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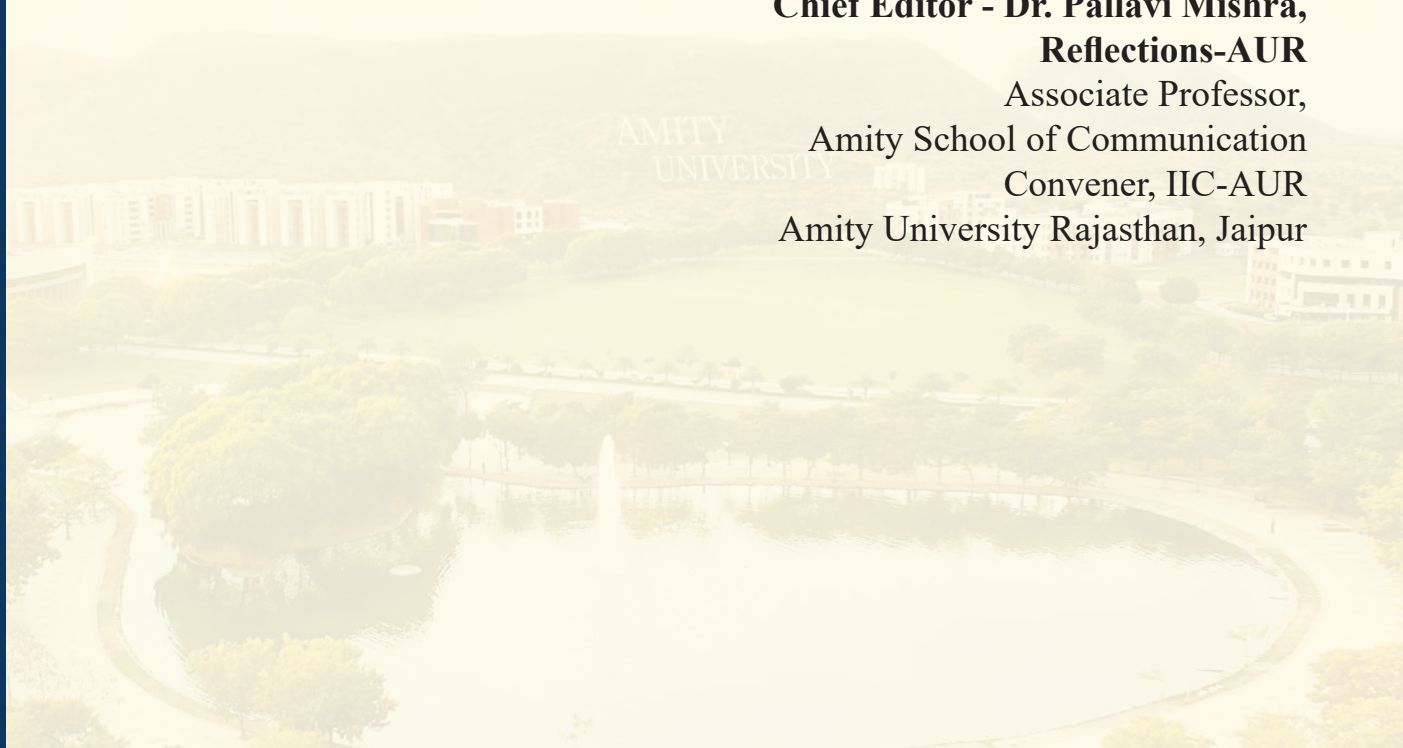

INTERVIEW

Prof (Dr) Amit Jain, Vice-Chancellor/President, Amity University Rajasthan

Sir, thank you for speaking to AUR Newsletter. At the outset, we would like to congratulate you on being appointed as the new Vice-Chancellor/President of Amity University Rajasthan.

Being an esteemed dignitary of Amity University Rajasthan, Jaipur, what are your roles and responsibilities towards the students?

We are a student-centric institution and cater to the needs and expectations of all stakeholders. I ensure that our research and academic endeavours contribute to the well-being of society. We provide a supportive environment that facilitates creativity and innovation. Rich Interdisciplinary Curriculum, Industry Connect, focus on Skill Development and Entrepreneurship help students to convert their innovative ideas into successful ventures. Moreover, I ensure to the growth and development of the education sector by providing an ecosystem that fosters excellence in academics and research, promoting a culture of lifelong learning and growth with intellectual activity, and bringing together academics, researchers, and students from all over the world to work together and expand knowledge.

What is your philosophy of leadership?

My philosophy of leadership is about creating a positive and productive environment that allows individuals to reach their full potential while working towards a common goal. I believe leadership is characterized by the ability to inspire and motivate others towards a common vision and prioritize the well-being and development of their team members and have more engaged and productive teams. My idea of leadership is underlined by recognizing the strengths and potential of everyone on their team and providing opportunities for growth and development.

How does the University's curriculum ensure the highest practice in the industry?

The college's curriculum ensures the highest practice in the industry with the Industry Advisory Council wherein we engage with professionals from relevant industries to gain insight into the latest trends, best practices, and emerging technologies. This provides students with opportunities for internships, job shadowing, and other experiential learning opportunities that expose them to real-world industry practices. These activities give students the chance to apply theoretical knowledge to real-world problems and can help prepare them for the industry. We also have a strong alumni network that helps to solicit feedback for improvement and stay up to date with the latest industry practices. The feedback is taken, and changes are made in the curriculum and pedagogy as required to keep it in line with industry needs and expectations. The focus is to achieve academic excellence

through industry integration, experiential learning, innovative pedagogy, and research.

Any insights into how your institute could be more welcoming to students of different Regions?

Our institute welcomes students of different races and backgrounds to foster a culture of inclusivity and we have a pool of faculty and staff members from different regions. We promote diversity and multiculturalism throughout the institution by celebrating cultural events, promoting cultural awareness and sensitivity, and providing support to students from diverse backgrounds. We provide access and support to students by providing financial aid and scholarships, offering academic and career counselling, and providing resources for mental well-being.

What are the interventions and approaches you bring in apart from the curriculum to train/teach the students?

We develop robust learning capabilities with a customized learning approach that demonstrates a prodigious intellect with a broad perspective responding perceptively to many human challenges and inventing innovative criteria for assessing and improving. The university offers a vast array of subjects and study possibilities wherein the students can specialise in their area of interest and find employment. We work to create an ecosystem that fosters academic excellence, research, technology-driven and field-based learning, cross-cultural exposure, holistic development, and a commitment to social and environmental responsibility to train the next generation of global leaders.

We have a full-fledged functional Amity Innovation Incubation centre. It is an active support ecosystem to inspire and mentor our students into budding entrepreneurs and facilitate them in establishing a start-up to solve local, regional, and social problems. The Student Entrepreneurship Cell organises informative sessions and workshops to inculcate and develop breakthrough innovation and create world-class start-ups. It is supported by an advisory body consisting of industrialists, venture capitalists, technical specialists, and managers to help entrepreneurs realise their dream through a range of infrastructure business advisory mentoring and financial services.

What is the University's greatest strength?

The University's greatest strength has been in promoting innovation through Higher Education besides nurturing young minds with value-based education with good academic practices. The institution's mentor-mentee programme strengthens the network of support for students. The residential campus, guarantees that both faculty and students have an active and happy

time while here. The campus includes top-notch sports facilities for football, archery, and golf putting, as well as for developing student athletes' potential. The academic programme at the AUR is distinctive and demanding because it combines core subjects with electives, value-added courses, and the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS).

How can positive relationships be built within the organisation?

Establishing healthy relationships in an institute requires effort and effective communication. Communication and collaboration are the keys to establishing healthy relationships. I strongly believe communication helps to exchange ideas, knowledge and thoughts while collaboration helps build trust, strengthens relationships, and encourages creativity. Building positive relationships with faculties and staff starts with getting to know each other during formal/informal meetings and establishing an emotional connection. I have instituted a practice of monthly structured meetings with faculty colleagues and students where they can share their concerns and suggestions. Students have access to an online intranet portal where they can make any suggestion to authorities at any time and the same is attended by the concerned persons within hours. Students are encouraged to explore, experiment and gain experience through active engagement with peers and faculty members.

What strategies do you use to help your students deal with the intense competition they face outside the classroom?

To face the competition, we ensure that the fundamentals of our students are quite strong so that they can apply their knowledge in the industry. Thus, we lay emphasis on experiential learning, and we keep on inviting industry experts across the globe to provide our students with insight into each vertical of the industry. We run certain certification courses in Amity University British Standard Institution (AUBSI) program wherein the most desired skills base certifications needed in industries are provided. We keep on revising our syllabus as per the industry norms and that gives an edge to our students and also encourages them to acquire other certifications offered by other bodies based on their attitude and inclination. Before choosing the elective subject, students are guided by a concerned subject expert about the scope and relevance of those electives, and they are matched with the profile of the student and his interest.

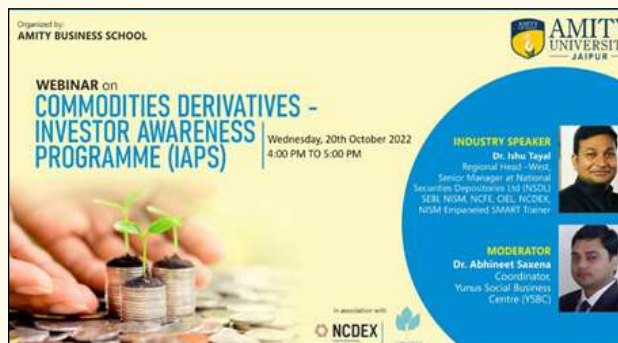
Expert Talk on Mental Health Awareness

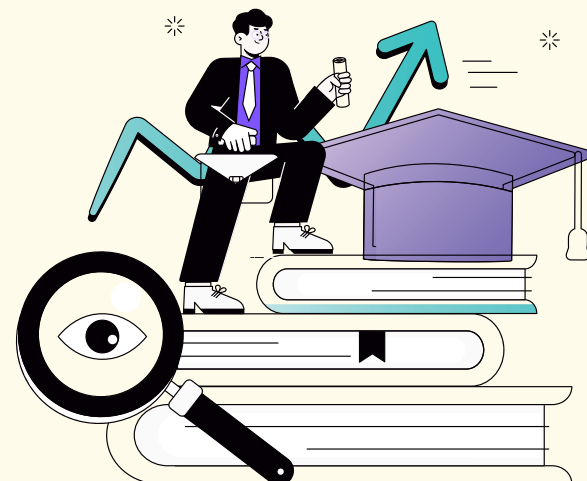


Webinar on Commodities Derivatives-Investor Awareness Programme

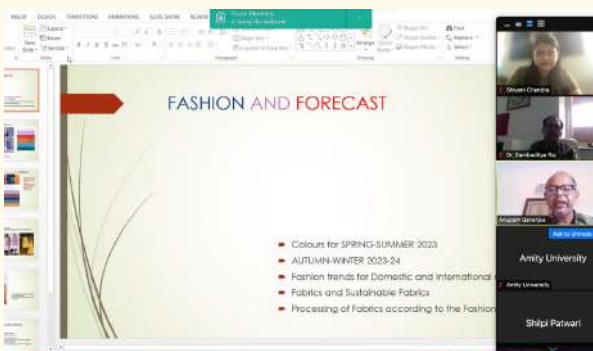
