



# 2. <u>Distinguished Speaker Invited for the Event</u>

1. Hon'ble Mr Justice Akhil Kumar Shrivastava (Retd),

Recognitions & Awards

Shri Justice A.K.Shrivastava was born in the family of lawyers on 31<sup>st</sup> January 1952, on the auspicious day of Vasant Panchami. Yourlordship's grandfather Babu

Parmeshwar Dayal, was an eminent layer who practiced in the High Court of Gwalior, and a pioneer in lexicology as he complied the very first English to Hindi law dictionary in the year 1939. Your lordship's revered father Shri J.P.Shrivastava, was an eminent lawyer, at Gwalior. His uncle Shri Shiv Dayal Shrivastava, was an eminent lawyer who later on became Judge and thereafter the adorned the seat of Chief Justice of the M.P. High Court.

In 1973, Shri A.K. Shrivastava, graduated in Science from Jiwaji University. He completed LL.B. in the year 1976 from the same University. Your lordship was enrolled as an Advocate in July 1976 and joined the chambers of advocate Shri B.C. Verma, who later on became Judge of M.P. High Court and the Chief Justice of Punjab and Haryana High Court. In 1977, your lordship joined his father Shri J.P. Shrivastava at Gwalior, and appeared for various transport corporations and companies. As a lawyer he specialized in labour, civil, constitution and revenue side of litigation. During 1985- 1989 he worked as a part time law professor as well in the MLB Law College, Gwalior.

On 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2002 Shri Justice A.K.Shrivastava, was elevated as Judge M.P. High Court, at bench Jabalpur. With a long term of over 11 years, he retired on 30.01.2014. the judgements passed by him are guiding factor for the entire Bar and Bench.

Twelve years as a High Court Judge, Justice Shrivastavaji was a relied giving Judge and one who would always motivate the spirits of the lawyers.

#### 2. Prof Dr Nisha Dube

A growth oriented professional and subject matter expert with 40 years of proven experience in the legal domain with extensive exposure to administration, knowledge based learning, teaching and creating social awareness towards legal rights and civic duties at large.

Dr Dube has contributed to social awareness through public speaking, TV programs, radio talks (primarily pertaining to legal rights for women and education to promote a progressive outlook in society). Dr Dube has guided more than 250 candidates.

Dr Dube has been appointed as a Vice Chancellor, Barkhatullah University, Bhopal from 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2010 to 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2014. She was the Head of law, University Teaching Department, Barkhatullah University, Bhopal from 2007-2010 and from 2015-2018. Dr Dube was the Former dean, Faculty of Law, Barkatullah University, Bhopal and DAVV Indore.

Dr Dube has also given significant contribution towards Human rights, as she was appointed as the Director, for Educational Programs conducted by State

Human Rights Commission (2001). Dr Dube has been associated as with spreading Human Rights awareness with particular reference to urban and rural, poor and illiterate people, handicapped children, juvenile delinquents, street children, senior citizens etc. She has rendered social service and worked for legal awareness among destitute women, rural women, semi literate and illiterate women in the form of talks, exhibition, poster displays, personal counseling etc. with the Government and Non-Government Organization. Dr Dube has participated in number of workshops, seminars, Group Discussion and has been invited as resource person/guest Speaker in workshops and Seminars.
