4. Event Guidelines

- Can include a blend of Contemporary, Classical, or Semi-Classical styles.
- Any genre and language allowed (Hindi, English, regional).
- Auto-tune and pre-recorded vocals are strictly prohibited.
- Background music allowed. Background track/Karaoke to be sent in MP3 format at least 48 hours before the event via a USB drive or email, as specified by the organisers.
- Live instruments permitted (participants must bring their own).
- If there are more teams than the permitted limit, an audition round will be conducted for elimination.

5. Judging Criteria

- Composition & Creativity – 25%
- Synchronisation & Coordination – 20%
- Expressions & Energy – 20%
- Stage Presence – 15%
- Overall Impact – 20%

6. Disqualification

- Participants must strictly adhere to the allotted time for their performance or presentation.

- Allowed language - English only (Mixed speech or regional languages are not allowed)
- Speech format - Topics will be given on the spot (participants will draw a chit).
- Mobile phones and notes are not allowed during the speech.

5. Judging Criteria

- Content & Relevance – 30%
- Clarity & Pronunciation – 25%
- Confidence & Body Language – 20%
- Fluency & Time Management – 15%
- Overall Impact – 10%

6. Disqualification

 - Reading from a script will lead to disqualification.
 - The topic will be announced 24 hours before the event.
5. Judging Criteria
 - Content & Argument Strength – 30%
 - Clarity & Language– 25%
 - Persuasiveness & Counterarguments – 20%
 - Confidence & Body Language – 15%
 - Overall Impact – 10%

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Eligibility

- Open to all registered students for the competition.

2. Team Composition

- Solo event - Individual participation.

3. Time Limit

Round 1: Direct Q&A

- Time Limit: 15 seconds per question (strict). Round 2: Theme-Based Round
- Time Limit: 20 minutes total (including transitions). Round 3: Buzzer Round (Clincher for Top 3 Teams)
- Time Limit: 15 minutes total. Final Round: Rapid Fire
- Time Limit: 20 minutes total (including transitions between teams)

4. Event Guidelines

Round 1: Direct Q&A

- Format:
 - Each team gets 5 questions (Total: 25 questions).
 - Questions alternate between teams.
 - General Questions (easy to moderate)
- Scoring:
 - Correct answer: +10 points
 - Wrong answer: -5 points (to discourage guessing).

Round 2: Theme-Based Round

 - >10 seconds to answer: -1 point (penalty for delay).

 - 15 minutes total. Final Round: Rapid Fire
- Format:
 - Each team gets 90 seconds to answer as many questions as possible.
 - Questions cover subjects they choose, but cannot select the same as in round 2.
- Scoring:
 - Correct answer: +1 point
 - Wrong answer: 0 points (no negatives).
- Time Limit:
 - 20 minutes total (including transitions between teams)
- The quiz will be conducted in English only. Participants are not allowed to use other languages.
- Mobile phones, smart-watches, other smart devices and reference materials are not allowed.

- Round 1: Direct Q&A - Correct answer: +10 points; Wrong answer: -5 points; Pass Question: 2 points
- Round 2: Theme-Based Round - Correct answer: +2 points; Wrong answer: -1 point; Pass Question: No points
- Round 3: Buzzer Round - Correct answer: +2 points; Wrong answer: -0.5 points; >10 seconds to answer: -1 point
- Final Round: Rapid Fire - Correct answer: +1 point; Wrong answer: 0 points (no negatives).

Round 1 – Idea Sprint

- Presentation Time: 3–4 minutes per team
- Preparation Time: 10 minutes
- Presentation Time: 3 minutes per team
- Preparation Time: 10-15 minutes
- Presentation Time: 5 minutes per team
- Pitch Time: 5 minutes per team
- Q&A Time: 3 to 4 minutes per team

4. Event Guidelines

- Round 1 – Idea Sprint
 - A theme/problem statement will be given one day prior.
 - The PPT must be prepared using the given template and submitted by 9.00 pm on 20th April. Late submissions may lead to a penalty or disqualification.
 - Teams must generate an innovative idea based on the given theme.
 - Only ideas with originality will be considered.
