Submission Guidelines:

- Submit your manuscript either in PDF or in Microsoft Word format.
- Authors should only submit originally written, unpublished work to ICCAKM-2021.
- Submissions should strictly follow the recommended IEEE conference template.
- All references must follow the IEEE format of referencing
- To facilitate the paper's double-blind peer review process, authors should not mention name and affiliation at the top as per template and make efforts to ensure that information about the authors identities/name/affiliation do not appear anywhere in the text-body of the paper. (for the Initial submission)
- Authors will be considered as mentioned in Easy Chair.
- Please limit your paper within 6 pages, and the size of your PDF file less than 2MB, files larger than 2MB will not be accepted for upload.
- Authors wishing to submit an over-length manuscript may do so. There will be an over-length page fee for authors and limited to an additional 2 pages (maximum page submission is eight (8) pages). This payment is required at the time of registration.
- All fonts must be embedded in the file.
- Authors can't be added or removed at later stage.
- Fonts that require non-English language support are not allowed.
- The document should not have any password protection.
- Do not put your own page numbers on the manuscript.
