

Dear Sir,

1. Amity University Madhya Pradesh (AUMP) was established under Ritnand Balved Education Foundation (RBEF) vide Madhya Pradesh Government Legislature Act No. 27 of 2010. The University has been functional since 2011 and one of its important objectives is to undertake human resource development activities for the region of Madhya Pradesh.
2. Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) has accorded approval for two years M.Phil (Clinical Psychology) programme under Amity Institute of Behavioral and Allied Science (AIBAS), AUMP from the academic session 2016 onwards.
3. Seven students are presently undergoing training under this programme.
4. As per RCI guidelines Clinical Work/practical training of 200 (two hundred) hours per year should be provided to the students.
5. In view of the above requirements, your association for availing the services for imparting practical training of our students of M.Phil. (Clinical Psychology) is requested, under the Department of Psychiatry, GRMC, Gwalior.
6. Faculty members of AIBAS, Clinical Psychology of AUMP, Gwalior with clinical background and expertise will accompany the students to give them necessary guidance and training.
7. RCI mandates that a letter of consent for affiliation with Department of Clinical Psychology, Amity University Madhya Pradesh be given by the agency agreeing to provide practical training to our students. (In this case, the Department of Psychiatry, Gajra Raja Medical College, Gwalior). Also we would like to enter into a MoU with Department of Psychiatry, Gajra Raja Medical College, Gwalior.

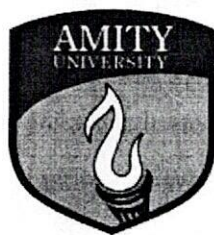

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

AMITY UNIVERSITY, MADHYA PRADESH (AUMP) was established under Ritnand Balved Education Foundation (RBEF) vide Madhya Pradesh Government Legislature Act of 2010, having its campus at Maharajpura, Gwalior acting through its authorized representative [hereinafter referred to as “AUMP”, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context and meaning thereof, include its successors and assigns] of the first part,

AND

GAJRA RAJA MEDICAL COLLEGE, GWALIOR, was founded in the year 1945, by Maharaja Jiwaji Rao and Maharani Shreemant Vijaya Raje on the occasion of the birth of their heir apparent Yuvraj Madhav Rao Scindia. The College was recognised by Medical Council of India from the Beginning. Post graduate training started in 1951 almost in all the subjects . It is now 54 Years and institution which produced stalwarts in the field of Medicine. Five of its faculty members have been awarded ‘ Padam Shri ‘ by the Govt. of India. This institute was turned into autonomous institute by the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh in April 1997 and since then it is running as the autonomous body initially under the name of Rogi Kalyan Samiti and later on by the Executive Council of the Gajra Raja Medcial college, gwalior which governs both college and the associated JA Group of Hospitals. At present this institute is equipped with latest equipments.

AUMP and GRMC are each referred to individually as a “Party” and collectively as “Parties”
WHEREAS

AUMP was established by Ritnand Balved Education Foundation (RBEF) vide Madhya Pradesh Government Legislature Act of 2010 with the view to promote professional, industry-oriented education in the state of Madhya Pradesh. AUMP, Gwalior located on a sprawling campus of 102 acres of land opposite Gwalior Airport, imparts modern, practical and research-oriented courses which will lead to the development of professionals who are employable and industry ready. This in turn will drive the socio-economic upliftment of the region. Amity imparts education in almost all areas including management, engineering, architecture, biotechnology, law, communication, behavioral science, fine arts, fashion etc. AUMP was adjudged the “Best Private University of Madhya Pradesh” by CMAI Association of India and has been accredited as “Premier University” by Accreditation Service for International Colleges (ASIC).

THE UNDERSIGNED PARTIES agree to do the following activities with the co-operation of each other:

1. Students of Amity Institute of Behavioural and Allied Sciences (AIBAS), AUMP, Gwalior (Post Graduate. M.Phil/Ph.D) will work under the guidance of a psychiatrist and Clinical Psychologist of GRMC and help in assessment and treatment of cases.
2. Students will be exposed to all therapies and infrastructure for completion of their program.
3. Faculty members of AIBAS of AUMP, Gwalior with clinical background and expertise in testing will accompany students to give them necessary guidance and also help GRMC in testing, analysis and using therapies on patients.
4. The psychiatrist/ Clinical Psychologist of GRMC will guide and supervise the students. He/ she will also supervise the students on preparation of case reports, therapeutic interventions and presentations.
5. AIBAS (Clinical Psychology) students of AUMP pursuing M. Phil will assist the clinical psychologists/psychiatrist of child and adolescent wing of GRMC in assessment and therapy.
6. GRMC on the request from the university will provide short term training to trainees of the university in their areas of specialization.
7. GRMC and AUMP will apply for collaborative projects jointly to national and international funding agencies.
8. GRMC and AUMP will jointly organize scientific workshops, symposia, training courses/conferences on topics of mutual interest.
9. M.Phil Clinical psychology Students of the institute will collaborate with GRMC in development of research projects and will accordingly use facilities of lab etc, to carry out research projects.

10. GRMC will use the library facility of AUMP, Library and the tests available in the AIBAS laboratory of AUMP.
11. GRMC to provide a separate room and infrastructure facility to AIBAS faculty./students to provide therapeutic sessions to the patients.
12. AIBAS students of AUMP should be allowed to observe Electro Convulsive Therapy (ECT) case history taking and conducting therapies by GRMC staff and doctors.

PROPOSAL:

The MOU is based on a mutual desire for a broad academic and research collaboration permitting both parties to work for promotion of mental health awareness and enhancement by following ethical codes of practice of clinical psychologists and respecting intellectual property rights.

ARTICLE I: SCOPE AND OBJECTIVES OF COOPERATION

The scope of this cooperation embraces work to facilitate

- a. Educational exchange
- b. Research collaboration
- c. Supervised internships and training.

ARTICLE II: SCOPE OF INVOLVEMENT

- a. Educational exchange- Faculty and Students of AUMP and Faculty and students of GRMC will enter into specific exchange programs agreed upon by individual departments and faculty.
- b. Research- Each of the party is free to enter into one or more of the individual or joint work projects.
- c. Training and internship- The students of AUMP will be working with psychiatrists and psychologists posted at GRMC. The faculty of AUMP would also supervise them as internal faculty guide for programme.

ARTICLE III: MODALITIES OF COOPERATION

A committee comprising of faculty from GRMC and AUMP will be responsible for setting up and implementing the envisaged cooperative academic and research activities. The manner of collaboration in providing psychological assistance to the patients (conducting therapies, counseling sessions, testing and diagnosis) in which each party carries out a specific complementary component. Limitations as imposed on exchange of material by Indian Govt. and rights of patients will be enforceable along with all other statutory requirements.

ARTICLE IV: PROGRAMME MANAGEMENT

A committee will be constituted to monitor and review the progress of activities. The Committee shall meet at least once within two year and review the progress on all the activities carried out under this MOU. This MOU can be amended only by a written consent duly signed by the Parties. The MoU for collaboration between the said AUMP campus and GRMC will come into force after getting approval from the competent authorities.

ARTICLE V: LIMITATION OF LIABILITY


No party to this MOU shall accept a liability or responsibility nor assert a claim, right or interest against the other party for damages or any loss arising from activities under this MOU.

ARTICLE VI: DURATION OF AGREEMENT

This MOU becomes effective from the date when signed by both the parties and will be valid for a period of five years. Any party may cease its cooperation under this MOU by providing six months' written notice to the other party.

This MOU is a statement of intent of the parties to cooperate and is not legally binding upon the parties under any circumstances, whatsoever. This MOU does not create legally enforceable rights, claims, interests, duty or obligations in favor of either of the Parties, as against the party.
