

PRIMARY OBJECTIVES

1. Both institutions agree that the primary objectives for this Letter of Intent (LOI) include consideration of the following:
 - 1.1. Opportunities for the exchange of research, management, and teaching staff to the extent which resources permit.
 - 1.2. Opportunities to exchange research findings and publications, academic teaching resources, and other materials of common interest.
 - 1.3. Opportunities for the development of collaborative research programmes that investigate topics of interest to staff and students in both institutions, acknowledging that:
 - a. All existing intellectual property will remain the property of the institution that has created the intellectual property; and
 - b. Ownership arrangements for any intellectual property developed as the result of a research collaboration will be agreed in writing through separate research collaboration agreements (if applicable).
 - 1.4. Organisation of joint activities, including meetings, seminars, symposia or lectures, workshops and conferences.
 - 1.5. Educational opportunities for students and staff, including working group collaborations between PhD students and dual degree PhD programmes.

EXTENDING COLLABORATION

2. Should the two parties formalise activities of a continuing nature between their institutions the terms and conditions will be contained in a separate cooperation agreement. In the case of a formal academic agreement, including guaranteed recognition of credit or a joint qualification, formal approval will also be obtained from the relevant Academic Board or the equivalent of each institution.

Each institution shall identify a member of its full-time academic staff as the academic coordinator and a member of its administrative staff responsible for the effective implementation of this LOI which may be amended at any time by written mutual consent through an exchange of letters. These liaison contacts will be outlined in Appendix One.


TERM AND TERMINATION


