorize him to look into the matter of issuing Minor degree along with Major degree and take a decision on the same. The council accorded its approval to this request.



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At this point, Prof Rajendra Prasad mentioned that 28 Projects have already been submitted to various funding agencies and the same was applauded by all.

**Item No AC 11.6: Convocation related matters a) Approval of award of PG / UG degrees
b) Approval of award of Medals & Trophies.**

The Registrar informed the details about the 861 No of recipients eligible for degree and the number of students who have confirmed so far to attend the Convocation. The Council approved the list unanimously.

The Registrar then informed the members about the medals, trophies and citation to be awarded to the meritorious students (Total 124) at the Convocation. The council approved the award of Medals and trophies to 124 students.

The Council also approved the award of Shri Baljeet Shastri memorial award to 17 students. The Vice Chancellor suggested that Director, ASET suggests the name of the most meritorious student from ASET who would be awarded Smt Sushila Devi and Durgadas Agrawal award during the Convocation.

The Chairperson informed that the following eminent persons would be awarded D.Phil. / D.Sc. during the Convocation:

Item No AC.11.7: Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.



At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the members of the Council and briefed them about the preparations made so far for the ensuing convocation to be held on 4th February, 2017.

Prof P.B Sharma, The Chairman informed the members that Amity University, Haryana, under the visionary Guidance of our Founder President Dr Ashok K Chauhan and dynamic leadership of our Chancellor Dr Aseem Chauhan has earned recognition for its relentless pursuit of world quality education, research and innovation and also is one of the top Private Universities in India within a very short period.

The Chairman also advised all HOIs to motivate their faculty to make all out efforts to enhance their qualifications and improve their research profile by submitting quality papers for publication in reputed journals, applying for and getting sponsored research projects and applying for patents.

The Chairman also desired that all the HOIs should ensure that all the members of faculty in the institute should invariably register on Research Guide, Google Scholar and other such important research portals to watch their citations of publications. Every Faculty member must also take note of his H Index and also I Index and make conscious efforts to raise the bar of quality research each year.

The Chairman also requested all the HOIs to workout carefully the list of reputed journals that are recognized for their quality the world over and are reflected on portals such as Web of Science etc. They should regularly motivate the faculty to publish their research papers in such quality research journals.

After the opening remarks of the Chairman, the Agenda Items were Taken up by the Registrar for discussion:-

Item No. AC 13.1

(a) To confirm the minutes of Twelfth meeting of the Academic Council held on 02nd August, 2016.

After a brief discussion, the minutes of the twelfth meeting of the Academic Council held on 02nd August, 2016 and

(b) Action taken thereof were approved.

Item No. AC 13.2: Matters for Information/ Ratification.

The Registrar read out the matter for information and ratification by the Council about the various areas where milestones were achieved by the University as per following:

- Project Submitted: 59
- Project Approved: 13
- Courses Introduced During 2016: 09



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- Courses Deleted: Nil
- Total Cumulative Publications: 2147

Prof. Prasad mentioned that all publications must be indexed in some Indian or International Journals and also suggested that AUH must try to publish our own Journal where faculties can contribute. According to him, wherever the faculty has to pay for publishing their articles, they should be reimbursed at least 50% of cost subject to the article gaining reasonable impact. He also warned that authors (faculty) should also be careful before publishing their papers by making payment because many of these Journals are not genuine or recognized.

Prof Archana Shukla, Dean, Faculty of Arts mentioned that in the area of Psychology, even the top most Journals may not have much impact factor and this must be kept in mind while extending the cost reimbursement facility to the faculty.

Prof. J P Dudeja was apprehensive about the authenticity of online Journals which charges money for publishing papers.

The Chairman (Vice Chancellor) mentioned that there are basically three kinds of Journals which are published in the world:

- (i) Highly Reputed Journals
- ii) International Journals of repute
- iii) Indian Journals of repute

2) He emphasized that faculty must be motivated to register on portals of repute in their respective areas and start submitting papers for publication.

3) The Chairman also was also of the opinion that every School/Institution of AUH should make an endeavor to publish a Journal as soon as possible. At this point AMS, ASCO, ASLA and ABS confirmed that they are already publishing Journals from their respective Institutes. The Chairman also intimated that he would discuss the matter related to re-organization of space of various Schools/Institutes to enable all to work-in-cohesion and also engage in Inter-disciplinary research.

Item No. AC 13.3: To seek approval of following by Academic Council

They felt that if the results could be declared on the same evening and the students are informed immediately, we will be able to retain more students in all disciplines.

The Member Secretary read out the following appendices and post deliberation, the council accorded its approval. The same are as follows:-




