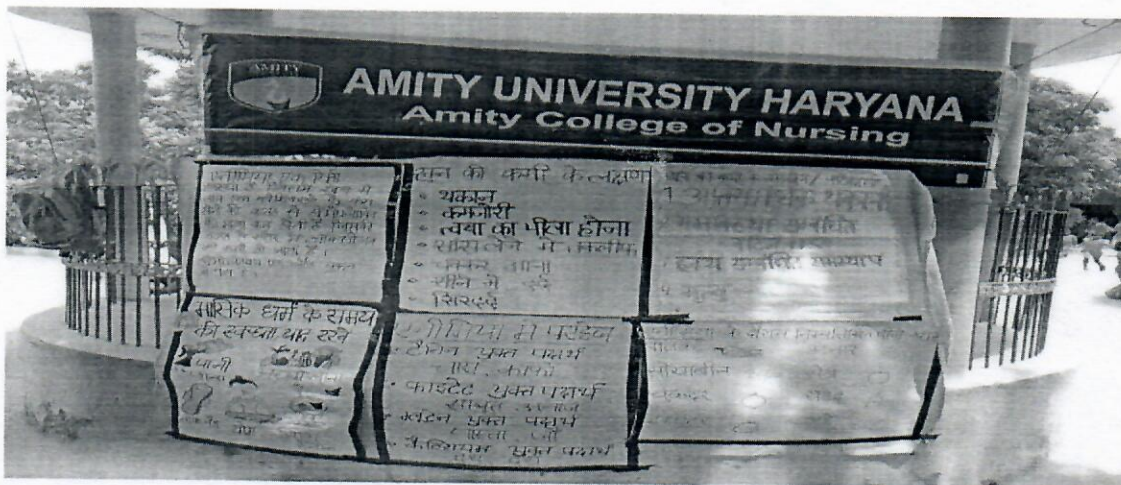

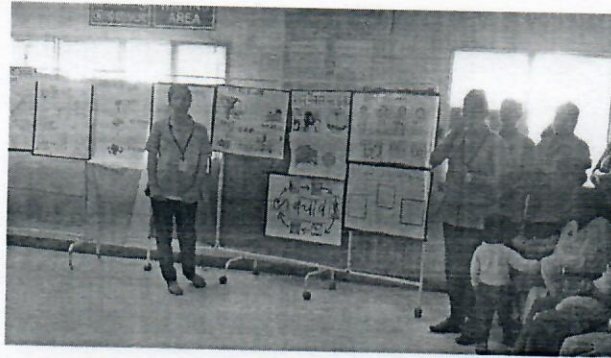

World Polio Day in the current year: October 24, 2016. This observance was established by nongovernmental organization Rotary International in order to commemorate the birth of Jonas Salk, the developer of a vaccine against polio. The Theme is **One Day. One Focus: Ending Polio**. The Global Polio Eradication Initiative, launched by the World Health Organization (WHO) to vaccinate every child without exception with the anti-polio vaccine, is considered one of the biggest health partnerships between the public and private sectors which managed to reduce polio incidence by 99%.

On this occasion BSc (H) Nursing III Sem students of Amity College of nursing were conducted a huge Rally and Mass awareness programme (Role play) on 27th October 2016 regarding Poliomyelitis and its vaccination at Bhangrola, Gurgaon under the Supervision of Mr. Naveena J H, Asst. Professor, Department of Community Health Nursing, Amity College of Nursing. 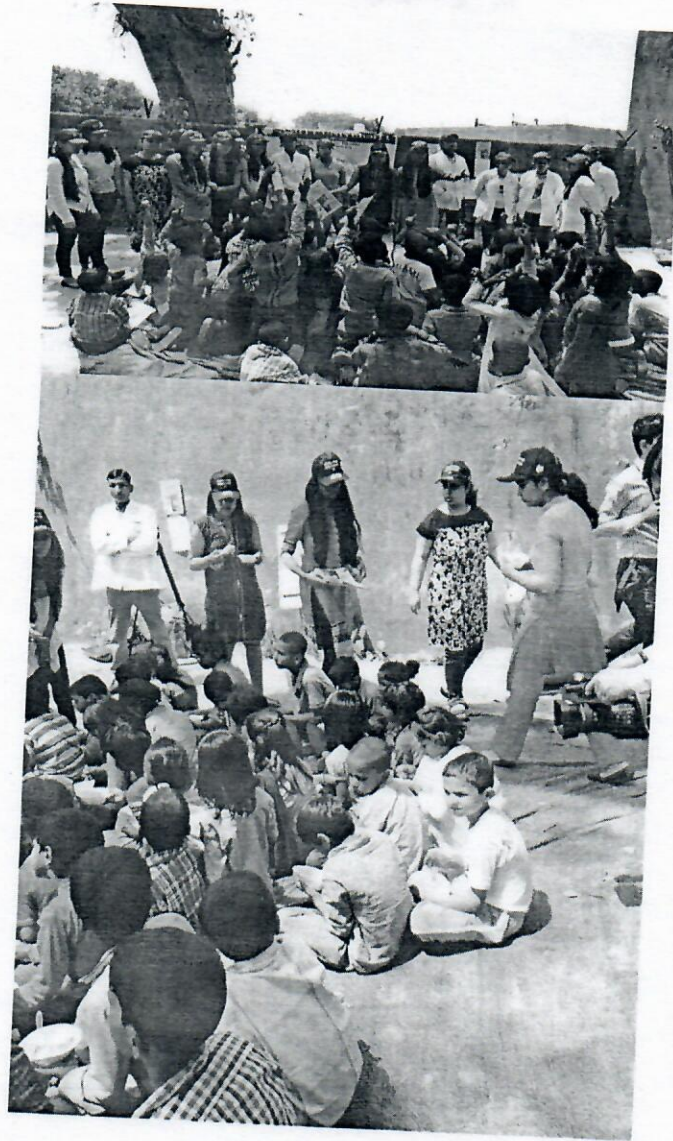

Outcome of the activity:

This community visit was organized on 7th April 2015 by department of Dietetics and Applied nutrition involving faculties Dr. Luxita Sharma and Ms Richa Singh and students of BDAN 2nd & 4th semester and MDAN 2nd semester. It was the third community visit for the students. This time awareness campaign was organized to celebrate World Health Day with the theme 'Farm to Fork'. Students gave nutrition education to villagers and prepared and served nutritious "Bhelpuri" to them. The villagers and school children came to know about health and hygiene and importance of eating healthy food.

Nutrition intervention can be defined as any type of addition or intervention for pregnant women to improve their anemic status. The nutritional educational intervention was developed based on results of the pre tests. The subjects were educated about nutrition and the function of each food groups in their body. They were motivated to fill their stomach with whole cereals, fruits, vegetables, green leafy vegetables, jaggery, beetroot and added citric fruits like lemon, orange, kiwi etc rather than junk foods and also counseled them to take high calorie food items and Iron rich diet. Some intervention made in preparing style of food like bulk up mashes potato by putting milk, make soups with milk instead of water, take meal at least six time in a day. The meal based on green leafy vegetables, citric fruits, folic acid. Avoid saturated fats from their diets because these are unhealthy fats, such as those contained in burgers, sausages, pies, biscuits, cakes and cheese. Try to not eat these types of the products too often. Provide whole milk to the pregnant women. All this information was given and villagers gained knowledge about good nutrition practices to be followed to live

healthy. It was a learning experience for students as they build confidence and practical knowledge of working as a community nutritionist.

Outcome of the activity:

The activity was organized on 13th January 2015 by department of Dietetics and Applied nutrition involving faculties Dr. Luxita Sharma and Ms Richa Singh along with students of BDAN 4th semester and MDAN 2nd semester. The activity involved a community visit to Padha village, Haryana, to evaluate nutritional status of local school children. The students gave nutrition education and told about the healthy food options the local children need to include in their diet.

At first students found out the problems persistent among the villagers in terms of their health and deficiency disorders. A standardized questionnaire made by students was filled by our students by asking face to face questions about their medical history, eating habits and the food options available to them. It was found that the villagers were eating food locally available and they were unaware about many food products available in the markets. Since this was initial stage and first camp, this made it challenging in finding the problem regarding the diseases persistent among them. The villagers were not very friendly and the information was not given properly as felt during the session, but students tried to build rapport and break the ice. Overall

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the session helped the students to understand the process of data collection in community. It also helped them to polish their communication skills.
