
## **E-POSTER MAKING COMPETITION**

## **Theme: Gandhian Concept of Labour**



AMITY LAW SCHOOL, DELHI is organizing E-Poster making competition at institutional level on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2020. For this purpose, all participants are required to send their e-poster in accordance with the required format as below-mentioned.

**Brief outline of the theme**: With the imposition of lockdown during COVID-19 pandemic, many factories and workplaces are forced to shut down which caused multiple hardships to millions of migrant workers. Thousands of them walked back home. Countless labourers and their families went hungry. Many of them died for reasons ranging from starvation, suicide, exhaustion, road and rail accidents, police brutality and denial of timely medical care. Mahatma Gandhi had high respect for the dignity of labour.

The ideas of labour are part and parcel of his political, sociological and philosophical ideals. These ideals are directed to the provision for basic needs of life and existence, the guarantee of economic freedom, justice and equality and moral development of human beings. Mahatma Gandhi said that the labourers should have the right to insist upon adequate wages, humane treatment from their employees, proper and good sanitary lodgings. In light of the migrant crisis, the Gandhian ideas of labour stand even more relevant today.

## **Guidelines for the competition:**

- For the purpose of evaluation, participants are required to attach a write-up of not more than 100 words explaining the creative vision, concept and ideas behind their eposter.
- E-Certificates shall be awarded to the participants who stand at 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> position.
