
National Service Scheme (NSS) units of Amity University Madhya Pradesh, AUMP organized Orientation Program for selected volunteers for the session 2020-21.

The day is recognized to commemorate his greatness and contributions in the field of mathematics like infinite series, number theory, mathematics analysis etc.


On this occasion, Dr. Santosh Kumar Sharma, HoD, Mathematics, ASET delivered a lecture to describe his life span and their contribution in the field of mathematics of such legendary mathematician, in all the first year classes through MS team. In the lecture, it was elaborated that he was never formally trained in the subject, yet he became one of the greatest mathematicians of all time.

Without any formal training of mathematics Srinivasa Ramanujan created several concepts and theorems of mathematics. By the age of 12 he mastered the advanced trigonometry book by S. L. Loney and at the age of 16 he studied the book A synopsis of elementary results in pure and applied



mathematics (containing 5000 theorems) written by G. S. Karr. In 1913, he started working with G. H. Hardy and J. E. Littlewood great English mathematicians. Then, he went to England and worked with G.H. Hardy for some time. But, due to his illness he returned India in 1919 and died on 26th April. 1920. During his very short span of life, he contributed 3900 results on Mathematics.





The Supreme Industry Ltd. had invited our Architecture and Civil Engineering Students and Faculties for an Industrial visit to the Knowledge Centre & Factory manufacturing unit of Plastic Pipes & Fittings at their Malanpur Plant through Corporate Resource Center (CRC) – AUMP. Supreme Industries Limited is an Indian plastics company, based in Mumbai. It handles volumes of over 420,000 tons of polymers annually. The company manufactures industrial and engineering molded furniture products, storage and material handling crates, multi-layer sheets, multi-layer films, packaging films, expanded polyethylene foam, PVC pipes, fittings, molded furniture, shatranj mats, and disposable EPS containers.

The Students of the Department of Civil Engineering, ASET, AUMP has learned the following information and knowledge from The Supreme Industries Limited, Malanpur plant.

- Piping is one of the most important system requirements in any industry. We need different piping products for various industrial applications like transportation of corrosive chemicals, hot and cold process water, abrasive materials, compressed air, etc.
- Conventional metal piping products have many demerits like poor resistance to corrosion and abrasion, chemical reactiveness, short and uncertain life span, and repeated maintenance requirements.
- This leads to leakages, and process interruptions and can badly affect the overall performance
 of the plants. Hence conventional products are not ideal to handle such aggressive materials;
 therefore we need efficient advanced piping systems.

Event titled: "REAXYS: A tool for Literature Search and Retrosynthesis of Chemicals and Pharmaceuticals"

Department of Chemistry, Amity School of Engineering and Technology, AUMP organized an international webinar titled "REAXYS: A tool for Literature Search and Retrosynthesis of Chemicals and Pharmaceuticals" on 26th February 2022 from 11:00 AM to 12:30 PM. The session started with the opening remarks of Hon'ble Pro-VC Sir. Then after, **Dr. Mandar Bodas**, PhD, Postdoc-University of Montreal, Canada, delivered a talk on Reaxys and demonstrated its' use in applying literature study.

The complete session was focused on the different methods of using Reaxys. Reaxys is a web-based tool for retrieving chemistry information and data from published literature, including journals and patents. The information includes chemical compounds, chemical reactions, chemical properties, related bibliographic data, substance data with synthesis planning information, and experimental procedures. Reaxys is built on expert-curated chemistry information and enriched with cutting-edge technology. It is also the leading database for bioactivity data. Scientists in corporate R&D and academia gain actionable insights that lead to innovation while saving time and money. Reaxys also supports teaching excellence in chemistry education.

A total of 319 participants from India, Indonesia, the Philippines, Egypt, Ethiopia, and Maxico have registered for the webinar out of which 120 have actively participated in the event. The event was conducted under the supervision of Maj Gen (Dr) SC Jain, VSM** (Retd) (Hol ASET), and was moderated by Dr. Rachana Kathal, Department of Chemistry. Kavach' is an anti-collision device (ACD) network. It is a Made-in-India technology that is designed to help Indian Railways achieve the goal of "zero accidents". Kavach' implementation will bring train movement to a halt automatically when it notices another train on the same line within a prescribed distance. Trains will also stop on their own when the digital system notices any manual error. It Receives inputs from satellites, communicate with each other using radio modems & use intelligence to act — To prevent 'dangerous' Collisions

The students learnt about the career development path also. They also learnt about the skill requirements by Industry for successful career path.

The students were happy and very excited during the visit. They got satisfactory answers to their questions from the Senior Engineer of the company. Visit may also be beneficial for further training of our students.







- 4. To develop Entrepreneurial skills







- 5. The importance of creative thinking and strategic thinking


About 170 students attended the workshop. The queries of the students were very well handled by the speaker. The overall feedback of the workshop was very positive.

TEACHERS' TRAINING PROGRAMME

A One Day Teachers' Training Programme was conducted by Dr Shweta Saxena, Assistant Professor, Amity Business School, Amity University Madhya Pradesh on June18, 2022 (Saturday) between 9 am – 1 pm in Model Convent High School, Gwalior for the teachers teaching in different classes and handling different subjects. The topic of the workshop was "Teaching Pedagogy and Bloom's Taxonomy".




Objectives of the Teachers' Training Programme

- 1. To help the teachers in understanding different teaching methods.
- 2. To make them understand Bloom's Taxonomy.
- 3. To make the teachers understand how to make the classes more interactive.
- 4. To help the teachers in changing their focus from teacher centred to student centred approach while teaching.
- 5. To make them understand the three levels of Bloom's Taxonomy i.e. Cognitive level, Affective and Psychomotor level.
- 6. To make them understand flipped classroom method and blended learning methods of teaching.
- 7. To help the teachers in learning about how to implement role play method.

Details of the Teachers Training Programme

The teachers were explained about the importance of implementing a mixture of different teaching pedagogies in their classes. They were taught about the importance of using blended learning and flipped classroom methods during teaching. The teachers were explained about the importance of using different teaching methods such as discussion method and role play method. They learnt about the importance of understanding Bloom's Taxonomy. They learnt about the three different levels of Bloom's Taxonomy i.e. Cognitive level, Affective level and Psychomotor level. At these levels, Head, Heart and Hands are involved in learning and implementing.





They learnt that at the very initial stage, the student remembers and understands the topic. Later on, during the class, the student applies his knowledge and understanding and stats analysing the things. In the last stage of hierarchy, the student starts evaluating and creating the things. For example, the student can write a poem or an essay or can create a working model during practical classes. The purpose is to understand the objectives of teaching.

The teachers were explained about the various teaching methodologies such as Case studies, Role Plays, Live projects, Industrial Visits, Group Assignments, etc.

They were encouraged to use a mixture of these methodologies while teaching.



•Growth zone- now we are at the stage where we have the purpose we live for our dreams.







All the participants very actively attended the lecture and took keen interest in all the sessions. They found all the sessions very useful and were very excited and enthusiastic during the entire lecture






