## IMPLEMENTATION OF NEP 2020 – NEW CURRICULUM FRAMEWORK FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS AT AMITY UNIVERSITY HARYANA

National Education Policy of 2020 outlines the vision of new education system with a primary purpose to raise the standard of education in India and universalization of education i.e washing off the boundaries between arts/commerce/vocational/curricular and extracurricular disciplines. It aims to make a revolution to the way education is imparted in India with a vision to make it more equitable, inclusive, and holistic. Getting away with rote learning to focus on fostering critical thinking, creativity, and problem-solving skills. To achieve this, NEP emphasizes teaching a wider range of subjects in addition to traditional subjects being offered in the core courses. More flexible and diverse pathways are available allowing students to pursue subjects that interest them and match their competencies. Also, infusion of technology, integration of vocational and skill-based training so as to make students more employable is one of the main concerns of new regime. With the changing realm of the education mechanism in India and

taking stock of National Education Policy, 2020, under the visionary leadership of our Honorable Chancellor Dr Aseem Chauhan, the Amity University, Haryana has envisioned, revamped the curriculum, and implemented NEP 2020 with the current academic year 2023-2024. Genuine efforts were put forward to understand the nitigrities and reconnoitered possibilities for a structured implementation of NEP-2020, emphasizing the holistic development, skill enhancement, industry-academia collaboration for the best interest of our stakeholders, and society at large. Equal focus has been given on the core values viz, Multi-Entry &-Exit system, Choice-Based Credit System, multidisciplinary education, Indian Ethos, and foreign languages. Taking note of NEP mandates, AUH has prepared Three-Discipline Pattern Model "New Curriculum Framework for Undergraduate Programmes", (NCFUG), which provides flexibility in terms of choice of discipline(s) of study developing academic pathways

having creative combinations of disciplines for study with multiple entry and exit options and is applicable to all 3yrs undergraduate programmes of all faculties of studies with nomenclature of B.A./ B.Sc./ B.Com./ BBA/ BCA except the programmes regulated by respective council/4 years or 5 years UG programmes already running in the University. Under this regime, the credit mechanism in the course structure is distributed to cater Discipline specific courses, foundation courses, and NTCC to complete 135 & 180 credits for 3 years and 4-year programmes respectively. Inclusion of MOOC's have also been made to develop the student learning skills. Even the pedagogy for imparting communication skill and foreign language skills have been recrafted to ensure maximum learning interface through LMS and optimizing both intellectual and technological resources at university. Embedding Value Added Courses to impart and ensure relevant domain specific

skills, mental, emotional, physical wellbeing, through basket of courses is an attempt to engage students beyond academics where they will explore activities pertaining to dance, gardening, team building, sketching etc. Thus, providing the multitude of combinations to our students, we wish to achieve excellence that has always been the objective of Amity University and meet the 21st century education goals.

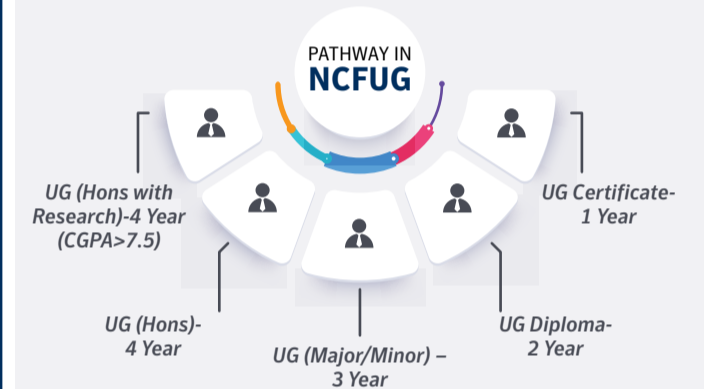

Saloni Setiya: Rights and Protection Available for Juveniles in Juvenile Justice; Vipul Jain: Legal Services Authority Act, 1987; Aditya Aryan: Domestic Violence Against Women

Dr. Shiv Raman, Assistant Professor at Amity Law School, explained the different provisions of the law relating to legal aid. He also explained important provisions of the Haryana Rent Act, 1973, and apprised the villagers that if they are not getting rent or a tenant refuses to vacate rented premises, they can file an application to the Controller of Rent, an authority under the Haryana Rent (Control and Eviction) Act, 1973.

In addition to the above, law students individually discussed different social and legal issues with the villagers relating to the problem of violence and violations of their civil rights.

The aim of the guest lecture was to make students aware regarding the concept of luxury in building interiors its scope, importance and challenges faced during the process.

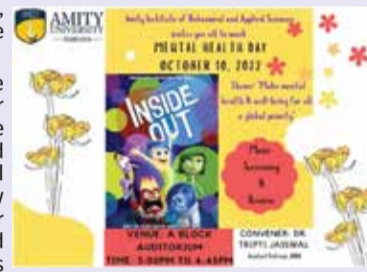

Ms. Malika's own experience in sales at ITC demonstrates the importance of sales skills in business growth and now works in B2B sales, showing how these skills can open career opportunities and advancement. Developing skills in storytelling and sales can lead to

personal and professional growth.

Ms. Elaine's advice emphasizes the importance of developing unique ideas and skills in order to make money. She works in taxation and recommends conducting thorough research beyond classroom learning. Basic finance skills, such as accountancy, are crucial and proficiency in tools like Excel is essential. Effective time management is important, particularly when dealing with data and multiple clients. Ms. Elaine suggests staying updates with automation and find ways to incorporate your skills into the automated processes. Finally, she emphasizes the importance of constantly enhancing knowledge and not confining oneself to theory.



Mr. Kreepa highlights the rapid transition from student to industry professional and the journey that comes with it. His role at Gartner involves identifying scalable problems and strategies, which require creativity. He encourages students to think outside the classroom and understand the practicality of their ideas. Mr. Kreepa gives the example of Redbull's marketing strategy as a demonstration of the importance of creativity.

The talk by Prof. Himanshu concentrated on numerous facets of the influenza virus, its effects on human health, and the difficulties connected with it. He began by defining the differences between the normal cold and the flu before delving into the analysis and reconstruction of the 1918 flu virus. He emphasized how the flu virus affects human health and how it affects vulnerable populations, including pregnant women, people with chronic medical illnesses, healthcare professionals, young children under the age of five, and the elderly.

Prof. Himanshu addressed the issue of drug resistance, focusing on NA inhibitors like the antiviral drug Tamiflu.



A question-and-answer session followed the presentation, in which participants asked insightful queries that Prof. Himanshu responded to. Participants have the chance to further clarify their questions and go deeper into the issues covered during this interactive portion.

Dr. Machiavelli Singh, in his welcome address, expressed his gratitude to the participants, guests, and organizers for their presence. He emphasized the significance of skill development in today's rapidly evolving world and acknowledged the efforts of Amity University Haryana in promoting skill-based education. Dr. Vikas Madhukar, Hon'ble Pro Vice Chancellor of Amity University Haryana, addressed the audience next. Dr. Madhukar emphasized the importance of collaboration between academia, industry, and government to bridge the skill gap and ensure employability among the youth.

At 9.30 a.m., the whole student body and faculty began travelling to the Pataudi Block Development Office from the AUH campus. The gang arrived at the Block office around 10.30 a.m. The Block Development Officer scheduled a meeting with the students where he discussed the challenges related to projects under the control of the Block Panchayat. After his lecture, students had the chance to ask him questions on many facets of rural home living conditions. The conversation was really beneficial to the students as they learned about the everyday challenges faced by development officials.

The main goals of the event were to encourage and promote the use of primary research techniques among ASE students and thereby give them a good understanding of how to prepare questionnaires, how to approach households and decision makers, and how to collect data. To study the agricultural transformation that is taking place in India by studying farming households in rural India specifically in the Pataudi Village of Haryana (primary data collection). Additionally, it concentrated on presenting an overview of the major statistical tools and techniques and provided guidance on how to assess data both qualitatively and quantitatively. Additionally, it taught students how to conduct primary research, including the processes that must be taken, and how to prepare a research report.

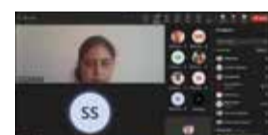

The Speakers for the workshop Prof. Sumit Narula, Director, ASCO, AUH and Editor-in-chief, Journal of Content, Community and Communication, Dr. Gyaneshwar Kumar Rao, Associate Professor at ASAS, AUH, Dr. Rishi Manrai, Associate Professor, Amity Business School.

The program featured sessions on identifying fake and predatory journals, open-access publishing models,

academic writing essentials, and quality research publishing standards for high-impact journals. The program emphasized the significance of ethical practices in research publishing, particularly in the digital age. Ethical standards were seen as essential for maintaining the credibility and integrity of research. The distinction between the conduct of research and the publication of research findings was highlighted, emphasizing the need for ethical practices in both phases.

The role of technology in enhancing research efficiency and productivity was underscored, urging researchers to stay updated on software tools and features. Practical guidance was provided on identifying cloned and predatory journals, including red flags to watch out for and the introduction of a mobile app for journal checking. The importance of coherent and well-structured academic writing, along with the concept of research reproducibility, was discussed in-depth. Attendees learned about the challenges of being accepted by high-impact factor journals and received tips on crafting titles, introductions, abstracts, literature reviews, and more.

## SOCIETY OUTREACH PROGRAM ON WORLD CANCER DAY - 2023



On December 6, 2022, Citizen Hospital in Gurugram hosted a Society Outreach Program on World Cancer Day in conjunction with Amity Institute of Clinical Psychology (AICP), Amity University Haryana, Gurugram. The program's main theme was sensitization and awareness of the cancer condition. Dr. Mustafa Nadeem Kirmani (Associate Professor), Dr. Mehfooz Ahmed (Assistant Professor-II), Ms. Nidhi Mehta, Ms. Meenakshi, Ms. Shirley Raj, Dr. Swati Sindhu, Dr. Deepika Dhingra, Dr. Amit Sharma, Dr. Amita Puri, Director Optimus Centre, Citizen Hospital Gurugram, MPhil. Clinical Psychology Part-1 & Part-2 participated and significantly contributed in the programme. The following issues were discussed by MPhil. candidates: Participants

were made more aware of psycho-oncology through the programme, which included topics such as symptoms, causes, prevalence, drug misuse, media, mental comorbidity, family therapy, couple therapy, bereavement counselling, and pain management. Moreover, the importance of ayurveda and other natural treatments was emphasised. The programme also highlighted community-wide methods for early sickness detection and prevention. The chaos caused by the cancer epidemic in society must be reduced. Recovery from the sickness is not impossible if the patient has sufficient social support, financial assistance, a good mindset, and the right care. The session's major goal was to concentrate on the various problems facing the cancer-affected people. Participants have gained knowledge of the value of early intervention and stigma reduction for cancer patients.

## GUEST LECTURE ON MITOCHONDRIA CALCIUM DYNAMICS IS A CRITICAL DETERMINANT OF HUMAN SKIN PIGMENTATION



Amity Institute of Biotechnology and Amity Institute of Integrative Sciences and Health organized a guest lecture on "Mitochondria Calcium Dynamics: A Critical Determinant of Human Skin Pigmentation" held on 9th May 2023. The main objective of the event was to create a platform for the presentation of current results of scientific work in calcium signaling to the faculty and students of AUH. Dr. Rajender Motiani, Assistant Professor at the Regional Centre for Biotechnology, provided an overview of the role of melanosomes and how calcium signaling regulates cellular functions such as tissue homeostasis and skin health. Perturbations in calcium dynamics can lead to impairments in cellular

physiology, eventually resulting in diseases. His research focuses on understanding the role of calcium signaling in skin pigmentation, pancreatic tumorigenesis, and cancer metastasis. The research goals include: 1) delineating the role of calcium dynamics in these pathophysiological conditions; 2) elucidating detailed molecular mechanisms that connect dysregulated calcium signaling to cancer metastasis and pigmentary disorders; and 3) utilizing this knowledge to develop strategies for improved therapeutic intervention and clinical management of these pathophysiological conditions. The lecture provided an invaluable opportunity for the attendees to broaden their understanding of the intricate relationship between mitochondria calcium dynamics and human skin pigmentation.

## EXPERT LECTURE ON CLOUD COMPUTING: CHALLENGES AND FUTURE PROSPECTS

Amity School of Engineering & Technology organized an Expert Lecture session on "Cloud Computing: Challenges and Future Prospects" on 10th November 2022. As the program's guest expert speaker, Mr.



Ajay Kumar, Head of NextGen AMS Practice, Injazat Data Systems (Abu Dhabi), hosted the session, while Dr. Priyanka Vashisht, Dr. Aman Jain, and Dr. Aashima Narang, Assistant Professors at AUH, functioned as event coordinators. A summary of the academic programmes, research infrastructure, and financing for research offered by AIB, AIISH, and AUH was provided by Prof. Rajendra Prasad. He also provided an overview of his Amity School of Engineering and Technology organized a Faculty Development Programme on Recent Advancements, Innovations, and Future Trends in Emerging Technologies and their Impact on Higher Education held between July 17th and July 21st, 2023.
