


Q-1: Curriculum and Syllabi of the Courses


Q -2: Extent of syllabi covered in the Class


Q-3 Quality of course delivery by faculty members in the class

Total Number of Satisfied Students with quality of the course delivery by the faculty is 85 % whereas 15 % of the students are not satisfied with the quality.


Q-4 Usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching


Q-5 Fairness in the assessment processes (Assignments, Quiz, ppt etc.)

Total Number of Satisfied Students with Fairness in the assessment processes 86 % however, 14% students are not satisfied with the fairness.


Q-6 Timely announcement of examination results

90 % of the students are of the opinion that University timely announces the results but 10% of the students are differs.


Q-7 Opportunities in the School/ University for Research Activities

Total Number of Satisfied Students with the opportunities of Research activities in the University is 82 % whereas 18% of the students are not satisfied with such opportunities.


Q-8 Opportunity for the students to participate in internship, field visit etc.
