

DIORAMA

Event Description

A scale or miniature model/ Diorama is most generally a physical representation of an object, which maintains accurate relationships between all important aspects of the model. This enables it to demonstrate some behaviour or property of the original object without examining the original object itself. The most familiar scale models represent the physical appearance of an object in miniature, but there are many other kinds. To be a true scale model, all relevant aspects must be accurately modelled, such as material properties, so the model's interaction with the outside world is reliably related to the original object's interaction with the real world. The Dioramas are then used for photograph modelling such that the photographs of the miniatures appear to be a real scale object. The effects are generated either optically when the photograph is taken, or by digital post processing. Many diorama effect photographs are taken from lower angles to simulate the effect of looking up on a miniature.

Material:

Each team will be provided with the following stationary- (4 boxes of Staplers pins: 2 small, 2 big; a sun board for base and backdrop, table, copper wires, cotton, green paint and brushes)

Setup:

1. Make a team of maximum 4 members.
2. Teams shall be provided with A1 size sheet, sun board, stationary, sculpting material.
3. Each team has to design an art form on their respective topic.
4. The art form should be able to depict the given topic or the art form can also depict the solution for the given topic (issue).
5. The time frame allotted is of 180 Minutes.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Each team can comprise of maximum 4 persons.
2. On the spot entries will not be entertained and prior registrations are compulsory.
3. Only the model would have to be assembled at the venue with materials provided. No extra time for concept formulation.
4. Photography shall be done by self-owned cameras/devices of participants. The submission of the photographs would be digital.
5. I-cards to be carried all the time during the event
6. Reproduction of existing ideas or designs will lead to disqualification.
7. Decision of the jury is final.
