
Sporting Achievements


BOOK COSMOS



The price of ice is here



Today we got our last ration of food from the government. Things are not good here in Syria. The Taliban and military are fighting constantly. The government is running out of resources. December 3, 10:30 pm

Amir and I have been using sign language to talk. We are trying to conserve our energy by not talking. Don't know if it will help that much...

December 17, 9 pm

We finally crossed the border! We are in Tajikistan now. My skin has turned yellow. I've puked four times already. But we found a packet of biscuits. At least I didn't pass out like yesterday. I don't want Amir to cry like he did yesterday.

December 25, 5 pm

My head has been throbbing for the past two hours. Amir touched my forehead and felt it was very hot. One of the persons in our migration group is a doctor. He checked my head and said something like, "She has pneumonia". It is a disease which has something to do with high fever and cold. I am staying away from Amir so he doesn't catch what I have.

December 31, 11 pm

This might be my last entry. Today is New Year's Eve. I wanted to celebrate it with Amir. But he'll have to start the New Year on his own. I reassured him by saying, "Don't worry. Ammi, Abu and I will be watching you from above." The doctor said I'll soon be reunited with Ammi and Abu. I know what that means. Goodbye dear diary. Goodbye world. Protect my little brother.
