Minutes of Meeting

The Board of Studies meeting began with a brief introduction by Prof. Ashok Tiku. He thanked the members and the expert for finding out time to attend the meeting. He briefed the members present about the agenda of the meeting. He, thereafter, invited the external expert to present his views on the introduction of the minor track in Québec Studies and Korean Studies and also to present his view on the syllabus of the mentioned courses.

Minor track in Québec Studies and Korean Studies

Comments by Prof. Sushant Kr. Mishra (External Expert)

It is a great initiative to introduce Minor track in Québec Studies as the stream is not very common and Amity could be a pioneer to establish this inter-disciplinary course. More diplomatic interaction with the students should be aimed at. The faculties should try to bag some cross country exchange of students. It was suggested to introduce literature in 5th and 6th semester.

The Korean studies minor should aim at setting up no pre requisite for the course in each semester thus enabling the students to pick of the course in whichever semester they need.

The syllabi for both the minor tracks were approved by the Board of Studies.

Review of syllabus of following courses:

- 1. FL-German
- 2. FL-Spanish
- 3. FL-Russian
- 4. FL- Chinese

The syllabus for the foreign languages was reviewed and following changes were approved:

- 1. FL-German (UG): the new book "StartenWir (A1 & A2) has been introduced.
- 2. B.A.(H) German: Schritte International Neu (A1-B1) has been introduced as text book for written and Oral expression (Sem I to Sem VI) since the older edition of the book (Schritte International) is out of print.
- 3. FL-Chinese: *Professional Handbook for Learning Chinese vol* I and Vol II introduced as reference book for UG and PG level.
- 4. FL-Russian: Essential Russianhas been introduced as the reference material for UG and PG level.
- 5. FL-Spanish: EnAccion: Cuaderno de Actividades (A1) has been added as reference book in addition to the main text book at UG and PG level.
- 6. The App based learning for all the foreign languages (German, Spanish, Russian and Chinese) were approved.

With this the deliberations on the syllabi of various programmes came to an end and it was recorded that the syllabi of the Minor tracks (Quebec Studies and Korean studies) and FL (German, Russian, Spanish and Chinese), B.A. (hons.) German was approved to be implemented by 2018-2019 academic year by the BOS.
