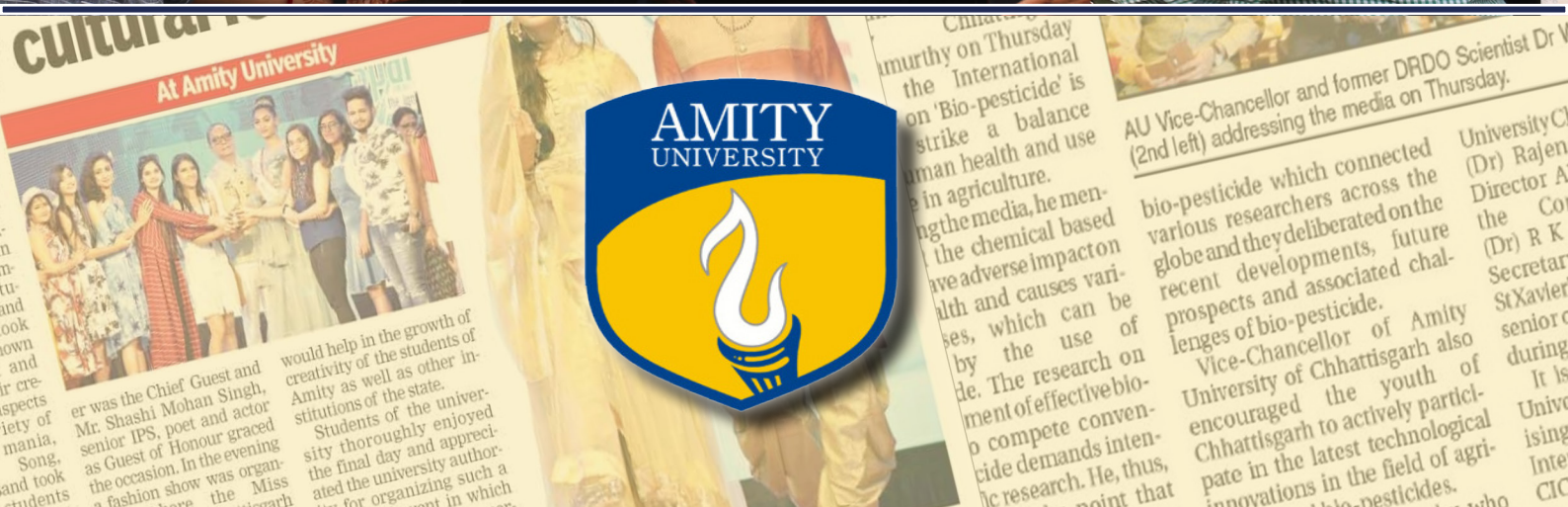

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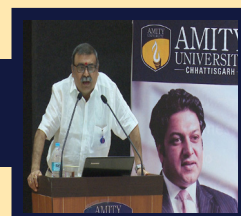

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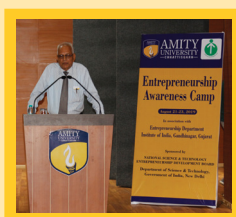
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## Message from the Founder President

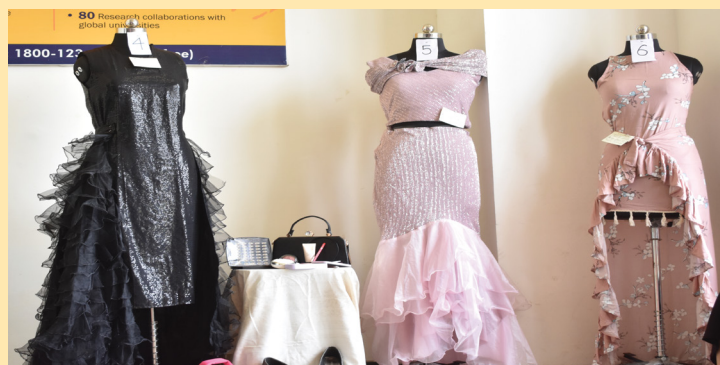
# Amity Celebrates Innovation Day

## Amity Celebrates 'Hareli'



Amity School of Communication, Amity University Chhattisgarh organised a celebration of 'Hareli', which is one of the famous festivals of Chhattisgarh. The celebration is praised with extraordinary pageantry and show. To commemorate the occasion, the media school performed a traditional *Hareli* puja where the farm equipment and plants were worshiped. Hareli festival is observed on the new moon day of *Shravan* month of the Hindu calendar. *Hareli* has a great significance in Chhattisgarh which symbolizes the new harvest and rainy season. People also take pledge to save the environment. *Hareli* provides an introspective time to check whether a harvest is good or not. Students came to know about khadi fabric and its significance. Most of the weavers of Kuwargarh are women and it enhances the contribution of women weavers in the growth of hand-loom industry. There are many handicapped weavers in Kuwargarh and they are producing fabrics in traditional Pit Looms for their livelihood.

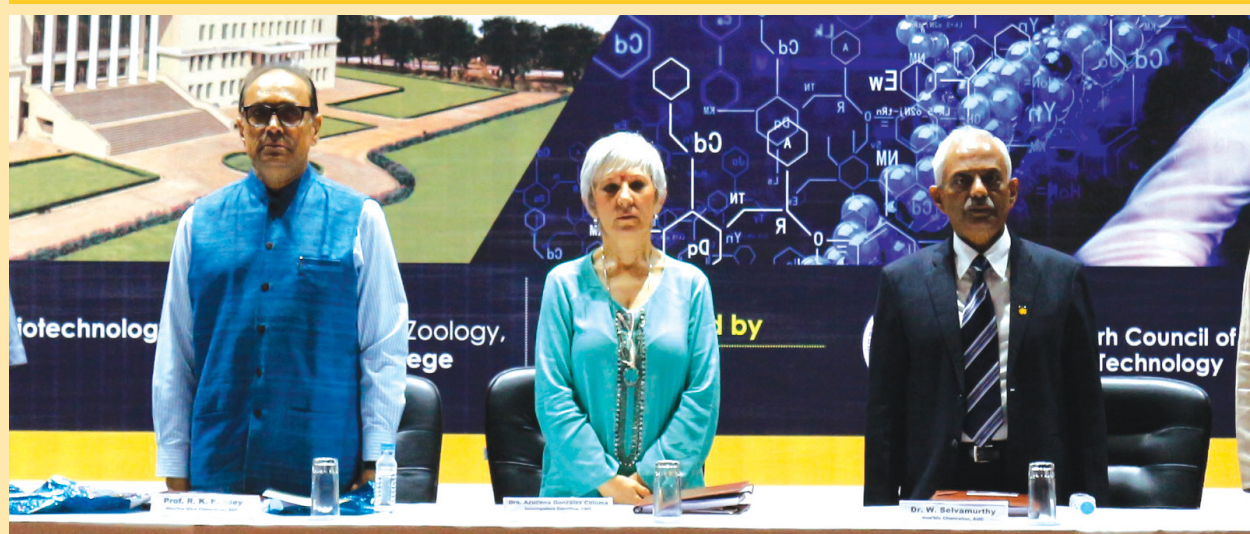
