At the outset, Member Secretary welcomed all members and gave a brief introduction of agenda of the meeting.

The following issues were discussed, and the decisions arrived at have been noted against each item:

Agenda I: Revision of Program Structure of M.Sc. Nursing

Dr. A Tamilselvi presented to the board to have one program of M.Sc. Nursing rather than specialties as recommended by Indian Nursing Council. It was also proposed to have a 12 hour per credit system instead of 10 hours per credit. The proposal was appreciated and approval by the board members.

Agenda II: Change of Duration of B.Sc. Medical Laboratory Program from Three Years to Four Fears Dr. Vijay Simha proposed to change the program structure from 3 years to 4 years of B.Sc. MLT. This would help the students to gain minor degrees and also to apply easily for Master's Program in foreign universities without attaining extra credits. The proposal was also in view of the Government of India — National Commission of Allied & Health Professions recommendation of Allied Health Courses, where it was recommended for the course to be of 4 years. The board discussed the matter and approved the proposal of Four Year's B.Sc. MLT Program including Three and Half Years of academic curriculum and Six Months of internship.
