


Q-1: Curriculum and Syllabi of the Courses

Total Number of Satisfied Students with Quality of Curriculum and Syllabus is **94%.** Total Number of Dissatisfied Students is 6 %.



Total Number of Satisfied Students with Extent of Syllabus covered is **95** %. Total Number of Dissatisfied Students is 5 %.


Q-3 Quality of course delivery by faculty members in the class

Total Number of Satisfied Students with the Quality of course delivery by faculty members in the class is **92%.** Total Number of Dissatisfied Students is 8%.


Q-4 Usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching


Q-5 Fairness in the assessment processes (Assignments, Quiz, ppt etc.)


Q-6 Timely announcement of examination results

Total Number of Satisfied Students with Timely announcement of examination results is **93%.** Total Number of Dissatisfied Students is 7 %.


Q-7 Opportunities in the School/ University for Research Activities

Total Number of Satisfied Students with Opportunities in the School/ University for Research Activities is **81%**. Total Number of Dissatisfied Students 19 %.


Q-8 Opportunity for the students to participate in internship, field visit etc.
