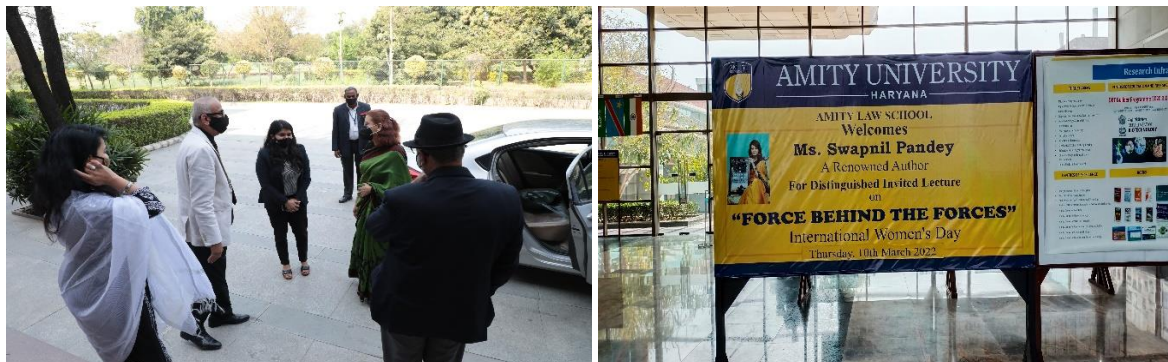

Address by speaker:

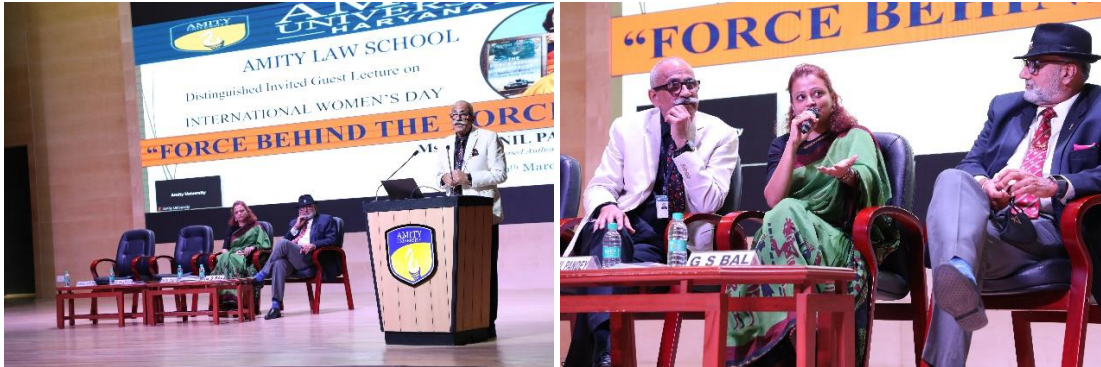

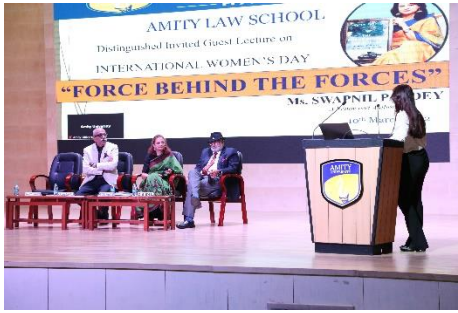
