



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

CRC CARE, AUSTRALIA

and

AMITY UNIVERSITY HARYANA, INDIA

- The Cooperative Research Centre for Contamination Assessment and Remediation of the Environment (CRC CARE), Australia and Amity University Haryana (AUH), India wish to collaborate to establish a node of global contamination assessment and remediation enterprise (globalCARE) at AUH in order to build capacity and benefit mutual research and teaching activities, and to further the internationalisation of both institutions. This collaboration aims to achieve high-level environmental contamination research outputs and to build the basis for continuing collaborative investment in scientific capability.
- The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to establish a framework within which co-operation may develop between the two institutions. This will occur within the context of the regulations and policies of each institution, and subject to the availability of resources.
- Co-operation between the two institutions may include such activities as
 - Establishing a node of globalCARE at AUH.
 - Capacity building activities, such as workshops, short courses, seminars, webinars, conferences and public lectures.
 - Joint research and consultancy projects of mutual interest in relation to environmental contamination assessment, remediation and management.
 - Joint funding applications to support capacity building.
 - Joint publications in high impact international journals.
 - Joint supervision of PhD students.
 - Such other projects for mutual benefit that are agreed upon by both parties.
 - Enhancing linkages with potential end-users
 - Student and faculty exchange programs
- Specific programs or activities will be undertaken under this MOU only after the written agreement of both institutions. The terms and conditions of each specific program or activity, including any financial arrangements, shall be set out in a separate written Agreement signed by an authorised representative of each institution.
- Both parties shall designate a liaison officer for this MOU and for any subordinate agreements under this MOU. For CRC CARE, the officer shall be the Dr. Prashant Srivastava, Business Manager, CRC CARE, Australia. For AUH, the officer shall be Dr Sudeep Shukla, Assistant Professor, Amity School of Earth and Environmental Sciences, Amity University Haryana.

Marketing and Publicity 6.

The parties agree to discuss and agree upon appropriate promotion of the activities undertaken collaboratively under this MOU.

Neither party may, without prior approval from the other party or otherwise in accordance with a written agreement between the parties, imply any b)

endorsement by the other party of its products or services.

Any use by one party of the name or logo of the other party or the other party's related bodies corporate (as that term is defined in the Corporations Act 2001 c) (Cth)) must have prior written approval and must be in accordance with the other party's policies or otherwise in accordance with a written agreement between the parties.

The parties agree to share the surplus revenue generated by activities under the Revenue sharing agreement, as applicable on a case by case basis.

Each party agrees to treat as confidential all information designated as Confidential Information confidential or which by its nature is confidential or which is disclosed in circumstances importing an obligation of confidence that is obtained from the other party in connection with this MOU or activities undertaken pursuant to this MOU and not disclose such information except:

to such of the officers, employees and advisers of the party as have a legitimate interest in the confidential information to be disclosed to them;

as may be required by applicable law (in which case, if permitted, prior to disclosure, the party must consult with the other parties about the form and content of such disclosure); or

as the parties may agree in writing.

- This clause 7 does not apply to information that is or becomes available in the public domain, is already lawfully known to the receiving party, or has been b) independently developed by the receiving party, other than as a result of a breach by a party of their confidentiality obligations.
- 9. This MOU comes into effect when it has been signed by both institutions on the date of the last signature, it will remain in effect for a period of 2 years from that date. Not less than six months prior to its expiry, the two institutions will review its operation and decide whether or not to renew it. Any such renewal shall be signed by an authorised representative of each institution, and may include variations to this MOU.
- 10. This MOU may be terminated by the written mutual consent of both institutions, or by either institution giving 60 days written notice to the other institution.
- Except for clause 7, this MOU places no financial or legal obligations on either of the institutions, nor does it create any legal relationship between them.
