Objective: To acquaint and train the participants with the procedure of selection by Services Selection Board.

Brief Overview:


Services Selection Board (SSB) is an organization that assesses the candidates for becoming Officers into the Indian Armed Forces. The Board evaluates the suitability of a candidate for becoming an Officer using a standardized protocol of evaluation system which constitutes personality, intelligence tests and interviews. The tests are both written and practical task-based. An SSB comprises the panel of assessors, who are Officers in the Indian Armed Forces and having their specialization as Psychologist, GTO (Group Task Officer) and Interviewing Officer. In total, there are thirteen Services Selection Boards across India, out of which four

Boards are for the Indian Army, four Boards for Indian Air Force, and five Boards for the Indian Navy. SSB is a 5 days evaluation process.

It was attended by 388 participants including Students, Faculty Members and Legal Professionals.


CONDUCT OF THE SESSION

Welcome Address:




The Session began with a Welcome Address delivered by Ms. Asha Meena, Assistant Professor, Amity Law School, who introduced the Guest, Brigadier Prem Mandotra (Retd.) and thanked him for accepting the invite to address the Students and Faculty Members from different Colleges and Universities.

Address by speaker:



Brigadier Prem Mandotra (Retd.) began the Workshop by stating the importance of having an aim in life, as the quality of life depends on the quality of aim and went on to discuss the life in the Armed Forces. He then gave an overview of the selection system wherein he discussed the role of SSB, it's structure, assessors (Interviewing Officer, Group Testing Officer, Psychologist) and the procedure.



Further, he explained in details, each step of the examination with examples. Brigadier Mandotra elucidated the assessment process of candidates and the importance and need of having Officer Like Qualities. In addition to this, he, stressed on the fact that positive attitude, areas of interest like social effectiveness, planning & organizing, qualities of heart, leadership quality etc. play a pivot role in the selection of the aspirants. He emphasized that human personality is not a mechanical summation of various qualities but is a product of their integration.

The Guest, concluded his address by advising the participants that a good 'demonstrated performance' is the key to success - 'if you have it in you, you will sail through'.

The address was followed by Question-Answer Session which made it easier for the interested participants to understand the selection process better.
