Specific initiatives to address locational advantage and disadvantages
Location advantages

- **Skilling and Training for local population**

In line with mandate of University value addition among rural population, Amity University Haryana organises several skilling and training programmes open for near by population under Skill India mission. AUH had signed MoU with eight different skill councils including five more relevant organizations including Miles, National Employability network, Vikaramshila Skill University.

- **Surya Mitra**

Surya Mitra address the need of skilling among rural population in area of Solar energy fabrication and maintenance with help of Ministry of Renewable Energy. Since 2016, 5 training sessions had been completed.

- **Hunar se Rojgatak**

'Hunar se rojgatak' this is another important initiative of University in line to channelize locational advantages of campus started in 2018.

- **Herbal Garden and Medicinal Plant Distribution Centre**

Amity University Haryana is 110 acers truly green campus in lap of Aravalli, like an oasis in semi-arid climate by following nature just development along with suitable plantation and maintenance of greenery in passive manner. University maintains a herbal and medicinal plant garden for internal use and demonstration and research. Recently in 2018, In collaboration with Ministry of Ayush, Amity University Haryana is now Medicinal Plant distribution centre for surrounding villages, to promote greenery and local economic prosperity.

- **Farmers Training**

In collaboration with Haryana Government, University regularly conduct farmers training for nearby villages to promote scientific cultivation and value addition to ensure prosperity and sustainable food production.

- **School/Collage Connect**

University reach out nearby schools and collages to update students for career and research opportunities and grooming with help of qualified faculty members. Apart from regular connections university also partner with schools to conduct academic activities including science quiz.

- **Corporate Connect Programmes**

Amity University Haryana is in lap of Aravalli bit far from main city of Gurgaon. The area lies along Delhi-Jaipur Highway; that is one of busiest business transport rout, which is transforming into business hub and special economic zone. In this context Amity University Haryana developed robust academic engagement with nearby business houses for regular classroom sessions to make student industry ready.

- **Internship opportunities for students**

Amity University Haryana have edge for being near to developing economic zone, which is reflected in core value of University 'Industry Integration'. Industry intergradation is reflected in terms of syllabus, teaching pedagogy, industry exposure to final placement of students. Subject domain like chemistry, biotechnology, business, commerce are front runner in providing internship opportunities to students in nearby business and industry establishment.

Locational disadvantages

- **Free Transport facilities for faculty and staff**

Free transport is provided for faculty and staff from their home to university to reduce locational disadvantage and ensure sustainable productivity.

- **Subsidized Transport arrangement for Students**

Amity University Haryana provides public transport facility to day scholar students for distant localities like Gurgaon, Delhi, Faridabad, Dharuheda. Promotion of public transport help to reduce carbon footprint that is inherently associated with its distant locations. This is clearly visible in LEED Platinum certification of its building.

- **Residential campus (Faculty and students)**

University provides in campus residential facility to fairly large number of faculty and staff (400) followed by 2100 students in hostel accommodation to address locational disadvantage. This will create a residential setup which promote 24*7 academic and research environment.

- **ATM services**

ATM facility is provided in campus to meet financial requirements inside campus for daily need.

- **Transport facility for student to visit Gurgaon during weekends**

University provide free public transport for students to Gurgaon during weekends. This provision helps students to meet local guardians, purchase essential items and a space for social gathering in urban environment.

- **24*7 Medical provision**

University maintain a medical center on 24*7 basis with all supporting medical staff including qualified doctors. A close tie-up with free insurance facility exists with near by Rockland Hospital to meet emergency situations

- **Departmental Store & Eatery points**

This caters need of residential university as like university is situated with in city boundary.



Our Students thanked the Doctors, PHC, Bhorakalan, Village Members for their constant Support .

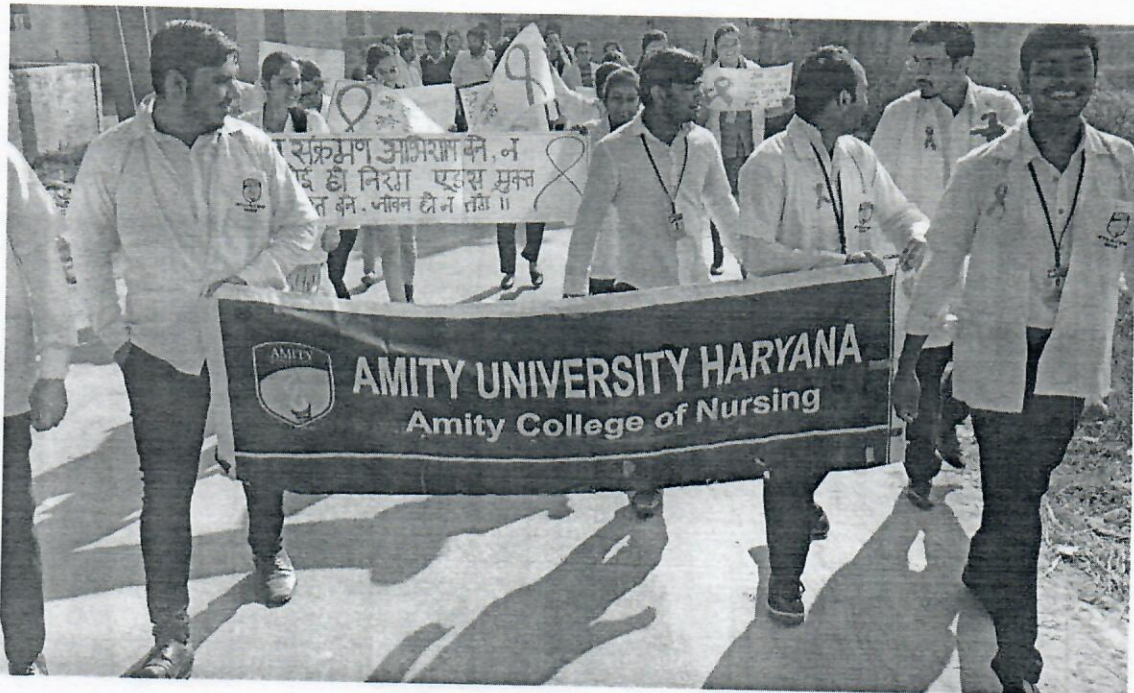

Point wise highlights of the Event: A community visit was organized at Aanganwadi Centre, Baghanki Village by Dr. Luxita Sharma, HOD & Associate Professor, Department of Dietetics & Applied Nutrition, Amity Medical School. The purpose of the visit was to impart nutrition education and aware the children and their guardians about general hygiene and sanitation. Students of M.Sc. II Semester and IV Semester were accompanied by two faculty members- Ms. Richa Singh, AP II and Ms. Apporva Tandon, AP I. All students along with faculties left the University campus at 11:00 a.m. and reached the village aanganwadi at 11:15 a.m. They were addressed by Ms. Poonam, the main worker at the aanganwadi and other helpers. There were around 15 children in the centre, belonging to the age group of 2- 7 years. All the children were given instructions about general nutrition education and hygiene in an interactive and collaborative manner. The students also performed a story telling session, recited a poem and also performed some dance to engage the children.

After this interactive and engaging session, all the children were individually weighed and height was noted and finally, the students distributed a nutritious kaalachanachaata as a snack to the children, which they enjoyed and relished. The day ended with a group photograph of all individuals present.

The community visit proved to be very fruitful for the students as well as the village people. The students got practical exposure and knowledge about working in a community and undertaking data collection, while on the other hand the villagers got nutrition education which may help in improving their health.

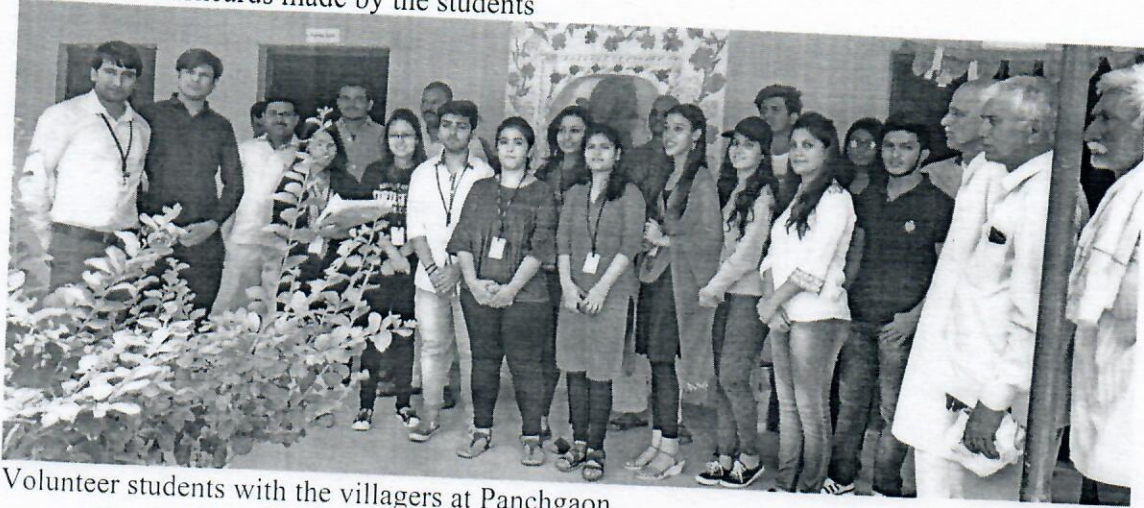

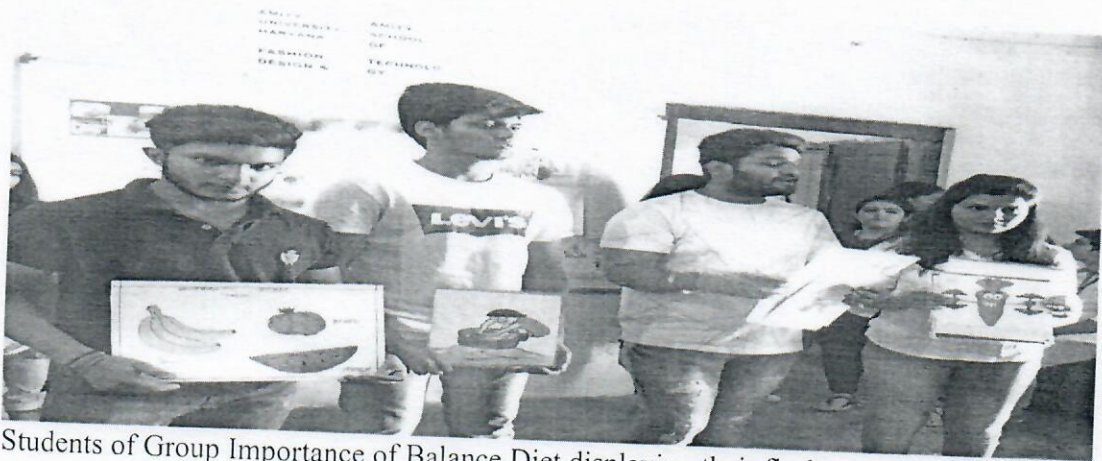

Outcome of the activity:

The activity was organized on 4th February 2016 by department of Dietetics and Applied nutrition involving faculty Dr. Luxita Sharma along with students of BDAN 4th semester, MDAN 2nd semester and MDAN 4th semester. The activity involved a community visit to Padha village, Haryana, for a Health checkup. In this study 30 subjects were included of age 20 to 32 year. After the subjects were selected, the collection of data was done using standardized questionnaire which consist of personal details, physical health, medical history, and clinical symptoms. For assessing food habits, a 24 hour recall method was used and dietary information was taken. All the subjects were made to fill the questionnaire before the intervention was started and after their intervention following for a month.

The villagers became aware of their health and nutritional status and came to know about the various healthy food options to be included in the diet. Nutrition education was given to make villagers aware of healthy habits. Students learned about the process of survey and data collection in the community and gained practical experience related to nutritional counseling. Hence, the camp was successful for students as well as villagers, imparting knowledge of nutrition and diet.

**Diabetes Awareness Program organized on the World Diabetes Day,
November 14, 2014**

Introduction:-

The World Diabetes Day, is a global awareness campaign which is observed on November 14 every year in over 160 different countries. It was jointly introduced by the World Health Organization and International Diabetes Federation in 1991 in response to the alarming rise of diabetes around the world.

The campaign engages millions of people worldwide in diabetes advocacy and awareness and draws attention to important issues related to it and keeps diabetes in public spotlight.

Diabetes is a global problem having over 350 million people suffering from it. In 2012 an estimated 1.5 million deaths were attributed to Diabetes. Diabetes is a silent killer and it is projected that by 2030 it will be the 7th leading cause of death. It affects all ages and all ethnic groups around the world.

In India Diabetes is fast gaining the status of a potential epidemic with more than 62 million of its population diabetic. It is being known as the Diabetic Capital of the World with the highest number of people suffering from diabetes followed by China and the USA in second and third place respectively. About one third of the Diabetics don't even know that they are suffering from it. Undiagnosed and untreated Diabetes leads to complications like blindness, kidney disorders, Hypertension, Diabetic ulcers, osteopathy, heart attacks, strokes and many more.

With the above facts in mind that it was decided to organize Diabetes Awareness Programme, under the aegis of Amity Medical School by the Department of Hospital Administration for the benefit of our faculty, staff and students. Dr. Sandeep Kharb, Consultant Endocrinologist, Paras Hospital, one of our partner hospitals in Gurgaon was invited to deliver a guest lecture on the subject.

Arrangements were also made for the faculties, staff and the students to have their Random Blood Glucose levels tested by a team of 4 technicians from Paras Hospital and also for vision examination conducted by the Department of Optometry, AMS, AUH.

Details of the program:-

The program was held in Auditorium A Block (as per the attached Program schedule)
Random Blood Glucose level testing & Vision Examination was done in B Block, ground floor, Rear Foyer (Photographs attached herewith)
Time: 10.30 AM to 12.30 PM.

Objectives

- To inform and educate faculty, staff and students about diabetes, its implications and motivate them to adopt a healthy lifestyle.
- To screen for high blood glucose level and visual acuity amongst students, faculty and staff.

Conduct of the Program

The program commenced with the networking tea for the guests and senior faculty members. By 10.30 AM the Auditorium had about 20 faculty members and around 250 students. The Program began with the Opening Remarks by Maj Gen (Dr) Mahavir Singh, HOI, AMS & Dean, Faculty of Health and Allied Sciences. He stressed upon the fact that Diabetes is a lifestyle disease & we need to change our lifestyles to overcome the problem. Dr Sandeep Kharb, MD, DNB presently Consultant Endocrinologist, Paras Hospital, Gurgaon delivered the guest lecture on the subject. He talked about various types of Diabetes like Type I, Type II, Gestational Diabetes & how and why these occur. He spoke on the burden of disease, its risk factors, complications & treatment and also stressed upon whom to screen for diabetes. He advocated adoption of healthy lifestyle, which included regular exercises, yoga and healthy nutrition practices. His talk evoked lot of interest among the audience which was evident from the questions raised by them during the Question – Answer Session. A question answer session followed, wherein the questions of audience were answered by Maj Gen (Dr) Mahavir Singh and Dr Sandeep Kharb. A large number of questions were asked by the faculty as well as students which were answered lucidly.

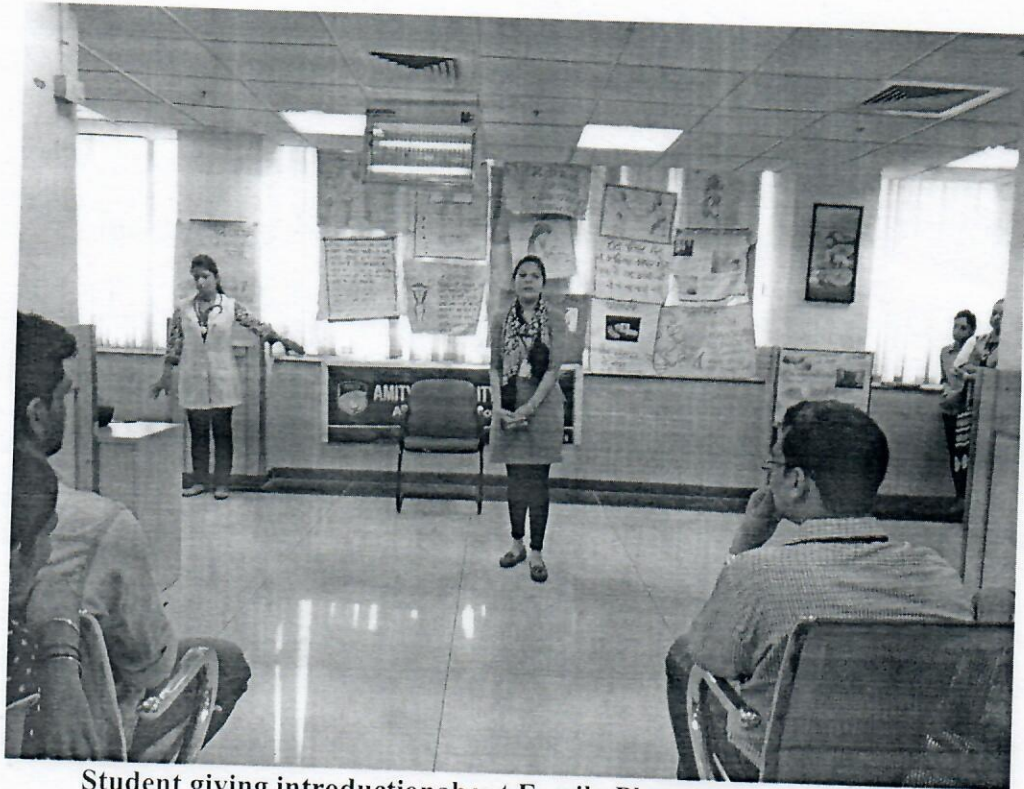

The following aspects were covered by the students during the programme: Introduction, importance, advantages, types and techniques of using various family planning methods.

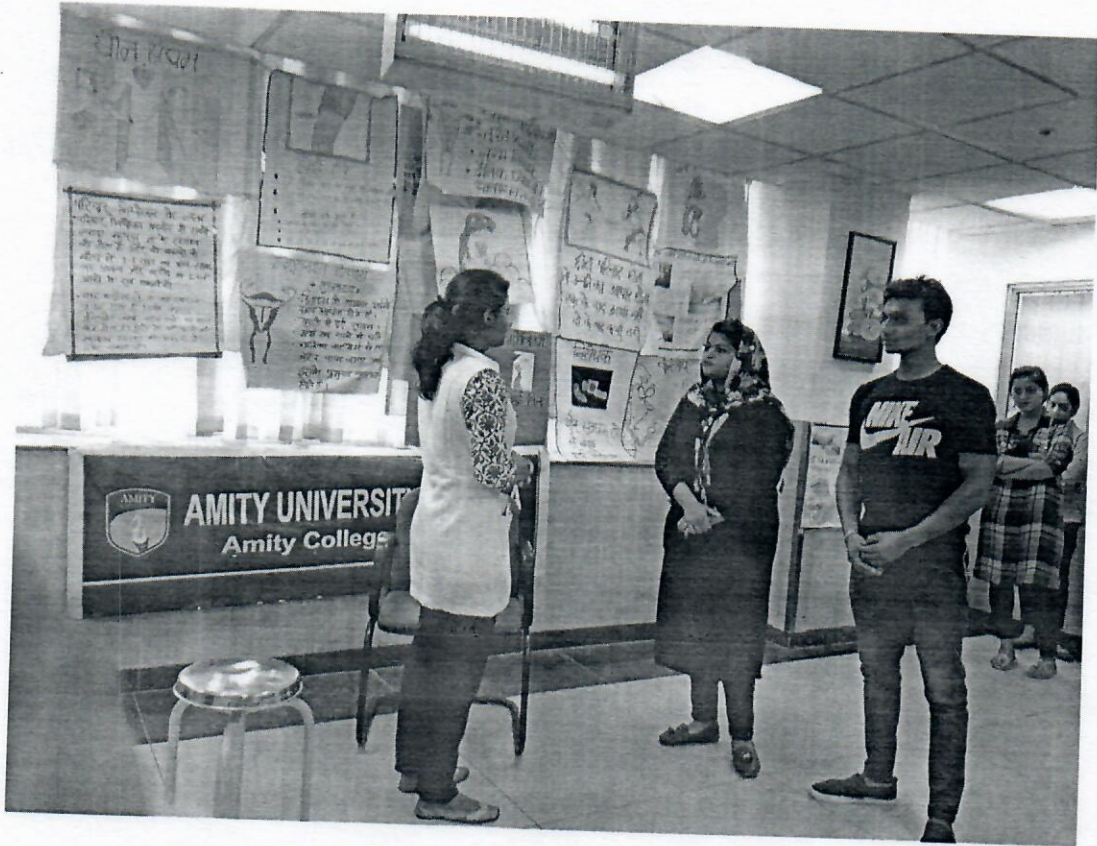
