Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's Administrative Approval No. MeitY/IPR/TIDE/16(1)/2017 dated 01.02.2019 conveying the approval of the Competent Authority to the implementation of the "Technology Incubation and Development of Entrepreneurs (TIDE) 2.0" Scheme at 51 Institutes of higher learning and premier R&D Organisations with a total budgetary outlay of Rs.264,62,00,000/-(Rupees Two Hundred Sixty Four Crores and Sixty Two Lakhs only) to be released as grants-in-aid over a period of five years.

- 2. As per the Scheme, financial support proposed to the start-ups through the TIDE 2.0 Centres is primarily divided into three components, namely, Entrepreneur-in-Residence (EiR), Grant and Investment for ideation, prototype development and brining product to market. Out of the three components of support, EiR and Grant are provisioned to be released by the respective TIDE 2.0 Centres. The proposals for the third component i.e. investment, as received by the respective TIDE 2.0 Centres would be forwarded to Ministry of Electronics & IT (MeitY) for critical evaluation. Based on the evaluation by MeitY, an expert Committee will finally recommend the investment proposals for further support. Thereafter, the disbursal for investment support for startups (upto Rs.40,00,000/) along with the support/management cost (upto Rs.4,00,000/-) will be released to the respective TIDE Centre.

- As per ibid Administrative Approval, 1st year amount earmarked under the scheme is to be disbursed in two instalments keeping 40% as advance instalment and 60% as 2nd instalment subject to submission of utilization certificate (UC) of previous release along with statement of Expenditure and based on PRSG recommendations. The progress of the centre has been reviewed by the duly constituted PRSG in its 1st meeting held on 15th, 19th and 20th October, 2020. As per Minutes of Meeting, PRSG has recommended to release of grants-in-aid as the centre has exhausted more than 90% of funds released as 1st installment amounting to Rs.13,60,000/- (Rupees Thirteen Lakh Sixty Thousand Only) released vide sanction letter no. MeitY/IPR/TIDE/16(38)/2019 dated 17.01.2020. Amity Innovation Incubator, Gurugram has submitted utilization certificates in respect of more than 90% of the amount.
- Therefore, sanction of the President of India is hereby conveyed to the release of Rs. 19,80,000/- (Rupees Nineteen Lakh Eighty Thousand only) as second installment of Grants-in-aid (General) after the adjustment of unspent balance of Rs.60,000/- to Amity Innovation Incubator, Gurugram for the year 2020-21 for the implementation of TIDE 2.0 Scheme. With this, the progressive releases made for the implementation of the project will be Rs. 33,40,000/- (1st installment of Rs. 13,60,000/- Current release Rs. 19,80,000/-)
- 6. The grants in-aid will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in the Terms and Conditions of Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. The Grants-in-aid is also subject to the Chapter 9 of the General Financial Rules, 2017, as amended from time to time, read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there under, and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard, and in particular to the following conditions:

i) All relevant information and documents/certificates as required under GFR 230(1) have been received.

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's Administrative Approval No. MeitY/IPR/TIDE/16(1)/2017 dated 01.02.2019 conveying the approval of the Competent Authority to the implementation of the "Technology Incubation and Development of Entrepreneurs (TIDE) 2.0" Scheme at 51 Institutes of higher learning and premier R&D Organisations with a total budgetary outlay of Rs.264,62,00,000/- (Rupees Two Hundred Sixty Four Crores and Sixty Two Lakhs only) to be released as grants-in-aid over a period of five years.

- 2.0 TIDE 2.0 Scheme aims to promote tech entrepreneurship through empowering 51 incubators and handholding close to 2000 tech start-ups in India over a period of 5 years in selected areas of national concern. The seven areas of national concern have been identified as Healthcare, Education, Agriculture, Financial inclusion including digital payments, Infrastructure and transportation, Environment and clean tech, clean energy. These Incubation Centres have been categorized into 3 distinct groups, namely, Group 1 Centre (GIC), Group 2 Centre (G2C) and Group 3 Centre (G3C) with specific numbers viz.6, 25 and 20 respectively.
- 2.1 The Sub-Committee of the Empowered Committee constituted with the approval of the Competent Authority in its meeting held on 22.07.2019 shortlisted group-wise 41 nos. of Centres to be supported under TIDE 2.0 Scheme, a list of these Centres is enclosed at **Annexure-I.** The recommendations of the Sub-Committee have been approved by the Empowered Committee.
- 2.2 As per the Scheme, financial support proposed to the start-ups through the Group 3 TIDE 2.0 Centres is primarily divided into two components, namely, Entrepreneur-in-Residence (EiR) and Grant.

Terms & Conditions for Grant-in-Aid

The grant is for the specific project as approved by Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY) and shall be subject to the conditions listed below. The proposal originating industry and grantee institution shall give an undertaking that they agree to be governed by these conditions.

- 1. The grant amount shall be i) spent for the project within the specified time; and ii) Any portion of the grant, which is not ultimately required for expenditure for the approved purposes, shall be duly
- 2. The grantee institution shall maintain an audited record in the form of a register in the prescribed proforma for permanent, semi-permanent assets acquired solely or mainly out of MeitY grant;
- 3. The assets referred to in (2) above will be property of MeitY and should not, without prior sanction of MeitY, be disposed off or encumbered or utilized for the purposes other than those for which the
- 4. At the conclusion of the project, MeitY will be free to sell or otherwise dispose of the assets which are the property of MeitY and grantee institution shall render to MeitY the necessary support for facilitating the sale of these assets;


