**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL OF AMITY UNIVERSITY MADHYA PRADESH, HELD ON 03 MARCH 2017**

(j) **Amity Law School (ALS)**, Mr. Mohit Sharma briefed about the BoS meeting of Amity Law School. He informed the members about the changes made in syllabus as under.

(i) The Chairman asked Offg. HoI, ALS to revise the minutes as suggested by the members of the Academic Council. Further, the members of the Academic Council

authorized Vice Chancellor to approve the revised minutes after making the necessary amendments.

(ii) The Vice Chancellor stated that each and every changes made in the syllabus should have a logical reason which should be elaborated in writing. He instructed all that if the syllabus is changed in Board of studies, the changes/updation are also to be updated to the concerned faculty for making appropriate changes in respective session plans.

(iii) The Vice Chancellor also instructed the HoIs to keep a proper record of batch wise syllabus and submit a soft copy of the same to the Office of the Dean (Academics) and the Registrar for record purpose. He stated that the changes made in syllabus will only be implemented for the new batch onwards and not for the ongoing batches. If the changes are proposed for ongoing batches, then explicit sanction of Vice Chancellor is required to be obtained on a note sheet, giving out the reason and urgency for such changes, which should be routed by the respective HoI, through Pro-Vice Chancellor.

(iv) Controller of Examination requested all that the overlapping/repetition of the questions in respect of value added courses should be avoided.

(v) The Vice Chancellor stated that a committee should be constituted under the Chairmanship of Director, ASL with one member from EVS and one member from AIBAS, which was unanimously agreed by the members of the Academic Council. He stated that the Chairman of the committee will go through the syllabus and avoid duplicacy and submit its report within 15 days from the constitution of the committee. The Vice Chancellor stated that there should be three aspects to be kept in mind while proposing changes in syllabi i.e Must Know, Could Know and Should Know.
