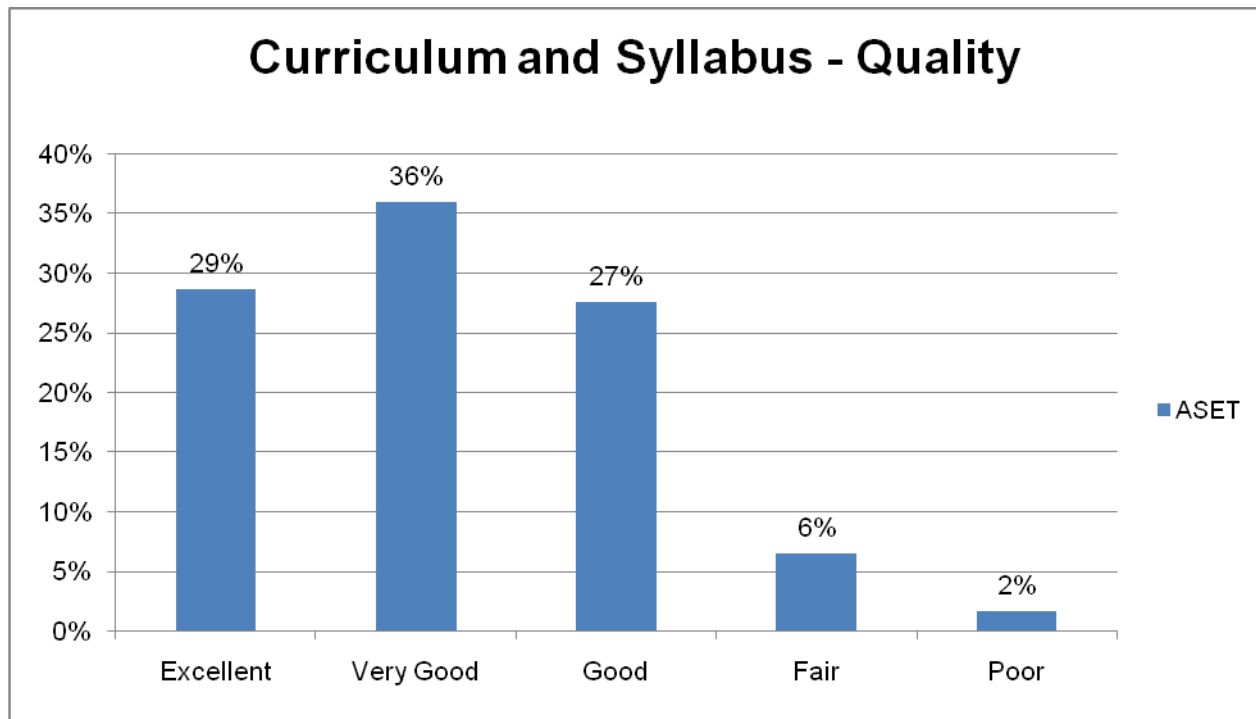

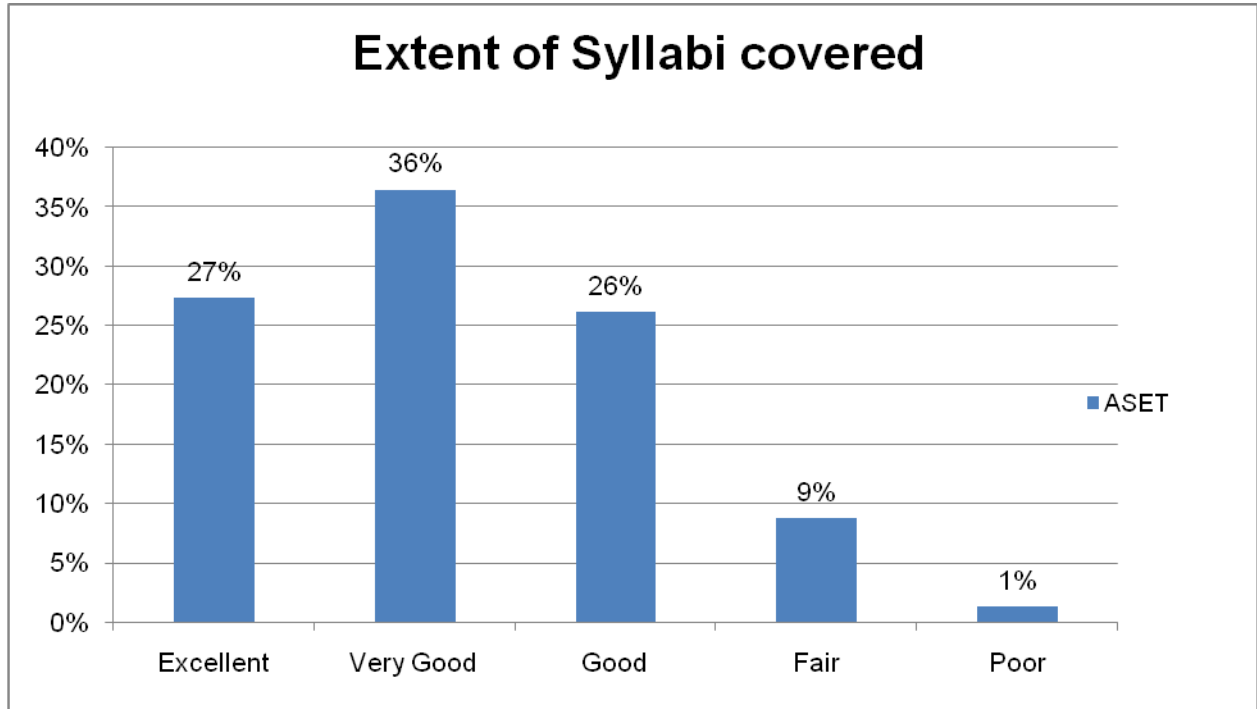
Q-1: Curriculum and Syllabi of the Courses

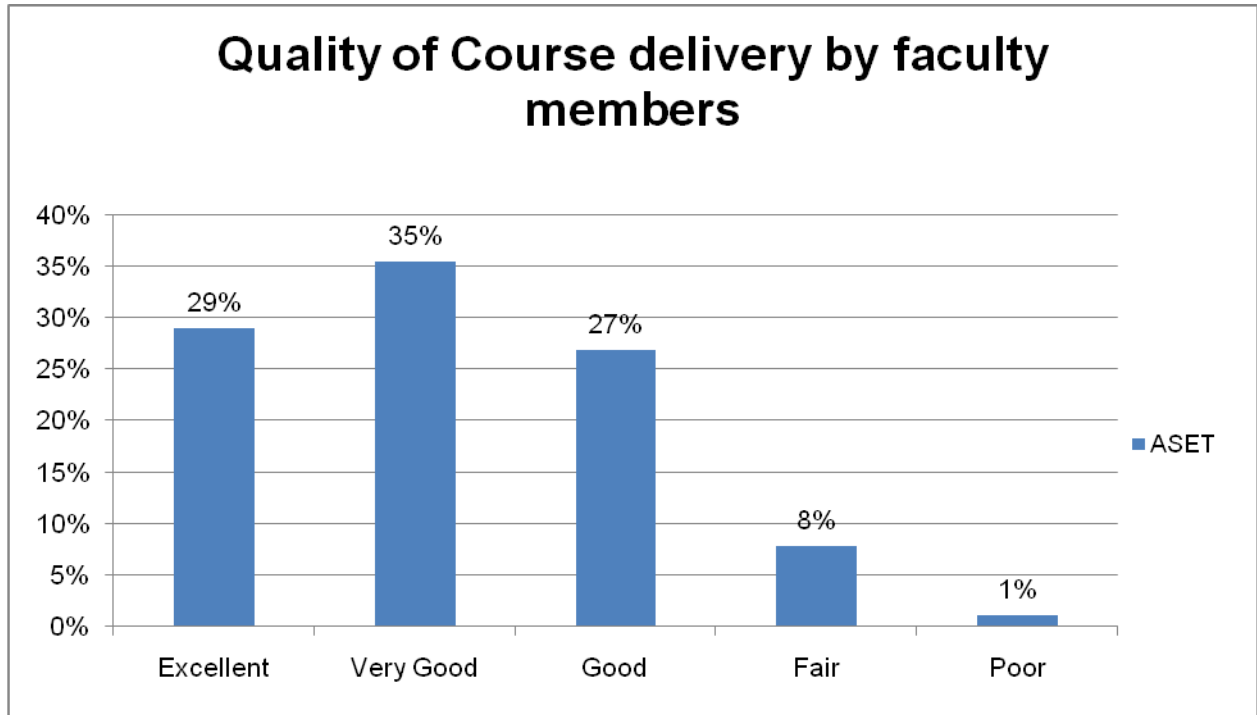
Q -2: Extent of syllabi covered in the Class

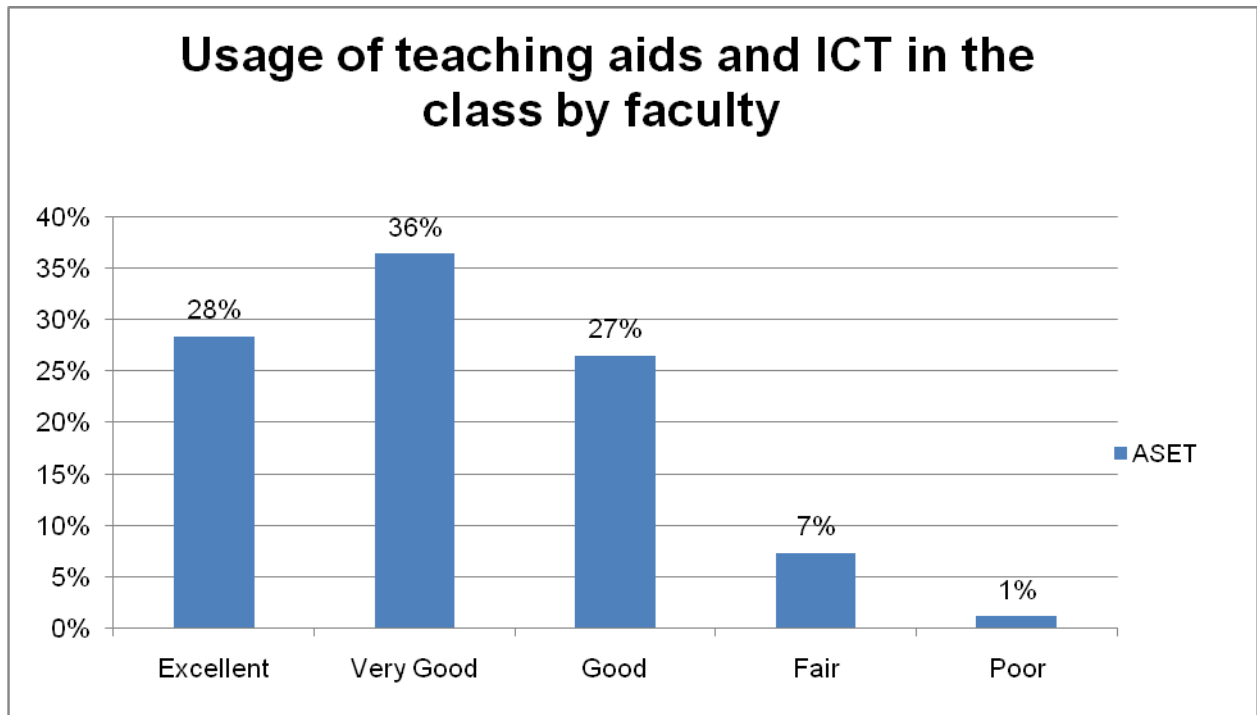
Q-3 Course delivery by faculty members in the class

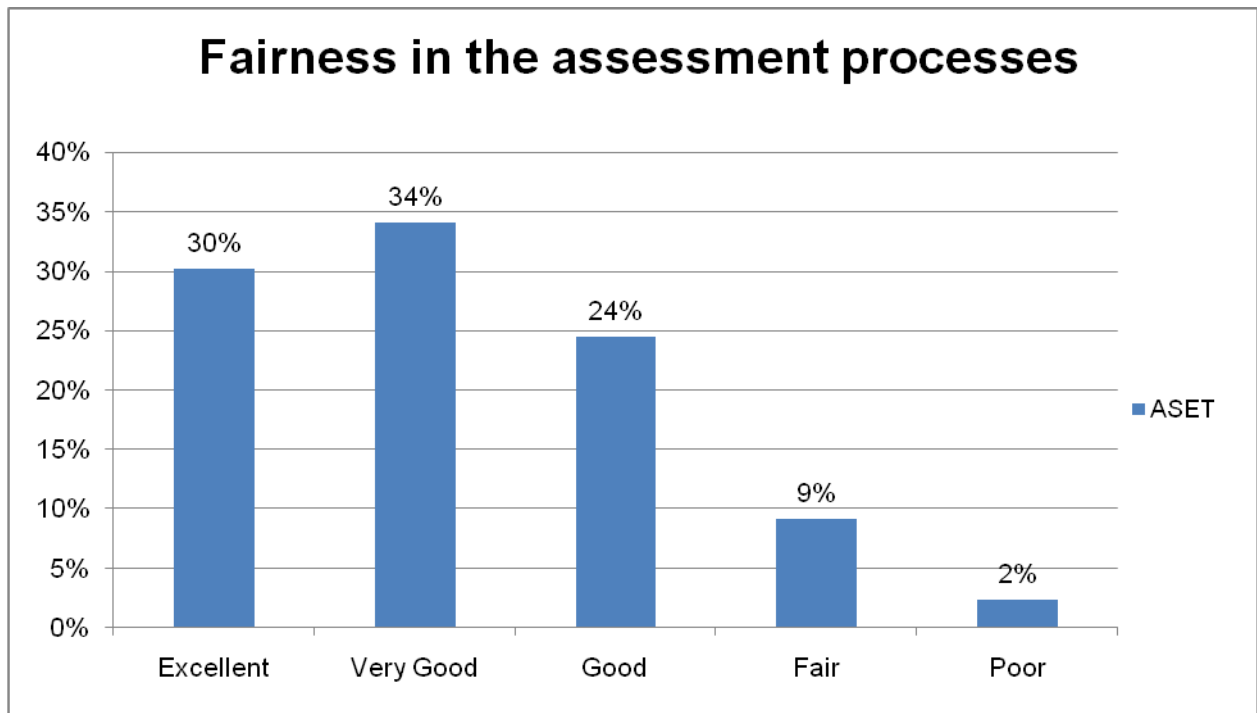
Q-4 Usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching

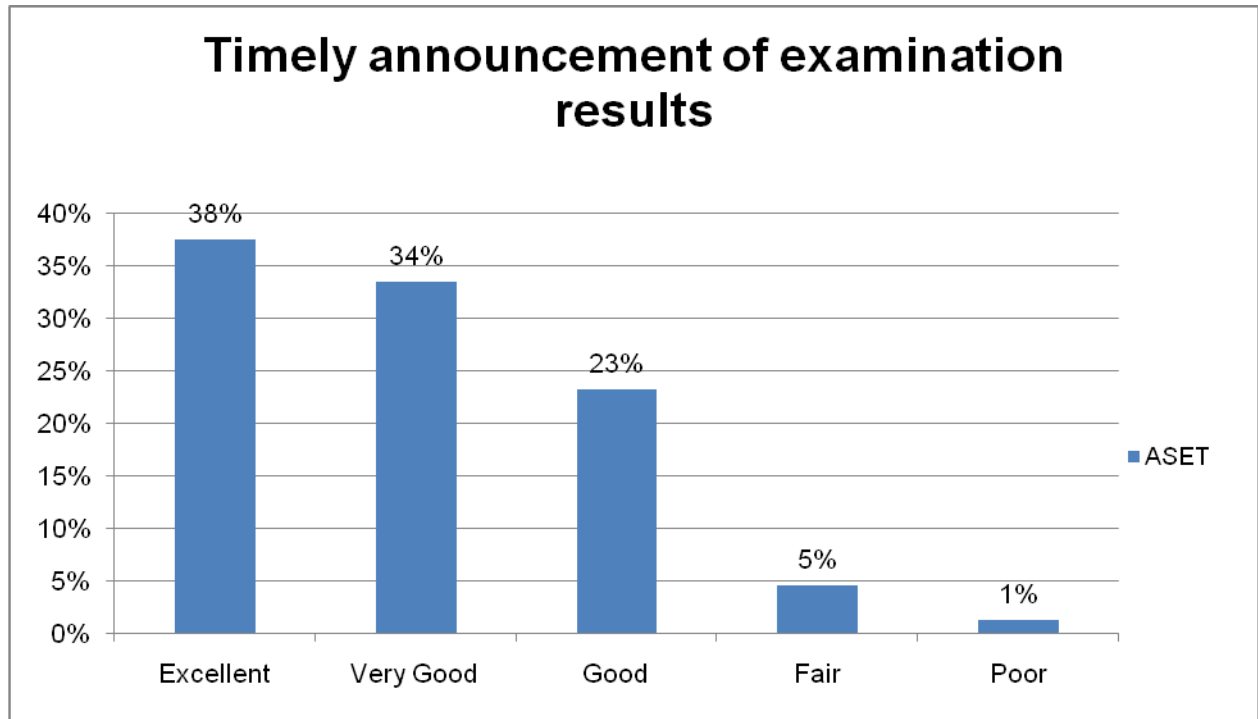
Q-5 Fairness in the assessment processes (Assignments, Quiz, ppt etc.)

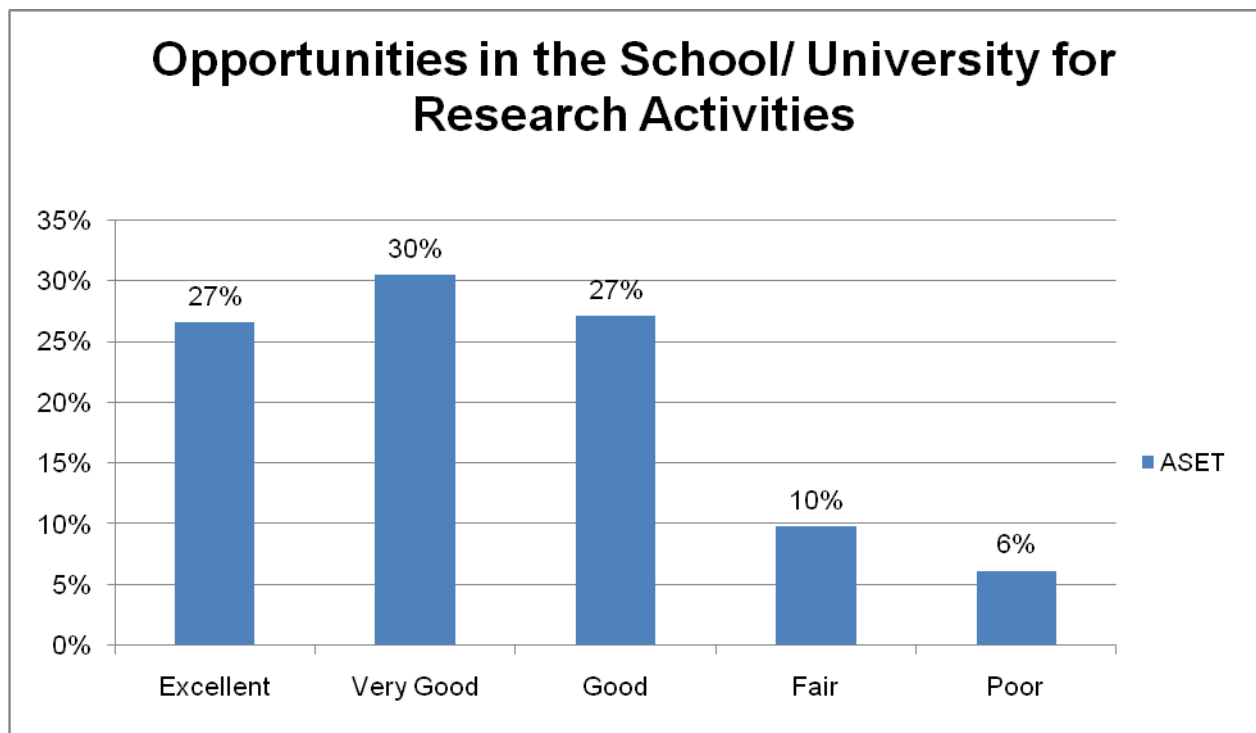
Q-6 Timely announcement of examination results

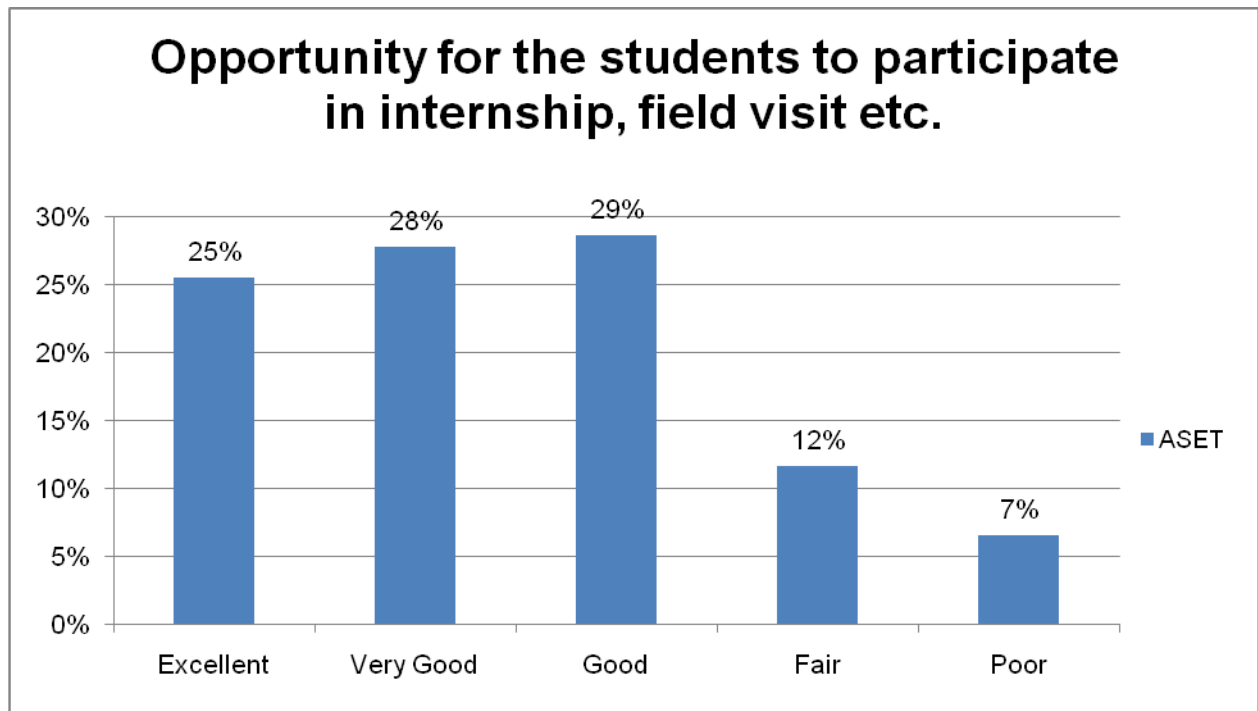
Q-7 Opportunities in the School/ University for Research Activities

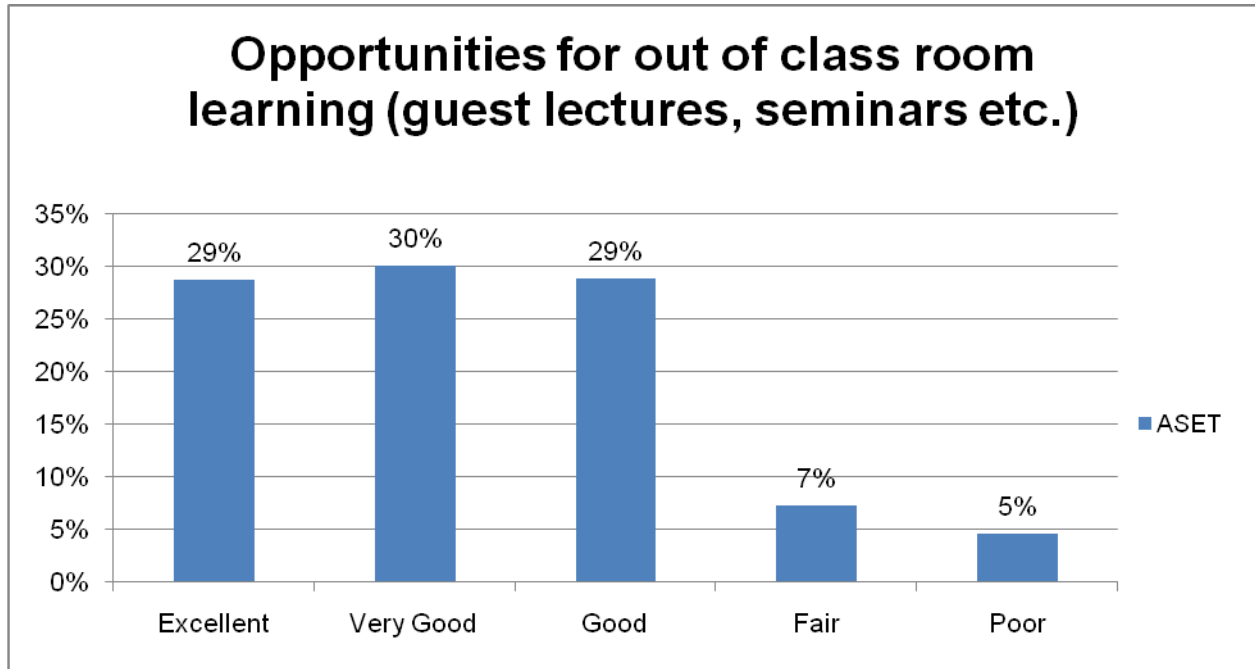
Q-8 Opportunity for the students to participate in internship, field visit etc.

	Suggestions	Action Taken
1	The curriculum is good but there are lots of pressure on students for studies . The curriculum is so tight that there was no free time for any other activity.	In Time- Table free slots will be introduced to accommodate Extracurricular Activities.
2	There were no personality development classes.	The University has compulsory Soft-Skills-Development Courses in all Semesters. personality development classes are taken care under Soft-Skills Development Course. All mentors have been advised to conduct awareness session on Soft-Skills Development Courses.
3	Research activities can be given more value. More Time for self-study and self-improvement	There is already a provision of Major Research Project in Final Years of all Courses with the sufficient credits. Students have given separate period for Library to explore the facility of library and online available e-library journals provided by the University.
4	Add some subjects which really helps for thinking abilities	There are already several subjects which involved critical thinking such as Problem-Solving Techniques, Analysis and Design of Algorithms, Data Structure etc. which really helps for thinking abilities.
