#### 3. <u>Recommendations.</u>

After in-depth analysis of existing course structure of various courses of ALS, AUMP and prevailing course structures in other Universities, Board unanimously made following recommendations:-

### I. <u>Recommendations for Ph.D. Course work</u>

Board recommends to adopt the syllabus of Ph.D. Course work in Law for 2018-19, for the coming Session 2019-20, as it is in terms of course structures, course contents and credits. ### II. <u>Recommendations for LL.M. (One Year) Programme</u>

Board recommends to add new Examination Scheme for LLM 143 Behavioral Science I and LLM 243 Behavioral Science II. Board further recommends to adopt the syllabus of LL.M. (One Year) 2018-19, for the coming Session 201-20, as it is in terms of course structures, course contents and credits after incorporating the said changes.
