

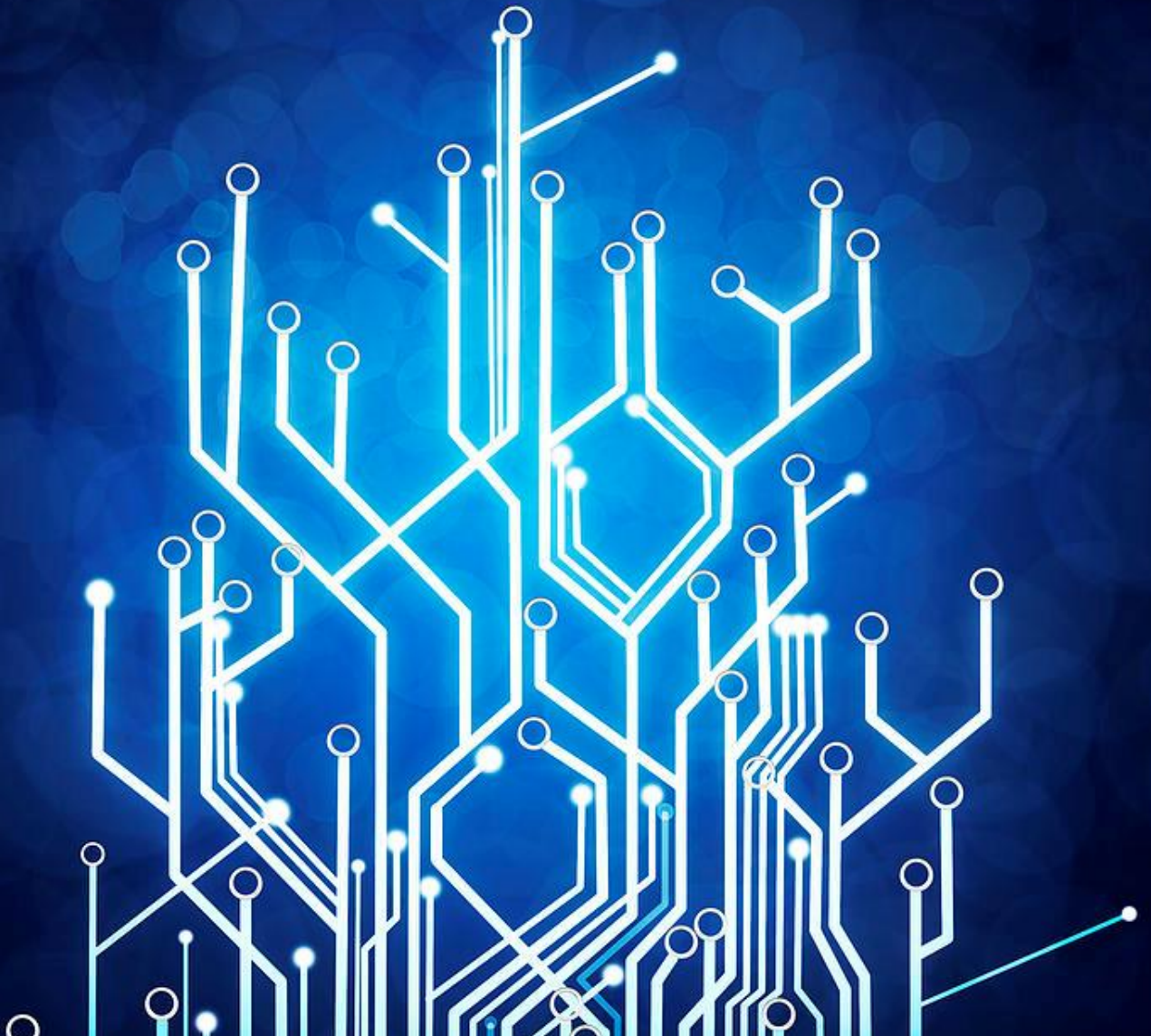

- Cloud Technology :- There are 3 times increase in monthly cost of renting in cloud industries have realized now that the efforts are taken for managing IT infrastructure is costing them a lot. Cloud is proving to be more efficient due to it's on demand nature. In near future more companies will be shifting their maximum processes on cloud.

- Advance Robotics :- There is 170% growth in the sales of industrial robotics and 12% manufacturing workers. In years to come Robotics driven manufacturing will appear more in trend.

- Autonomous & Near Autonomous Vehicles :- Google Car is the example of Autonomous Vehicle, whose efficiency can be judged that the car has travelled 3000000 miles with only one accident that was also due to human error.

- Genomics:- More work will be done in the area of Genomics in coming futures, people having knowledge of genome will

- 3D Printing, Augmented Reality and Virtual Reality :- use of 3D printing, AR and VR will be going to increase in the future. These technologies will be used in various sectors like construction, real estate, education etc.

- Advance Materials:- materials like nan tube are becoming cheap and replacing existing materials. Industry will be going to focus more on use of advance materials in future.

- Advance Oil & Gas Exploration:-new avenue's for oil and natural gas exploration will be found and work will be done in this area.

- Renewable Energy:- Renewal energy will be used more and more in near future, different sources will be identified and used.

How students will apply in real life:

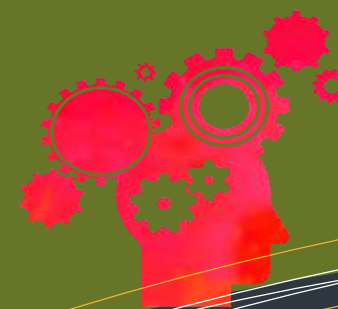
- Students gained knowledge on Design club.

Details of the activity:

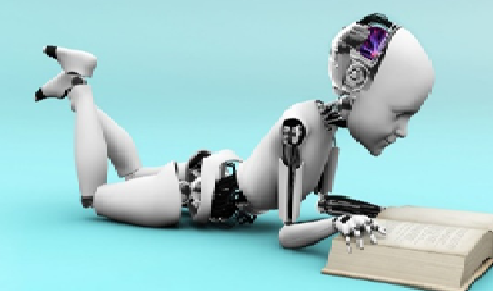

Methodology:

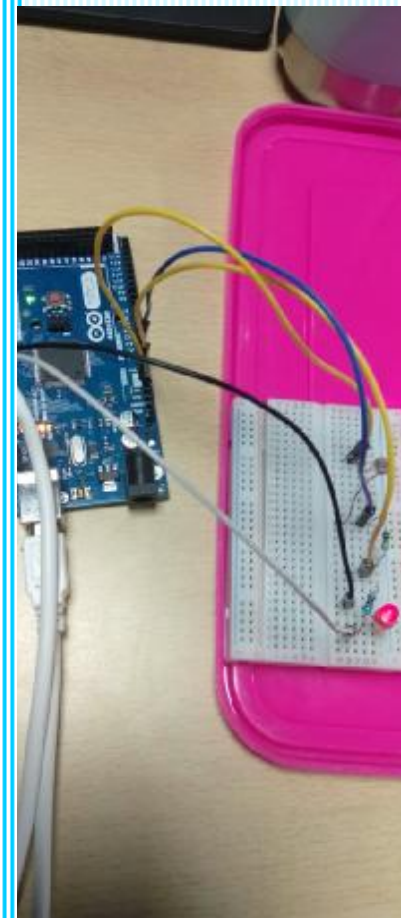
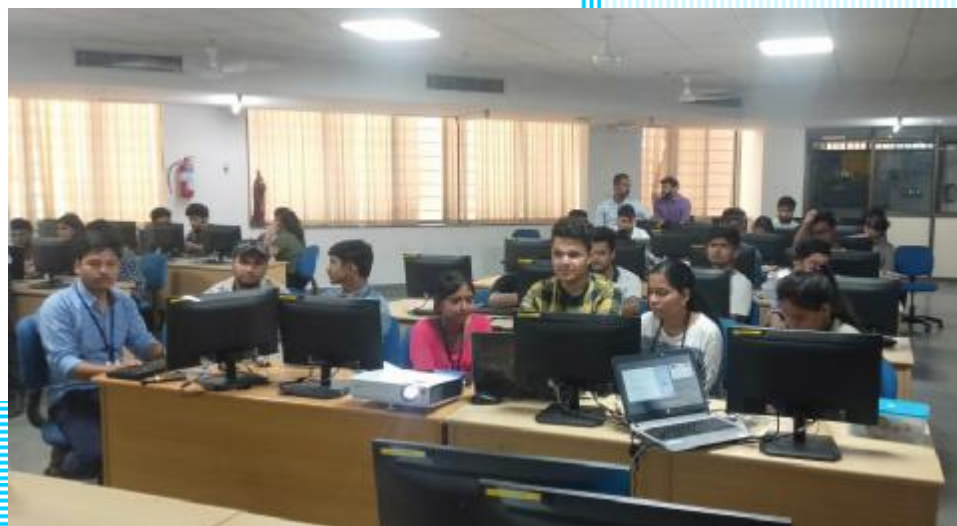
The students were introduced to IoT, sensor types and their applications through an interactive session with them. A hands-on session was also conducted with ARDUINO and the sensors for deeper understanding.

They presented how sensors can be used with in IoT and also in Artificial Intelligence.

Following are the hardwares used in the workshop: -

Arduino Mega 2560(Microcontroller), LED's and register, Ultrasonic sensor, PIR sensor, Keypad module, Relay module, L298N motor driver, Basic two-wheel drone chassis with 300 rpm DC motors.



At last they introduced a “Raspberry Pi” which is a microprocessor or minicomputer used for hardware projects. This facilitate various feature like Arduino but also has capability to install an Operating System in it. They concluded the session by giving a very descriptive presentation on “Flying Drones” and “UAV (Unmanned Aerial Vehicle)”.

He also covered the application of droned in the industryas well as in society. “Automated drones are capable of completing a wide range of applications. Automated drones can be used in oil & gas facilities for security, Surveillance, emergency response and infrastructure inspection. In sea ports, drones can perform applications such as mapping, surveying, operational oversight , and port monitoring and traffic control. In mining operations, drones can be utilized in stockpile management, tailing dams, inspection and more," he said.

The Internet business models are the basic

bilateral marketplace connecting group of buyers and a group of sellers via a technological intermediary like a website or mobile app for a transaction fee by making it easier, faster, or more powerful than the traditional method.

Ebay was the first major two-sided marketplace achievement by making it possible to buy and sell anything to anyone on the planet. Today, companies like Uber and Airbnb have made this space and model even more popular.

Airbnb has made it possible to book or rent out a room to/from anyone on the planet and Uber has made it possible by allowing its taxi drivers and passengers to find each other in real time. Companies like Ebay, Uber and Airbnb have enhanced upon the understanding and economics of the system and technology in place. Understanding the dynamics of bilateral marketplace businesses:

Understanding and fulfilling the below given sets makes a good investment in bilateral marketplace with high success rate.

- Does the marketplace offers a qualitatively better customer experience?
- Does it provide an economic advantage?
- Can the technology strengthen the marketplace and make it more powerful?
- The current market status – Organized or highly fragmented.
- The market size
- Market expandability
- Customers transaction frequency
- The Revenue model of the marketplace
- Network of externalities (Does adding to the network make the network more powerful?)

Uber is one of the fastest-growing and most debateable start-ups of Silicon Valley as it has always upset expectations.

BUSINESS MODEL OF UBER

The core value of any marketplace lies in reliability.

Business model of Uber is based on faster pickup times, more drivers on the road, and possibly lower prices for commuters. It has become more valuable by expanding its network and operations.

In a marketplace “supply” can meet “demand” either through a loosely-organized, semi-random process of discovery, or through a direct steering by a middleman.

Traditional cabs were dependent on taxi stands, centralized senders to find a fare and they have no other way to know where to go next as a result they only have a passenger in the car 30–50% of the time. (Poor Availability)

Also, cabs assemble in urban centres and high-transit areas, leaving outer divisions, suburbs, and other remote areas under served. Commuters in these areas are often unable to get a cab at all, or have to wait for a long. (Poor Supply)

Uber allows users to request and schedule their rides directly using the app. The nearest driver is forwarded to requested location, and user can be addressed again immediately after drop-off, creating:

- Better supply allocation for drivers.
- Higher supply for commuters.

The business model of Uber meets the fluctuating levels of demand with an optimal level of supply. It ramps up the prices in times of low supply and ensures that drivers are on the road and passengers are getting picked up.

Uber besides increasing the supply to high-demand areas also uses surge pricing that helps in regulating the customer demand, as those willing to pay a higher price will find the means of transportation, while others will have to opt for other means.

The dynamic or surge pricing helps in creating liquidity by providing a financial incentive to drivers for changing location. Drivers receive a notification about surge pricing status on or off for a specific location or area.

The Price discovery or the Surge (dynamic) pricing is one of the strong pillars of the Uber business model.

The autonomous self-driven vehicles could transform Uber’s business model further as it is already experimenting with AI and Deep Learning technologies. Uber is testing with strategies of adding more value onto its logistics network. The business model of Uber since inception has engaged in the same basic dynamics. The two biggest initiatives Uber Pool and Uber Eats are aimed in increasing the driver utilization.

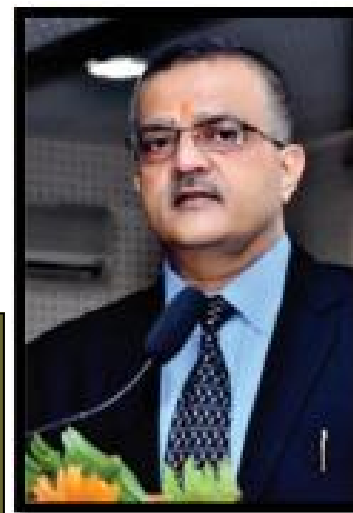
CHALLENGES AHEAD:

Business model of Uber is very capital efficient, but it continues to tussle with its costs. The Uber costs are driven by a number of factors:

1. Expansion Cost, the early mover advantage
2. Competing with established-capitalized local competitors.
3. Driver retention with high churn rate.

Network Externalities -

When the value of a technology, product, or service depends upon the number of other entities using it in other words the fringe social benefit of one more person joining the “network” is bigger than the marginal private benefit.

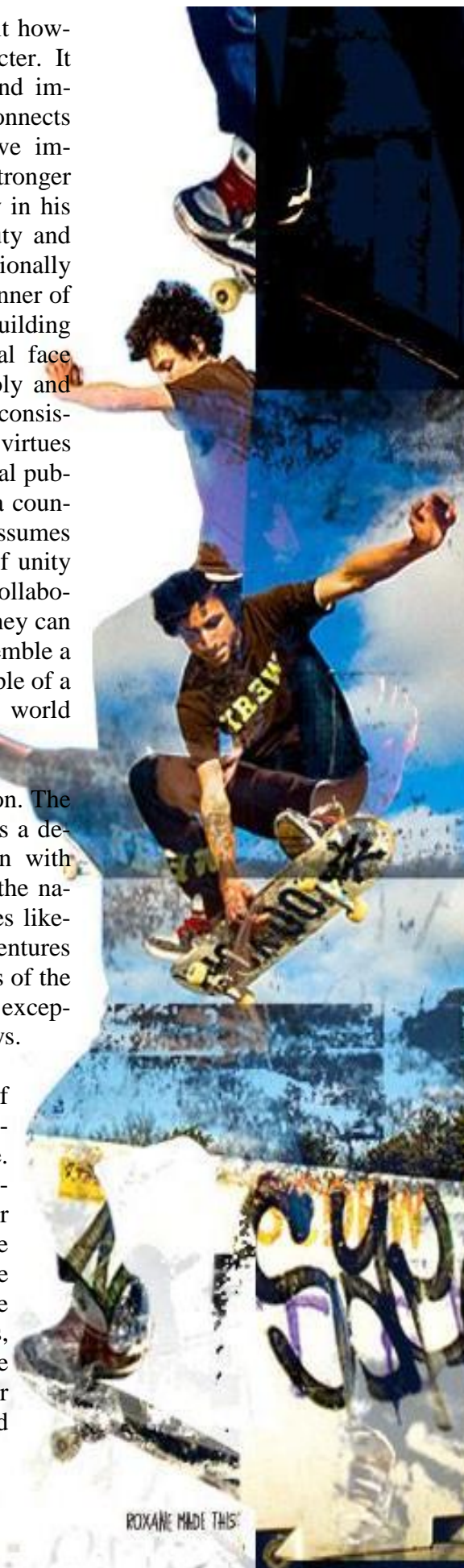

Huawei, reportedly, launching its own 'Google Maps' replacement in October



Huawei's slow untethering of itself from a reliance on Google, and specifically on Google's Android mobile operating system, is sort of underway now — “sort of” being the key phrase since it's still not clear if Huawei will stay cut off from Google indefinitely. But that's also why the company has gone ahead and worked up a homegrown OS that it says it can bring to its handsets eventually, if needed, as a replacement for Android.

Meanwhile, after having finally unveiled that OS in recent days, Huawei is apparently about to take another step forward in its great decoupling from Google. Next up is a reveal supposedly coming in October of Huawei's potential alternative to Google Maps, called Map Kit.

This news comes from the English-language, [state-run newspaper China Daily](#), which notes that Map Kit is-

n't meant to be used by consumers but is instead a solution for software developers to build applications based on Huawei's mapping technology.

Yandex, the so-called Google of Russia, as well as travel website Booking Holdings, are said to be among the companies teaming up with Huawei to use Map Kit, which will reportedly be available in multiple countries and some 40 languages. Zhang Pingan, president of cloud services at Huawei's consumer business group, told *China Daily* that among the features map kit will offer are real-time traffic conditions and “a highly sophisticated navigation system” that can spot a car changing lanes, as well as support for augmented reality mapping.

One of the immediate needs that became clear when Huawei finally revealed its HarmonyOS last week is

that it needs a correspondingly robust ecosystem of mobile applications for the OS to have any chance of taking hold at all. What Huawei is apparently planning with its Map Kit seems to be a way of addressing that — by providing a framework for software developers to tap into Huawei's mapping capabilities to build all manner of products.

For now, of course, this shouldn't be seen as some kind of move by Huawei to try and dethrone the pervasiveness of Google Maps. The company line out of Huawei is also, still, that it wants to keep working with Google. Map Kit would seem to be another backup tool in its assortment of multiple Plan B options should the company have to finally, officially, figure out a permanent post-Google future.
