

- 4. Mobilization for participants shall be done by each centre through newspaper advertisement and website. However other media such as radio, roadshow, digital marketing etc. may also be used for the same. A transparent mechanism of selection of trainees be adopted by them, which should properly be documented.



- 1 The organizations should acknowledge receipt of the recognition letter by stating that they will abide by the terms and conditions of recognition.




