3	Eligibility	(**Uploading of valid ID card is mandatory for AILF'20 registration)		
4		<ul> <li>Use of unparliamentary words and distasteful language will lead to disqualification</li> <li>Decision of the Jury will be final. No clarifications regarding judgment will be entertained.</li> <li>The virtual platform details will be shared on the registered email id. Participants are requested to enter the correct email id in the registration form.</li> <li>All participants will have to join the platform 20-30 minutes before the commencement of the activity and get themselves registered for their presence (Attendance).</li> <li>Not abiding by any of the instructions will lead to disqualification.</li> </ul> ACTIVITY SPECIFIC GUIDELINES Preliminary Round:- <ul> <li>The participants will be given a set of tunes 4 days prior to the submission day.
