The conference was attended by recognized speakers, representatives and leaders from Industry and presented their viewpoints in different plenary sessions. <u>Inaugural Session: Following were the speakers during the inaugural session of INFINITY</u> 2022 which was held on 3rd November, 2022.

The inaugural ceremony commenced with an auspicious note by seeking the blessings of Goddess Saraswati and lighting of the ceremonial lamp by the dignitaries. The students interacted with the guests and were curious to learn more from them. At the end of the ceremony, Shri. Vijay Bahadur Pathak, Mr. Jayant Chandra and Mr. Amit Dubey were felicitated by Prof. (Dr.) Sanjeev Bansal, Dean FMS & Director ABS.

Prof. (Dr.) Teena Bagga welcomed all the esteemed dignitaries and audience who graced the occasion with their presence. She talked about how the pandemic situation become the catalyst for digital transformation of the organizations. She emphasized on the role of various emerging technologies and explained how these technologies are transforming the business process and aiding in business continuity. She elucidated, how technologies when harnessed and aligned effectively, can drive innovation, and bring fundamental change in business models to potentially deliver massive returns.

Dr. Sanjeev Bansal, Chairperson of INFINITY 2022, Dean FMS and Director ABS welcomed the Speakers and the audience and spoke about the theme of the conference. He talked about the emerging technologies like Artificial Intelligence, Internet of Things, 5G and so on and emphasized on the fact that the technology is no longer going to remain constant and would be drastically changing in no time. He added by saying, "Technology has taken a new leap and a new dimension altogether". Dean FMS & Director ABS also gave a glimpse of past Infinity conferences held in ABS.

Dr. Balvinder Shukla, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Amity University Uttar Pradesh addressed the audience and expressed her gratitude to everyone who came to attend the conference. She stated that Infinity 2022 is a very important conference and the theme chosen for the Conference is very appropriate.

Further, she talked about how the emerging technologies have gained momentum during the pandemic and technology was the only key to survival for businesses in times of crisis. She even mentioned that during the pandemic not all businesses were badly affected and the majority of them flourished because they were well equipped with technological tools like Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, Augmented Reality, Virtual Reality and many more. She emphasized that good information and technology were needed for businesses to get a competitive edge.

Mr. Jayant Chandra started by thanking the panel for inviting him to the conference of such esteem. He was part of Amity as a student in 2008 and currently is the Director of PwC. He briefed the audience about the influence of technology and how it gives a perspective to the prevailing market. He discussed the importance of Blockchain technologies and AI in today's curriculum. He emphasized on the factors which could result in the current technologies to go obsolete in less than 5 years.

Mr. Amit Dubey expressed his gratitude to Dr Sanjeev Bansal for making him a part of the event. He introduced the details of his work as a cybercrime investigator. He believes the world can be controlled through mere codes, as he says, "I would love to change the world, but they won't give me the source code."

He then told how the concept of Quantum Mechanics derives from Bhagwat Gita. He put light to two main parts, Superposition and Entanglement. He mentioned how modern technologies in quantum mechanics have surpassed previously existing tools in cybercrime. He talked about AI programs in-the-making which are to be designed for predicting possible criminal activities. He shared a personal incident from 2018 where he had to work on an investigation regarding an esteemed minister of India and their approach towards handling cyber conspiracies.

Shri Vijay Bahadur Pathak talked about the previous few years where technology was on the brink of advancement. In those times, IMEI numbers used to be tracked in criminal investigations regarding technology. He referred Prime Minister Narendra Modi's efforts towards incorporating 3-D campaigns and digital money, especially at the onset of the Covid-19 Pandemic.

Dr Triveni Singh began by discussing the possibilities of cyber-crime in the Metaverse created by Mark Zuckerberg. He mentioned the scope of quantum computing and how it will eliminate the need for passwords and security. He then discussed an incident in which a bank robbery was convicted through hacking digital security and how it poses problems to maintaining digital presence. He shared that the statistics at his cybercrime division revealed that over Rs 4200 crores are scammed and lost through chain messages and spam emails which are heavily regulated
