Students from more than 21 countries participated in it. With the mission of identifying and nurturing talented young scientists, TISF is a science research competition for high school students from grade nine to twelve. Over 231 projects were presented in TISF and participating students were divided into domestic and overseas groups. The projects were categorised into various sub themes like biomechanics, engineering, chemistry, home science etc. and two students of class XI from AIS-46, Gurgaon represented India in TISF and got the project under Engineering.
