General Introduction of the Event

3.2 Inspiration & Objectives of the Event:

The students of AIBAS finding placements and selection in prestigious organizations like CRY Foundation, are making their mark in the professional field of psychology and other allied work sectors. This event was also organized by CRC in collaboration with AIBAS to train the students of PG 2nd Semester in making strong impactful impression during placement interviews.

- 3. To train the students in effective and impressionable communication skills required for a favorable interview performance.

Report of the event

A mock drill interactive session was organized by CRC for AIBAS students to educate and train them in delivering effective interview performances for placements. The session was initiated by Dr Ruby Singh, Assistant Director, CRC who welcomed all the event participants. She apprised everyone about the significance and purpose of the session. Following Dr Singh's introduction to the importance of the event, Prof. Rajesh Nair, Director, AIBAS spoke about the key skills that every interviewee must showcase and prepare for an impactful interview performance. Prof Nair highlighted how important it is to master and positively project both thematic i.e. subject/domain specific skills along with presentation skills.

Next, a role play based mock drill session was conducted in which mock interview sessions were conducted. The mock sessions had Dr Ruby Singh and AIBAS faculty Dr Fouzia playing the role of interview panelists while voluntary students from AIBAS participated as interviewees in the sessions. Both the panelists provided tips to the participants as to how to improve their resume and communication skills. It was advised that students make authentic, factual resumes bearing important and detailed information about their training experiences in previous internships completed. Participants were also advised to mention in their resumes, their involvement in participating/organizing extracurricular and various student club & classroom activities in Amity campus. The panelists also explained the importance of converting a normal question asked during the interview into a golden opportunity of sharing relevant anecdotes of previous achievements. Besides, the student participants were also provided simple tips for better and nuanced articulation of thoughts and words during interview. Doubts, queries and concerns raised by students with regard to effective interview performance were also diligently answered by Mr Manoj Sahani, Director, CRC & Dr. Ruby Singh.

Outcome Of the Visit:

The session was a successful one as it managed to generate enthusiastic participation and interest amongst the student participants of AIBAS. The mock drill sessions proved to be confidence booster as many students volunteered to participate in the mock drill sessions. The students received tips of improvement with positivity.

In a nutshell, the session encouraged the students to have confidence in their skills and capabilities and gave a shot in the arm for further improvisation for future interview placements.






