WATER CONSCIOUS PLANTS

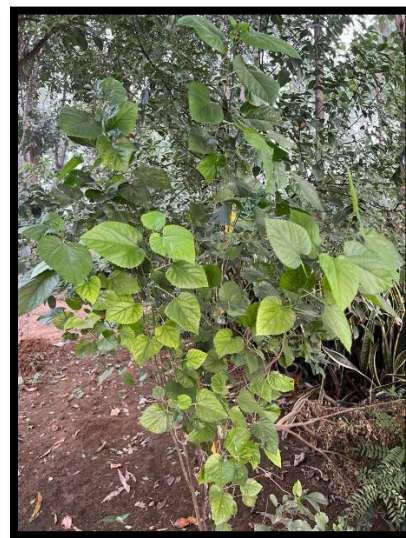
Water is necessary for the survival of all flora. Drought-tolerant plants, on the other hand, are those that require very little regular water supply to thrive.
