- (b) The syllabus for the course, Communication skill for 1st semester is prescribed by PCI. Approval for the syllabus of course, Communication skills offered from 2nd to 8th semester as value added course.
- (c) Approval of increase in intake of B. Pharm course from 60 to 100 seats from the year 2021-22.

Discussions/Comments:

a) Discussion: Discussion on existing syllabus for value added courses such as French and Behavioural Science, to be offered from 1st to 8th semester in Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm) course for the year 2021-22.

Comment: The BOS approved the syllabus for above said value added course from 1st to 8th semester in Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm) course for the year 2021-22.

b) Discussion: Discussion on syllabus of communication skills from 2nd to 8th semester in Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm) course for the year 2021-22.

Comment: Member observed that, the Communication skill course for 1st semester is taught as per PCI syllabus. The syllabus for the Communication skills course from 2nd to 8th semester which is taught as value added course in Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm) course has been approved.

(f) Discussion: Discussion on raise in admission from 60 to 100 in existing B. Pharmacy course from the year 2021-22.

Comment: The members observed that the number of applications received for admission for the first year B. Pharmacy is more than the approved intake, hence the proposal for raise in admission from 60 to 100 has been approved.

The BOS recommends that the codes and the names of all courses must be same as mentioned in the syllabus prescribed by Pharmacy Council of India (Framed under Regulation 6, 7 & 8 of the Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm) course regulations 2014).
