SUSTAINABLE INVESTMENT POLICY

Title:	:	Sustainable Investment Policy

Purpose of this Policy	:	The purpose of this policy is to ensure environmental sustainability and deliver social responsibility
Date of Incorporation	:	September 2019
Date of Review	:	Once in three years. This can also be reviewed as per the requirement of University

BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE

The Amity University Haryana (AUH) mandates for creativity and innovation to contribute to the progress of humanity through excellence in education and ensure environmental sustainability and deliver social responsibility. University invests its assets responsibly and ethically with approach of Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) integration.

SECTION 2: SCOPE

The policy provides guidelines to effectively supervise, monitor, and evaluate considering the Environmental, Social, and Governance-related (ESG) insights to improve long-term outcomes.

SECTION 3: POLICY STATEMENT

- (a) University considers long-term perspective in its investment, and incorporates environmental sustainability, social responsibility, and corporate governance factors.
- (b) The Sustainability is the main focus while investing into the resources required for the university. University takes cognizant of the impact of environmental changes, and the need for the world to transition to a greener and more sustainable environment in pragmatic ways to support this transition.
- (c) University considers combination of negative and positive screens to ensure that companies that may be harmful to society or the environment are excluded and to invest in businesses with responsible culture, practices and good governance.

(d) University investment is aligned with mandate that supports UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and other frameworks and provide impetus to the business sectors critical (Renewable energy, Sustainable transport, Waste management etc.) to Nationally Determined Commitment (NDCs) of India to meet Paris climate change targets.

- (e) University periodically review the asset management, value and use the investment to ensure sustainable investment and integrate in campus investment in the areas aligned in para (d)

SECTION 4: PROCEDURE

The Board of Management will be the authority for execution of the Sustainable investment policy.
