Disabled Friendly Accommodation Allotment Policy

Introduction

Amity University Rajasthan is committed to providing a safe and accessible environment for all students, including those with disabilities. This policy outlines the AUR's procedures for allotting accommodation to students & staff with disabilities.

Eligibility

To be eligible for preferential accommodation allotment, students must meet the following criteria:

- Be a current student at the university.
- Have a disability that substantially limits one or more major life activities.
- Provide documentation of their disability from a qualified professional.

Policy: The university will provide preferential allotment of accommodation to persons with disabilities. This policy is designed to ensure that persons with disabilities have access to accessible accommodation at the university. It is the university's goal to provide a barrier-free environment for all students and employees.

Selection Process: Persons with disabilities who are eligible for preferential allotment will be selected based on the following criteria:

- o The severity of their disability.
- The need for accessible accommodation.
- o The availability of housing units that meet their needs.

Accommodation: The university will provide accommodation to persons with disabilities in their housing units, as needed. These accommodation may include:

- Accessible entrances and exits.
- o Wide doorways and hallways.
- o Grab bars in the bathroom.
- Accessible appliances.
- Accessible furniture.

Cost: The cost of accommodation for persons with disabilities will be the same as the cost of accommodation for other students and employees.

Preferential Allotment

Students with disabilities will be given preferential allotment in the following ways:

- One present reservation in the overall accommodation allotment.
- Priority for accommodation on the ground floor or in accessible units.
- The ability to request modifications to their housing unit, such as widened doorways or accessible showers.

Application Process

Students who wish to apply for preferential accommodation allotment must do so through the Administration / Registrar office. The application process will include providing documentation of their disability and requesting the type of accommodation they need.

Appeals

Students who are not satisfied with the outcome of their accommodation application may appeal the decision. Appeals must be made in writing to the university's accommodation appeals committee.

Additional Considerations

In addition to the above, the university may also consider the following factors when selecting persons with disabilities for preferential allotment of accommodation:

- The person's ability to live independently.
- The person's support network.
- The person's academic or employment status.
- The person's financial resources.

The university may also require persons with disabilities to provide additional documentation, such as a letter from their doctor or therapist, to support their application for preferential allotment.

The university is committed to providing accessible accommodation for all persons with disabilities. This policy is a step towards ensuring that all students and employees have the opportunity to live and learn in a barrier-free environment.
