## EVENT SUMMARY

The BUDINDIA-22 event was held on August 31st, 2022 by the Amity School of Communication's E-Cell, Spandan, to bring together young people, policymakers, academics, and businesses to explore how to unlock India's startup potential and provide more and better employment. It is a flagship annual event of Spandan, that aims to develop entrepreneurial mindsets.

More than 70 students attended the event, which was organized by the students of Journalism and Mass Communication (MJMC'23). The event commenced with the felicitation ceremony, where our faculty coordinator Dr. Ashima Singh along with Professor Debjani Roy Chowdhury presented saplings to welcome our guest speakers, Ms Vidushi Malhotra and Mr. Apoorv Bamba.

The hosts of the event Arushi Tandon and Rasleen Kaur welcomed Mr. Apoorv Bamba and Ms. Vidushi Malhotra on stage. Vidushi provided insights on her educational background along with her short stint as a budding filmmaker. During her entrepreneurial journey, she worked for a foundation on various sustainable projects in Bhutan for a year. She even taught in 15 countries and worked with grassroot communities. Further she gave a brief introduction about her first venture, "Startup Safari", which she founded side Apoorv.

After Vidushi, Apoorv took over the stage and began describing his journey. He quoted, " I have learnt the least in classrooms." He emphasized on the Power of Why and encouraged the audience to think out of the box. He has taught in 18 countries worldwide and is credited for designing courses for Master's in entrepreneurs for African Universities.

### **EVENT SUMMARY**

Vidushi enlightened the audience with the novel concept of Travel and Error, an idea that she followed in her journey, and encouraged the audience to embrace their failures as they always teach a lesson. Further, she conducted an interactive activity where the audience members were instructed to rank five basic life necessities in order of their priority. This was followed by another activity where the audience members paired up and interacted. This activity was focused on learning something new and getting to know each other.

Apoorv conducted an open discussion on the difference between being an entrepreneur and having an entrepreneur mindset. The discussion proceeded with Apoorv asking the audience members about their objectives. Next, he defined the link between employability and an entrepreneurial mindset with the help of a Powerpoint Presentation. He emphasized keeping oneself relevant and evolving creative skills rather than just focusing on obtaining a degree. He quoted,

#### "Belief creates the actual fact."

The guests conducted another activity which required the audience to team up in groups of 15 and build a sturdy bridge with the help of limited resourcesnewspapers, tape, and a pair of scissors. The motive behind conducting the said activity was to provide an experience of working under pressure with a huge group of people. He concluded the activity by quoting,

#### "Order comes from chaos."

In order to enforce the notion of thinking out of the box, another activity was conducted, which required the audience to solve a riddle, that was presented through a TedX video. The activity helped the audience in understanding the importance of creativity which in turn will lead to the constant evolution of the mind.

They introduced the audience members to their platform, Belong, which works with start-ups globally, and encouraged them to apply for the same.

The event concluded with a vote of thanks given by the hosts for the day.


