

TREASURE HUNT

The first round which was the qualifier round of Innovative Business Managers was the Treasure Hunt round which was conducted on Dare2Compete platform on 6th March, 2021 from 7:00 PM to 10:00 PM. During the main event the participants were given a total of 10 minutes (7+3) to present their wealth plan and answer the questions asked by the judges on MS Teams platform

ROUND 5- THE WINNING PITCH

The Marketing Club of Amity Business School organised the event – "INNOVATIVE BUSINESS MANAGER MARKETING ROUND- THE WINNING PITCH" on Saturday, 13TH MARCH, 2021 at MS Teams-virtual mode. The participants were assigned a random product for which they had to make a presentation and create a pitch in strategy to sell the product.

A debate competition has been organized by the Debate Club on the topic "Can Technological Advancement provide India an edge over other Developing Countries?".



Of the world's promiscuity


