- To include Building Bye Laws as part of different subjects like architectural services,
   Professional Practice etc.

#### Actions Taken:

- Interior Design introduced as a compulsory subject in Semester VII.
- Theory of Architecture III (Semester VII) is removed and contents adjusted in Theory of Architecture II and Dissertation.
- Bye-laws are incorporated in Building Service I, II, III, IV, Building Materials and Construction Technology - VII & Professional Practice.

# Agenda 2. Revision of Syllabus - B Plan

## Suggestions:

- Merging of Fundamentals of Building Structures and Materials and Principles of Construction subjects of B.Plan 1st year
- To introduce a subject based on Planning Communication Skills in 1st sem
- Shifting of Regional Planning & Management subject from 5th semester to 6th semester
- Thesis Programming subject to be renamed as Dissertation

#### Action taken:

- The merged subject has now renamed as Fundamentals of Building Structure, Materials
   & Construction and is introduced in B-Plan 1<sup>st</sup> semester.
- We already have Communication Skills as a university subject in all the semesters of B-Plan. Graphical planning communication module is being added in PDL-I (Planning Studio) of 1<sup>st</sup> semester.
- The Subject Regional Planning & Management is now a part of B-Plan 6<sup>th</sup> semester.
- The subject Thesis Programming is renamed as Dissertation.

### **Action Taken**

- Literature Review has been incorporated in Techniques of Planning and Computer Application in M-Plan 1<sup>st</sup> semester.
- Sociology and Inclusive Development (PLN4311) which is an elective subject has been renamed as Settlement Anthropology and Inclusive Development and syllabus modified accordingly.
- Ecosystem Management & ecosystem Services are included in Housing & Environmental Planning of M-Plan 1<sup>st</sup> semester and Planning Studio of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.
- Name and focus of the subject had been changed from SPSS to Statistical Data Analysis Software (PLN4214) to accommodate SPSS and any other statistical data analysis software e.g. excel, etc.
- Disaster Management & Climate Change has been replaced by Resilience & Planning.
