### **Rules :**

Primary membership is mandatory for the evaluation and secondary membership is optional.
- Each Club has a restricted intake of 60 students (Primary Membership). Enrollment to any club will be on FIRST-cum-FIRST basis. Once the seats of the club are full on first cum first basis, automatically the option of entering the respective club will be closed. Then they will have to choose the clubs where seats are available. Primary membership is mandatory for the evaluation and secondary membership is optional.
