 - (a) Lt. Gen. Dr. Rakesh Sharma: he was commissioned in Gorkha Rifles in 1977 and had a career in the Army spanning forty years. He has had extensive operational experience in Jammu and Kashmir, Northeast and on the Western Borders. He had trained the Botswana Army for three years in Africa, and attended the National War College at Abuja, Nigeria. 

CONDUCT OF THE SESSION






- 1. Every year India celebrates the making and adopting of its Constitution, on 26 November. In keeping with that and like previous years, Amity Law School, in collaboration with We The People Abhiyan, an NGO, with whom we an Ongoing MOU, organised a Webinar on "Making of the Indian Constitution", at 3:00 PM on 24 November 2021.
- 2. The Event was held on Zoom and Live streamed on YouTube. It was attended by nearly 120 participants, including all Faculty Members of Amity Law School and a large number of our students. The Event was addressed by Ms Sana Siddiqui and Ms Prachi Bathwal from We The People Abhiyan and Maj Gen PK Sharma (Retd), Professor & Director Amity Law School and Dean Faculty of Law, Amity University Haryana.
- 3. 
"swear by Goddess". It was decided not to include any but only state "We The People".


