He described some of the incidents that occurred during the freedom movement. "Peaceful coexistence among all communities is necessary for our nation to remain whole and strong, otherwise we could be in trouble," he concluded.

A GUEST LECTURE ON "MEDIA TRIALS: A BARRIER TO THE NATURAL JUSTICE SYSTEM"

On March 22, 2022, a guest lecture entitled "Media Trials: Hindrance to the Natural Justice System" was conducted by the Amity Law School of Amity University Gurugram with Mr. R.H.A. Sikander, an accomplished industry professional and Supreme Court of India advocate. The speaker began the lecture by stating that the two principles of the justice system, Nemo Judex Causa Sua and Audi Altrem Partem, can never be ignored. He then explained the meaning of the term "trial by media" as a predetermined outcome of an ongoing case. He referred to the case of R.K. Anand v. Registrar H.C. of Delhi, where the three-judge bench of the Hon'ble Supreme Court observed that the expression "media trial" means the intense impact of television and newspaper coverage on a person's reputation by creating a widespread expression of guilt. "This is akin to mob lynching, and the accused is not able to live their further lives without public scrutiny", he said.

He further said that, in today's society, the media, under the guise of investigative journalism, which conducts its own independent inquiry, shapes public opinion is against the accused even before the court takes the matter under consideration and renders a verdict. The speaker argued that while the value of a free press in a democracy cannot be disputed, the real question is: to what extent? He emphasized the need to keep in mind that the Constitution's rights to freedom of speech and expression are subject to legitimate limitations, one of which is contempt of court. Mr. Sikander said that the presumption of innocence of the accused is the basic rule of natural justice, and the media houses should not infringe on this protection granted to the accused.

He asserted that is why media should not be barred from reporting cases, but it should be very cautious in reporting and interpreting the facts of a sub judiciary case. He concluded by referring to the autobiography of Mr. Fali Nariman, "Before Memory Fails," wherein it has been clarified that the media should give both sides an equal opportunity to be heard. He advised the students to make wise decisions when they browsed the content on various news channels, noting that the media had to focus on accountability standards. The session coordinator concluded the session by expressing his gratitude towards the participants, faculty, and staff members for contributing to the success of the event.

NASA-AERONET CIMEL SUN-SKY MULTI-SPECTRAL RADIOMET

In a collaborative research effort, a global network station of NASA AERONET (AErosol RObotic NETwork) site has been successfully established in May 2017 on the roof-top of Academic Block-A of Amity University Haryana, Panchgaon-Manesar-Gurugram for regional air quality and climate research (Figure 1). The valuable data sets (column-integrated aerosol optical depth, aerosol size distribution, aerosol refractive index, finemode and coarse-mode aerosol fractions, single scattering albedo, phase function, asymmetry parameter, water vapor, effective radius and current satellite and long-range transport model trajectories) from this real-time sun-sky radiometer provide understanding of almost complete characterization of aerosols over different environments. These real-time, network observations yield radiative forcing due to aerosols and various gases to the earth-atmosphere radiation balance, which plays a vital role in

climate change. These datasets have also been found valuable for developing models for forecast purpose and for calibrating/validating the satellite sensors (Holben et al., 1998; Giles et al., 2019; Vijayakumar et al., 2018, 2020). MAIA AMOD SAMPLER FOR SPACEBORNE HEALTH STUDIES

As a part of the CAL-VAL Program of NASA's satellites, a Network of Citizen-Enabled Aerosol Measurements for Satellites (CEAMS), involving MAIA (Multi-Angle Imager for Aerosols Investigation) AMOD (Aerosol Mass and Optical Depth) samplers are being installed by Emory University Rollins School of Public Health, Atlanta, Georgia, USA at different Suitable locations all over the globe. The ACOAST-AUH has been selected as one of the sites in this global network. The IIT-D is coordinating these installations in India. Very recently, a MAIA AMOD sampler has been installed (Figure 2), co-located with the existing NASA-AERONET instrument, which has been operating for the past more than 4 years on the terrace of Academic Block-A of AUH. The data from MAIA AMOD would improve our understanding of how

aerosols affect local air quality, visibility, and human health through the connections between AOD and fine particulate matter of PM2.5
