- 1. To discuss the recently (2020) approved M.Sc Biotechnology (DBT-GATB) program and issues arising out of nomenclature clash with already ongoing similar PG programme.
- 2. To consider approval of Revised syllabus for M.Sc Biotechnology to reconcile with the model syllabus recommended by DBT.

Minutes of BOS meeting

- 1.The chairperson apprised the members and external experts that the students joined through recently(2020) approved M.Sc Biotechnology (DBT GATB) program of DBT, India and the students who have directly admitted in M.Sc Biotechnology under AUH regulation shall be addressed as M.Sc Biotechnology-GATB (M.Sc BT-GATB), and M.Sc Biotechnology (M.SC-BT) respectively.
- 2. The separate nomenclature is to be adopted only due to technical limitation of the software (Amizone) used in AUH to mark various activities of the semesters, M.Sc Biotechnology (DBT GATB) is configured as a separate program as M.Sc- GATB. However, apart from internal technical matters (Amizone), both programs will be treated as M.Sc- BT only. Both programs M.Sc- GATB & M.Sc- BT will run together with same curriculum and assessment schemes.
- 3. Same degree shall be awarded to all the successful students with the nomenclature of M.Sc Biotechnology without any discrimination between two different sources of admission.
- 4. The committee approved the adoption of model syllabus prescribed by DBT of 94 credits, with the below-mentioned changes. The same syllabus is approved for both the programs.
- 5. Value-added courses of 14 credits (fourteen) are accommodated in total 100 credit PG program in Biotechnology. Therefore, the credits of few subjects are reduced from DBT's model syllabus of 94 credits to adjust 14 credits. Now the course syllabus has 86 credits from DBT model syllabus and 14 credits for Value-added courses from Amity University Haryana syllabus to complete total 100 credits as per the regular practice or UGC norms.
- 6. The Elective II in DBT's model syllabus are brought to Sem III from Sem IV. This will allow students of Sem IV to leave the campus for dissertation project, if they wish to do project elsewhere. Also, two extra electives are added in the final syllabus to give more choices to the students. These are 'RNA biology', and 'Advanced Plant Genomics'.

Prof (Dr) Pooja Rana initiated with a brief overview of the agenda of the meeting which was in continuation with previous meeting to propose revision in the curriculum and introduction of new courses in the programmes being offered by Amity School of Communication.

Ms Esha Jainiti gave an overview of the proposed programme structure of BSc Animation & Visual Graphics and shared that focus of new syllabus is towards the upcoming trends in the industry like Gaming, UI and UX etc. so that students have more career prospects. The members unanimously recommended the approval of the following updates:

Changes in First Semester

- Changes in nomenclature 'Design Software'.
- 'Stop Motion' moved from 4th Semester to 1st Semester

Changes in Second Semester

Introduction of UX and UI

Changes in Third Semester

- Two Courses combined together Audio, Video and Post Production
- Introduction of 'Design Thinking' as Concentration Elective

Changes in Fourth Semester

New Courses introduced 'Introduction to Game Development' and 'Motion Graphics'

Changes in Fifth Semester

- New Course introduced, 'Game Development with AR and VR'
- 'Scripting' and 'Storyboarding' have been combined as one course, which were separate earlier.

Changes in Sixth Semester

• Core Course, 'VFX' introduced in the sixth semester.

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Mr Vishu Aggarwal, industry expert, added that concepts of UX and UI that have been introduced are trending in the industry and are important for students' career. He further added that introduction of AR and VR is also an important upcoming industry trend which has been incorporated with 2D and 3D.

Dr Preeti Singh, apprised the external expert and the other members of the proposed changes in the syllabus of BA JMC programme offered by Amity School of Communication. The syllabi of new courses was also discussed.

The members deliberated on the proposed revision of the BA JMC syllabi. The members unanimously approved the following changes in the programme structure of **BA JMC**.

CHANGES IN THE FIRST SEMESTER STRUCTURE:

- Nomenclature of 'Advertising Principle & Planning' changed and first semester course 'Fundamentals of Advertising' combined with the second semester course 'Advertising Principles and Practice'.
- Nomenclature of 'Computer Graphics & Animation' changed and first semester course 'Computer Application- I' combined with the second semester course 'Computer Application- II'.
- Course 'Understating Mass Communication' shifted from second semester to the first semester.
- Course 'News and Contemporary Issues' shifted to the first semester from the third semester.

CHANGES IN THE SECOND SEMESTER STRUCUTRE:

- Nomenclature of 'Electronic Communication: Radio & TV' changed and the first semester course 'Fundamentals of Radio Journalism' and the second semester course to be combined.
- Media Planning & Buying- this course has been shifted from Concentration Elective of third semester to second semester core courses.

CHANGES IN THE THIRD SEMESTER STRUCTURE:

- Nomenclature of the course 'Basics of Research-I' changed to 'Mass Communication Research-I'.
- Course 'Development Communication' to be shifted from concentration elective to core courses.
- Project shifted from CE to Core course.

CHANGES IN THE FOURTH SEMESTER STRUCURE:

- Nomenclature of the course 'Media Management' to be changed to 'Media Laws & Management'.
- Credits of the course 'Brand Management' to be changed from 2 to 3.
- A new course 'Digital Marketing' introduced as CE.

CHANGES IN THE FIFTH SEMESTER STRUCTURE:

- A new course- Data Journalism has been introduced with 3 credits.
- 'Mass Communication Research-II' shifted from concentration elective courses to core courses.
- Summer Internship Evaluation-II- credits changed from 2 to 3.
- Nomenclature of the course changed from Event Management-II to Event Management.
- Nomenclature of the course 'Multimedia' changed to Multimedia Journalism.
- Credits of 'National & International Issues & Affairs' changed from 2 to 3 and shifted from third semester to fifth semester as CE.

CHANGES IN THE SIXTH SEMESTER STRUCTURE:

- Dissertation to be added as an option with the Professional Project.
- Professional Project or Dissertation- Lecture and Practical hours changed to 4 and credits changed to 9.
- Some additions have been done in specialization areas such as Event Management, New Media, Corporate Communication and Development Communication in the above course.
- Internship- Credits have been changed from 9 to 8.
- The course 'Media Analysis' shifted from concentration electives to core courses of sixth semester and 1 tutorial added to 2 lecture hours.

External Expert Dr. Monika Verma appreciated the proposed syllabi; talking about Development Communication being shifted as a core course; it would have wider career prospects. She also complemented the decision to teach research at UG level in two semesters.

Prof (Dr) Pooja Rana, Prog Co ordinator, MA J&MC and PGDJMC presented the proposed changes in the syllabus of different courses of MA JMC and PGDJMC. She also presented the detailed syllabi of the newly proposed courses – Media Trends & Technology (MA J&MC sem 2/PGDJMC Sem 2) and Communication Research (MA JMC Sem 3). Syllabi of both the newly introduced courses along with proposed revision of the existing syllabi was recommended for further approval by the DRC.

The following changes were also recommended by the Board of Studies in MA J&MC programme structure:

CHANGES IN THE FIRST SEMESTER STRUCTURE:

- Credit of the course 'History, Culture & Society' reduced from 3 to 2.
- Total credits of the first semester reduced from 26 to 25.
