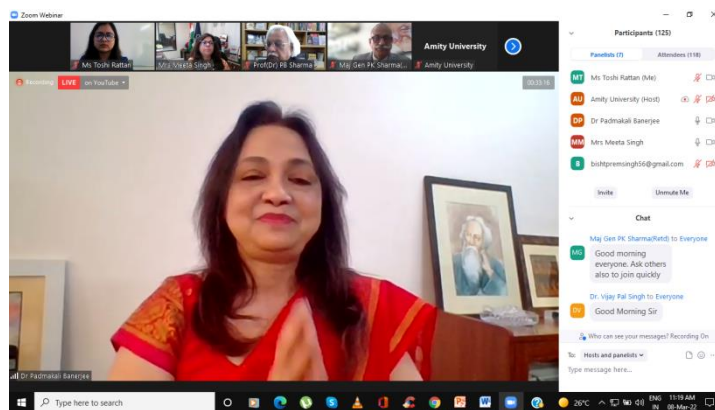
#### 3.1 General Introduction of the Event

Women's empowerment can be defined as promoting women's sense of self-worth, their ability to determine their own choices, and their right to influence social change for themselves and others. It is closely aligned with female empowerment – a fundamental Human Right which is also a key to achieving a more peaceful and prosperous world. Women's empowerment and promoting women's rights have emerged as part of a major global movement and is continuing to break new grounds in recent years. International Women's Day (March 8) is a global day celebrating the social, economic, cultural, and political achievements of women. The day also marks a call for action for accelerating women's equality. To mark this occasion, Amity Law School, Amity University Haryana organised this Webinar on the theme, 'Women Empowered and Empowering'.

Approximately 150 participants including students, Research Scholars, Faculty Members and Heads of Institutions, from Amity University Haryana and various other colleges of Delhi-NCR attended the Webinar.

### **Conduct of the Session:**

The Guest Speakers for the Webinar were Ms. Meeta Singh, Income Tax Commissioner, Delhi and Mr. P S Bisht, Former IPS Officer. Prof. (Dr.) P.B. Sharma, Vice-Chancellor, Amity University Haryana and Prof. (Dr.) Padmakali Banarjee, Pro-Vice Chancellor, Amity University Haryana also graced the event with their presence.



The Session commenced with Ms. Toshi Rattan, the Coordinator, giving a brief about the Event and introduction of the Speakers, after which Prof. (Dr.) Padmakali Banarjee had given her thoughtful insights on the need of women empowerment. She emphasized how the society can progress even further with the equal participation of women. She specifically pointed out how AUH promotes nurturing young female talent. Prof. (Dr.) Padmakali Banerjee said, “All of us should aim at creating a sustainable and peaceful tomorrow by taking care of others. We, as the empowered members of the society should contribute to empowering the less privileged.” She also said that for the women to be more empowered, equal opportunities should be created in all spheres of life.



Expressing his delight for the International Women’s Day celebrations, Prof (Dr.) P B Sharma stated, “Our age old Vedic civilization always had highest respect and reverence for motherhood

and the girl child. The world in which we shall live tomorrow shall stand for equality of opportunity, for justice to one and all and for responsible citizenship. There should be no scope of positive bias in favor of one or the other. Empowerment is not so much about equality of number of male and female but about equality of opportunity and the absence of a negative bias.” He also mentioned that at Amity University Haryana, we have almost equal number of both male and female students as well as teaching staff.



Ms. Meeta Singh then addressed the participants. She said that this year’s theme of Women’s Day ‘Gender Equality Today for a Sustainable Tomorrow’ needs a serious consideration. She, elaborated on how the social media has, in the present world, helped in empowering women by giving them access to information and providing for them various role models to be looked upon in different diaspora of fields. She pointed out how lack of aspiration has been the root cause of women remaining back-doors and emphasized the need to break the stereotype of the society and achieve gender equality in true sense.



Ms Singh said that the perspective needs to change from Gender Equality to Gender Equity; since women now have same opportunities as men, it is required that they be treated equal to men as well. In the end, she mentioned that it is really important for women to hold on to each other and push each other up instead of expecting men to give them equality.



Mr. P S Bisht spoke about 'Women in the Forces'. He discussed the role of women in the Forces and how they have played an important role since the fight of independence started. He spoke about the various legal provisions and international organizations speaking about women rights. He also highlighted how the Supreme Court of India has actively helped women increase their participation in Armed Forces be it Permanent Commission of Women or about letting women candidates sit for the NDA exams. He concluded by stating "Women are already empowered. We just need to change the way the world perceives it."



While delivering the Vote of Thanks, Maj Gen P K Sharma (Retd.), Professor & Director, Amity Law School and Dean Faculty of Law was optimistic that the youth now has a different mindset and are marching forward to change the perspective of the world. He said that the glass ceiling will disappear when we focus more on the caliber of a woman first and not the gender.
