At the outset, the Vice Chancellor welcomed all the members present and thanked them for being present for the meeting. After this he requested the Registrar to carry on with the proceedings of the meeting as per agenda.

Item No. AC 7.1: (a) To confirm the minutes of the Sixth Meeting of Academic Council held on 28 May 2013.

(b) Action taken on the Minutes of the Sixth Meeting.

The members, after a brief discussion, confirmed the minutes of sixth meeting of Academic Council held on 28 May, 2013 and also the action taken report on the same. Mentoring Program was discussed and it was decided that a workshop will be planned in December / January 2014.

Item No. AC 7.2: To review Admission status so far.

The matter was discussed in details and respective Directors / Dy. Directors and HOIs briefed the members about the number of students enrolled in the new programs and the current status. It was heartening to note that quite a reasonable number of students have enrolled for the recently introduced programs like Amity School of Hospitality (ASH), Amity School of Liberal Arts & Foreign Languages (ASLA) and Amity Institute of Design (AID) etc.

Item No. AC 7.3: To review the status of new Academic Programs introduced during 2013-14 session.

The word lateral was withdrawn from the agenda due to its mistaken inclusion.

The agenda was discussed at length as this was concerning all the Institutions / Schools / Departments. Prof B P Singh recommended that it is advisable to introduce a research program on Laser Technology rather than as an academic course. The issue about setting up a research based center including Laser, Nano Technology etc. which had been discussed earlier, was rediscussed and it was decided that the same (Advanced Centre for Science & Technology) will be taken forward in due courses.

Item No. AC 7.4: To recommend the Result of the Examination for Ex-post-facto Approval.

While reviewing the various activities included in conduct of the examination, it was pointed out that timely declaration of result is important.

On the issue of delay due to the non submission of marks by the faculty, it was felt that concerned Director's will have to take appropriate action on the matter and for future, respective Director's involvement would be appreciated.

It was also suggested that in the no dues certificate, a column must be created to be signed by the COE at the time of relieving any faculty on resignation / transfer etc. to confirm that all marks / score cards have been submitted.

Item No. AC 7.5: To review status of Patent & Research Activities Programs. Prof. SMP Khurana & Prof. AK Raghav to brief the members.

Prof. BP Singh suggested that this agenda item need not be included for discussion, but can be a reporting item, in order to avoid any complication in future. It was resolved that the Faculty Development Program for younger faculty will be strengthened.

Item No. AC 7.6: To review the current status of Scholarships

Registrar briefed members about the current status of scholarship.

Item No. AC 7.7: To review the status of Campus Placement of B. Tech Students. Dy. Director (CRC) to brief the members.

This was also proposed for deletion from Agenda Points as it is not directly concerned to Academic Council.

Item No. AC 7.8: Any other Agenda item with permission of the Chair.

Approval of new Programmes, Schools and Institutes for the Academic Session 2014-15.

- (a) List of Schools / Institutes Appx 'A'.
- (b) List of New Programs to be introduced Appx 'B'.
- (c) List of Programmes and Schools Appx 'C'.

Syllabi Revision for Academic Session 2014-15 is attached as per Appx 'D'

The Member Secretary read out the a/m appendices and after some discussions and deliberations the council accorded in principle approval for the same.

The Pro Vice Chancellor suggested that all necessary and relevant details must be worked out before any new program is projected / introduced by any Institution / School in future. This will include cost, expected student intake, availability of laboratories and availability of faculties. The Dy. Vice Chancellor remarked that space infrastructure must also be taken into account, as that could be a serious issue for next year.

Maj Gen (Retd.) VK Narang had requested for inclusion of certain agenda items related to Amity School of Engineering & Technology (ASET). The point that was accepted to be introduced was specialization in M.Tech Program for which he was requested to submit relevant details.

Mr Mehta proposed a one year program of two semesters in Broadcast Equipment Maintenance. The Pro Vice Chancellor suggested that Dy Director ASCO and Mr Mehta will do more research on this and submit report for final discussion. He was also advised by the Vice Chancellor to submit the entire project for approval by the Academic Council through PVC and VC.

Prof. Dube mentioned that an Integrated Program in M.Sc. Economics for 5 years duration may be considered in the next meeting.

The Council decided to include "Stem Cell and Gene Therapy" to be introduced as an optional subject in Amity Institute of Biotechnology - Masters Programs (M.Sc / M.Tech).

A proposal was made by Dr. J R Luthra for introduction of a new 5 years Integrated Program in Environmental Science & Management in ASEES. He was requested to submit the relevant details for discussion and approval.

After a vote of thanks to the chair, the meeting was declared closed.

At the outset Prof P.B. Sharma, Chairperson extended a very hearty welcome to the members. He addressed the members to apprise them of the achievements of the University since its last meeting as also the road ahead in future. His address included the following salient points:

Brief Report on Recent Initiatives at AUG

 A Centre of Excellence and Innovation in Biotechnology has been transferred to AUG from JNU by DBT, Govt of India with an outlay of Rs 2 Crores to Dr Rajendra Prasad, Director AIB based on his track record in Research and Innovations in Biological Sciences. This is a major breakthrough for AUG for Scientific Research and Innovation.

- An Interdisciplinary R&D Project on "Development of Prototype Chromium Filtration System Using Silica Based Chemibiosorbent matrix for Potable Water in Rural areas" has been submitted to DST for Rs 42 Lacs in June 2015. Principal Investigator: Dr Biswarup Sen of Biotechnology Co-PIs: Dr Kushagra Rajendra of ASEES and Dr Seema Pathak and Rakesh Kumar of ASAS. The Vice Chancellor / Chairperson informed the Hon'ble members of the Academic Council that around fifty new faculty members have joined the Amity University, Haryana; notably among them are:

Dr Rajendra Prasad, former Professor and Rector, Jawaharlal Nehru University, renowned Scientist and Sr Vice president INSA as Director of AIB.

Dr Brijesh Kumar, formerly at National University of Singapore as Professor and Head, Centre of Excellence in Nano Science & Technology in ASAS.

Dr Burra L Prasad, Ph.D. from IISc, Bangalore as Professor in AIB.

Dr Anek Pal Gupta, Former Professor, Polymer Science & Technology at Delhi Technological University as Professor and Head, Centre of Excellence in Polymer Science and Technology in ASAS.

Dr Sanjay K Jha as Professor of Linguistics and Director ASLA.

Dr R.K. Thakur as Associate Professor and Dy Director, ASAS.

Dr Archana Shukla as Professor and Director, AIBAS,

The Chairperson also emphasized on the following ideas and requested the members present (All HOIs / HODs) to actively look into the following aspects for betterment of the University:

- · Promotion of quality innovation and research to be encouraged.
- Creation of interest and motivate the faculty is required and HOIs to play an active role.
- Participation in Conference /seminar is to be encouraged.
- . HOIs to identify Five (5) good projects in which higher level of innovation has been done
- Faculty have to be more enthusiastic and HOIs/HODs to create the enthusiasm in them by encouraging to be more involved in research and publication.
- HOIs to conduct a reality check on the research publications before submission.
- HOIS must have regular dialogue with the Faculty as also students.
- All Faculty must start feeling excited about improved performance and research.
- · Internationalization have to be extended through more activities.

Following the address by the Chairperson, the Council took up the agenda items:

Item No 10.1: a)To Confirm the minutes of the Ninth Meeting of Academic Council held on October 28, 2014 b) Action taken on the minutes of the Ninth Meeting.

The Minutes of the Ninth meeting of Academic Council & Action taken report were confirmed by the Council. At this point of time the Chairperson suggested that the following senior officials may be invited

Item No 10.2: Report on the Status of Admission for session 2015-16

Dr Vikas Madhukar, Director (Admission) presented the basic data in connection with the current admission status as follows:

- 12 admission tests conducted sofar.
- 13th admission test is scheduled on August 17.
- 5846 applications were received (5811 in 2014).
- 3286 were selected as on date.
- 1408 students have taken admission so far (1544 in 2014).
- Except three schools where the percentage of students joining is deficient, other Institutes / schools have done well.

The Chairperson suggested that from the academic session of 2016-17 a final date may be decided by which date all admission forms may be submitted and the entrance test may be scheduled on a particular day after scrutiny of the application is completed. General Discussion and Personal Interaction can follow. He was also of the opinion that HOIs must be actively involved in admission process and devote enough time for this purpose. He also emphasized that the functioning of CRC is much below average and as a result the placement of the students is getting affected. He suggested that HOIs should get seriously involved with the placement activities of CRC also for better representation and placement.

Dr Padmakali Banerjee, Pro Vice Chancellor suggested that the admission of Amity Business School must be done before the normal schedule and she suggested December/January as the prime time for ABS admission. She requested all the HOIs / HODs to involve themselves in marketing and admission procedures more actively and depute the faculty to visit all the state capitals alongwith marketing personnel forspreading increased awareness about Amity University, Haryana among prospective students.

The Chairperson also informed that he had held a meeting with senior officials of Prasar Bharti for linking up their National Academies and all Amity Institutions in the country for mutual benefit.

Some members expressed their concern about the time gap between the date of Entrance Test and the declaration of results which cause many students to take up admission in other Universities/Institutes. They pointed out that an impression is gaining ground that admission is always available as the University doors are always open. This impression must be done away with and hence the entire schedule of admission process must be specific and adhered to strictly. The Council members agreed to these points and requested Director (Admissions) to consider the same seriously.

Item No 10.3: Update on Syllabi of Programs to be introduced in 2015-16

After a brief discussion, the Member Secretary informed the Council that the detailed syllabi which were deliberated during the 9th Academic Council meeting have been submitted to the authorities at DGHE office.

Item No 10.4: To review the result of Examination 2014-15.

The Controller of Examinations made a brief power point presentation to the members and the general observation was that the results of most of the Institutes /schools was not encouraging. The Chairperson expressed his concern over this matter. Most of the members including the Pro Vice Chancellor felt that this has happened because of lack of internal monitoring of internal marks and not keeping a tab on the progress of each student periodically.

The Chairperson mentioned that the following three components need to be monitored by the HOIs/HOD to provide better result:

- · Students Attendance in the class
- Number of classes held as per calendar
- · Internal Assessment
- Analysis of result by the HOIs regularly.

The Members felt that the results must certainly not be less than 80% to 90% in Professional courses and other subjects must have a progress of 70% to 80%. However, Prof SMP Khurana was of the opinion that overall results are bad due to the student's lack of interest in attending value added courses, not attending the classes, not interested in exams and thus the overall results look poor.

Item no 10.5: Recommendation of Number of Teachers to be appointed

The Registrar mentioned to the members that as per the list 55 positions of Faculty were to be recruited across the schools and that the major portion of the recruitment has been completed. Some members mentioned that some additional faculty will now be required. The Chairperson requested them to send their requirement to HR for doing the needful. The appointment of 55 faculty for 2015-16 was approved.

Item no 10.6: Report of Deputy Dean, Academic on academic activity of the Academic Session 2014-15 and for AS 2015-16.

Dr Bhavana Adhikari, the Deputy Dean, Academics circulated a report to the Chairperson and other members. She also briefly mentioned the salient features of the report which included:

- AUG at a Glance.
- Faculty of Studies & List of Schools for the Academic Session 2016-16 attached as Appx 'A'.
- New programs introduced for the Academic Session 2015-16 attached as Appx 'B'.
- List of Programmes & Schools for Academic Session 2015-16 attached as Appx 'C'.

- Computer Forensics and Cyber Security.
- · Military Training Foundation.
- Technology Enhancement.
- Skill Development Program.
- Recent Major Events.

The Pro Vice Chancellor mentioned that the accreditation process by CRISIL was conducted recently which is a prestigious accreditation agency in the country and that this will also add to the academic excellence. The Director, AIB & AISHE mentioned that excellence must be justified and to do so visibility, recognition and address to the cause of Academic dedication of faculty and staff are to be total. The Chairperson suggested the following necessities for achieving excellence:

- Address to the cause of Academic Excellence.
- Address to the Global Cause.
- Assessment and Integration.
- · Industry Readiness.
- · Process of assessment.
- Achieving global eminence through Research, Innovation and Relevance.

At this stage, the Director, AIB remarked that for each Institution / school funds for research should be allocated every year. No activity can take place if basic funding is not made available for research. The Chairperson agreed to this suggestion and agreed to take it up further with the competent authority.

Item No 10.7: To ratify the Academic Calendar for the Academic session 2015-16

The Academic calendar for Odd & Even semesters for the academic Year 2015-16 was approved by the Council

Item No 10.8: To Report on the achievements, ranking, recognitionand accreditation awarded to AUH

The Chairperson remarked that the list is quite impressive. Members congratulated Prof Khurana for having been awarded Sir J.C.Bose Memorial Medal by the Hon'ble Prime Minister for his exemplary contribution to the area of Plant Pathology.

The Dy. Dean Academic added that Amity University, Haryana has also signed a number of MOUs on Skill sectors as also with their principal NSDC, which should find a mention in this list. The members noted the remark with appreciation.

Item No 10.9: Annual Progress Report

The Chairperson remarked that the Annual report was prepared in a hurry and the same needs to be redrafted with more inputs as per following:

Item No 10.10: To consider and approve induction of a new Course" Skill Enhancement Course" in the model framework of various Program groups of the existing and New Batches.

The Chairperson remarked that during the meeting of Executive Council of AUUP, NOIDA, he chanced upon this item in the agenda and advised the Registrar to include it in the agenda as he found the same very relevant.

The Dy Dean, Academics informed the members that skill based courses are already included in the Flexi credit system under track items. The Chairperson suggested that the details of such programs may be forwarded to the Secretary, Academic Council.

Item No 11.11: To Formulate additional Guidelines

The Chairperson informed that this item was also included from the agenda item of the Executive Council meeting of the AUUP. He informed the members that he has already constituted two committees to prepare relevant guidelines under two broad categories of Academic (headed by the Pro Vice Chancellor) and Administrative (headed by the Dy. Vice Chancellor).

Gurgaon

The Pro Vice Chancellor mentioned that she will be able to discuss the detailed guidelines under her purview only during the next Academic Council meeting. Dy Vice Chancellor informed that he had already held the first meeting of the committee and assigned members of the committee to prepare the first draft of the Guidelines on or before August 31. Once the same is finalized (expected by Mid-September), he will submit the same to the Vice Chancellor, AUH.

Item No 10.12: Any other item with the permission of the Chair

The Dy Director, ABS informed that there are some marks improvement cases in ABS, which can be categorized as borderline and they want another opportunity to appear for a supplementary examination for improving their marks.

The Chairperson felt that our Examination policy needs amendment on certain provisions and rectify the anomaly. The matter needs to be looked into by the COE and other senior officials.

The Registrar placed an application received from three pass out students of MAE dept. (received through Dr A.K. Raghav) stating that they missed out on an employment opportunity as the concerned PSU wanted graduates from mechanical Engineering department and not from MAE dept.

The matter was discussed at length. Members expressed their anguish over the statement of the pass out students. Many members voiced their concern and after due deliberation, the Academic Council passed the following resolution:

"The Academic Council of Amity University Haryana in its tenth meeting resolved that the existing Academic program namely" Mechanical & Automation Engineering" should be reclassified as "Mechanical Engineering" as the same nomenclature of Mechanical Engineering is used by all leading Technological Institutes and Universities like IITs.

Since it has been brought to the notice of the Academic Council that students have been denied employment because of the difference in nomenclature alone, the Council unanimously decided to adopt this resolution effective from the academic session 2015-16 and the students of this batch will be awarded Degree in Mechanical Engineering alone"

There being no other points for discussion, the meeting was declared closed after exchanging thanks to and from the chair.

At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the members. He then spoke about the important milestones that have been achieved by AUH during the period from January to July 2016.

B. Proposal for an Innovation Incubator has been submitted to the Government of India. Under the scheme, the Government of India will fund Rs. 10 crore to the University for setting up the Incubator.

C. Publications: The figure of 1956 publications is very satisfactory but all faculties must be encouraged to publish more research publications. The faculty must also keep a watch on the progress of H index.

D. More Patents must be prepared and submitted by the faculty. It is the vision of our Hon'ble Founder President that more patents will bring out more success and achievement and all of us should work to achieve that success.

E. Centre of Excellence: ASET has already entered into an MOU with CARDEA laboratories for Biomedical Instrumentation and Signal Processing. This will be a Centre of Excellence in the same areas.

F. Interdisciplinary Activity:

 A centre for innovation in creative writing is being established by ASLA with active support from Prof. Yuyutsu R.D. Sharma of Columbia University.

- II. A 15 credit diploma program in Molecular Medicine and Stem Cell Therapy is being proposed which will be in collaboration with RUTGERS University USA and New York Medical College, USA.
- III. A publication from Dr. Rajendra Prasad has been published in a very highly acclaimed Bio-chemical Journal and also the core area of research is on the front page of the journal. The council appreciated and applauded Dr. Prasad for his achievements both as an individual and as Director of AIB.
- G. The Chairman then presented the details of faculty and non teaching staff who have joined between January and June 2016 and also those who have resigned during that period.

H. Events:

- I. During the last convocation held on 6th February, 2016 Honorius Causa was conferred to Mr. Sunil Bharti Mittal, founder of Airtel and Mr. Vijay Shekhar Sharma, founder of PayTM. The following eminent academicians were also honored with Honorary Professorship:
 - Dr. Amitabh Chatopadhayay
 - Dr. Ramashankar Verma
 - > Dr. Dariush Rafinejad
 - > Dr. Debabrata Banerjee
 - Dr. Ulrike Zeshan
- II. A workshop on creative writing was conducted by ASLA under the guidance of Prof Yuyutsou R.D. Sharma of Columbia University.
- III. Guest lectures on corporate connect were organized by ABS,
- IV. An International Conference on Stem Cell Research was conducted and supported by RUTGERS University, USA. This conference generated Rs. 2 Lacs for the University.
- V. International Affairs Office had organized International Guest speaker series during the period.
- VI. Eminent speakers were invited from India and abroad for delivering lectures to the faculty and students on various subjects.
- VII. ALS conducted the first Moot Court competition which was a grand success.
- VIII. A workshop was conducted by NDTV for ASCO.
- IX. Asia Pacific Young Scientist Conference (APYSC) was conducted between 13th and 18th July. Delegates and young scientists from 15 countries participated in the conference. This conference also generated Rs. 3lacs for the University. AUH also conferred Honorary Fellowship to Dr. Roberto and Dr. Monika Raharti.
- X. Our faculty also attended various conferences, workshops and seminars at various Universities and Research Institutions in the country and abroad.

- XI. During the recent Orientation Program there were various guest lectures including that of Dr. Subash Jagota and Prof. DP Aggarwal, former chairman UPSC.
- XII. So far 1184 admissions has been reported but the Chairman was of the opinion that the figure must be much higher than this and we must reach our objectives in this regard.

He also requested all the HOI's to be present during the admission test held at AUH from time to time.

After this he requested the Registrar to take up the agenda items:

Item No. AC 12.1

A. To confirm the minutes of Eleventh meeting of the Academic Council held on 29th January 2016.

After a brief discussion the minutes of the Eleventh meeting of Academic Council was approved. It was informed to the Council that B.Ed / M.Ed.has not been approved by NCTE as yet and also there is a ban by the State Government to introduce new B.Ed Institutions in the State of Haryana.

B. Action taken on the Minutes of the Tenth Meeting.

The action taken report was also approved by the Council.

Item No. AC 12.2: To obtain the approval of the Members for Ph.D. award to three Ph.D. scholars.

The members after due deliberation recommended approval of Ph.D. degrees to the following scholars:

- 1. Ms. Priyanka Singh, ECE, ASET, guided by Dr. Priti Singh
- 2. Ms. Madhupriya, AIB, guided by Prof. SMP Khurana
- 3. Ms. Shikha Khandelwal, AIB, guided by Prof. SMP Khurana

However, while discussing the PhD awards, following points emerged:

- A brief note should be annexed to the agenda about the person(s) on whom the degree is to be conferred.
- II. It was also pointed out that Academic Council is a body which is empowered by the University Act to scrutinize and recommend all the proposals related to academics, examination etc.
- III. Before the agenda is submitted to the members, Registrar must discuss the same with the PVC and VC positively.

IV. A standard template of front page of PhD thesis must be devised and sent to all the members for their kind concurrence. Similarly, thesis for Master's Degree and M.Phil. degree should be standardized as far as the title page; inside page etc. are concerned. The members applauded the recommendation of the members to confer the PhD Degrees to all the three recipients.

Item No AC 12.3: Approval of syllabi for two new programmes to be introduced in 2017-18 and revision of some syllabi of courses already undertaken.

The council approved the syllabi of two new programs to be launched by AIBAS, namely, Masters in social work and M.Phil. in Clinical Psychology. The Director, AIBAS informed that approval of RCI has been obtained for the M.Phil. (CP) course and it has been made clear that annual examinations is required to be conducted for this course which is mandatory as per RCI rules.

As the syllabi of M.Phil. (CP) was submitted in a different format, the council approved the same but advised Director, AIBAS to impress upon RCI to accept the semester system. The Director, AIBAS mentioned that only few cosmetic changes have been made in the revised syllabi submitted to the Council but overall it follows the RCI syllabus in totality.

Following this, proposed revision of syllabi of some courses were discussed.

The Director ASET informed the council that the existing program structure and curriculum of M.Sc. (NT&M) program was received and changes suggested as per the recommendation of BOS.

Director ASET also sought approval of the Council for revision of curriculum for B.Tech (AE) program as per the recommendations of the BOS. The Council after due deliberation approved both the proposals from ASET.

Maj.Gen. Dr. Mahavir Singh of AMS then presented the recommendation of BOS for revision of syllabi of six programs and the same was discussed and approved by the Academic Council.

Dr. R.K. Thakur, Deputy Director, ASAS, and then proposed revision in the syllabi of Physics, Chemistry, Biochemistry and Forensic Science as recommended by the BOS. After due deliberation, the Council approved the revision of syllabus.

Dr. SK Jha, Director, ASLA, then submitted the proposal of BOS for few additions and changes in the curriculum for BA English (H) and MA (English) and two other programs which were discussed and approved by the Council.

The Council also approved the following courses to be introduced during 2017-18 based on proposals submitted by the respective institutions:

- 1. M.Tech program on "Atmospheric Technology and Climate Management" by ASEES.
- 2. M.Tech program in "Nano Technology" of ASAS.

The Director ALS informed that as suggested by the 11th Academic Council, the BOS was reconstituted for ALS and its meeting held on March 2nd, 2016 which proposed revision of syllabi after a review of the BOS. The council approved the revision in syllabi of ALS.

Item No. AC 12.4: To brief the Council about impending visit of UGC expert team and our preparation level till now.

The Chairman informed the Council that the Expert Team constituted by the University Grants Commission will be visiting AUH on 9th & 10th of September. He reminded that he has held two meetings in this connection, where most of the council members were also present.

Item No. AC 12.5: Any other item with permission of the chair.

- A. At this point the Chairman pointed out that Hon'ble Chancellor is worried that while we announce the course, the intake is either nil or very minimal. The gap must be bridged and at some point of time if the same situation continues we have to discontinue with such courses. At this point, the PVC intervened and suggested that all such courses must be reviewed and a final decision taken. Prof. Prasad suggested that we should not be in a rush to start any course unless infrastructure, availability of faculty and market demands are assessed properly. Director, ASET suggested that minimum number of student's intake for any program should be fixed and maintained.
- B. The Chairman than suggested that there should be a threshold of minimum number of students in each course and the council adopted the following parameters:
- ➤ B.A., B.Sc.; min. 10; desirable 30
- B. Tech; min. 10; desirable 30
- BCA; min. 10; desirable 30
- BBA; min. 10; desirable 30
- M.Sc.; min. 5; desirable 10
- M.tech; min. 5; desirable 10
- LLM; min. 5; desirable 10
- M.A.; min. 5; desirable 10
- LLB; min. 10; desirable 30
- M.Phil.; min. 5; desirable as per approval of regulatory authorities

Prof. Kiran Devendra remarked that AUH library does not have enough books for the students and faculty. The chairman suggested that all Institutions and School must prepare fresh list of books of standard quality and send to the library for its processing.

Based on a suggestion of Director, ASET, it was resolved that the program currently known as "Construction Management" should be changed as "Construction Technology & Management".

- C. The Pro-Vice Chancellor informed that for the final year students, supplementary examinations for those who have not secured passing grades, or were debarred/detained from appearing in any examination and those who have made up the deficiency in attendance as per provisions of these regulations, will normally be held within thirty days after the declaration of results of the final Semester examinations. For this purpose, the students of one year courses shall be deemed as final year students. The eligible students will get one time chance for internal assessment improvement. Such students will have to appear in supplementary external examinations as well.
- D. It was informed that the following tracks with the minimum credit requirement are also available to the students:

- H. Chairman and PVC clarified the methodology adapted for carrying out the cadre review of the faculties as per UGC norms.

There being no other items for discussion, the meeting was declared closed after exchanging greetings between the chair and the members.

The Chairman stated that prior to starting the AC meeting he would like to introduce leading structural Biologist of International repute to the august gathering who are with us today to address a high impact Seminar at AUH. He then welcomed Prof (Dr) T P Singh, Distinguished Professor at AIIMS, himself a leading structural Biologist Scientist and complimented him for his distinguished contributions to medical education. Thereafter Prof (Dr) T P Singh introduced the visiting scientists as follows:

- (c) Prof Peter Tompa, Professor of Biochemistry, VIB SBRC, Brussels, Belgium.

The members of the Academic Council warmly greeted Professor Singh and the distinguished visiting scientists. The Chairman while expressing his delight at the august presence of the visiting scientists, remarked that in todays bioscience led scientific revolution, we are looking at miraculous solutions to monumental problems such as waste water treatment, solid waste recycle and conversion of useful fuel and nutrients for agricultural use, creating abundance of energy and for cleaning the atmospheric air besides a formidable support to major advancement of medical sciences to assure immunity from deadly diseases and viruses.
