Amity University Madhya Pradesh has been established by the Ritnand Balved Education Foundation (RBEF), New Delhi which is a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and was established by the **Madhya Pradesh Legislature through an amendment in Madhya Pradesh Niji Vishwavidyalay (Sthapna Avam Sanchalan) Adhiniyam – 2007 as Madhya Pradesh Act (No. 27 of 2010) vide State Government Notification No. 7692-402-इक्कीस-अ-(प्रा.) dated 30.12.2010, and is recognized as per Section 2(f) of the UGC Act.**

The First Statutes of the University were published in Madhya Pradesh Gazette on 28.12.2012 vide Notification No.52 and the First Ordinances of the University were published in Madhya Pradesh Gazette on 05.04.2013 vide Notification No. 14.

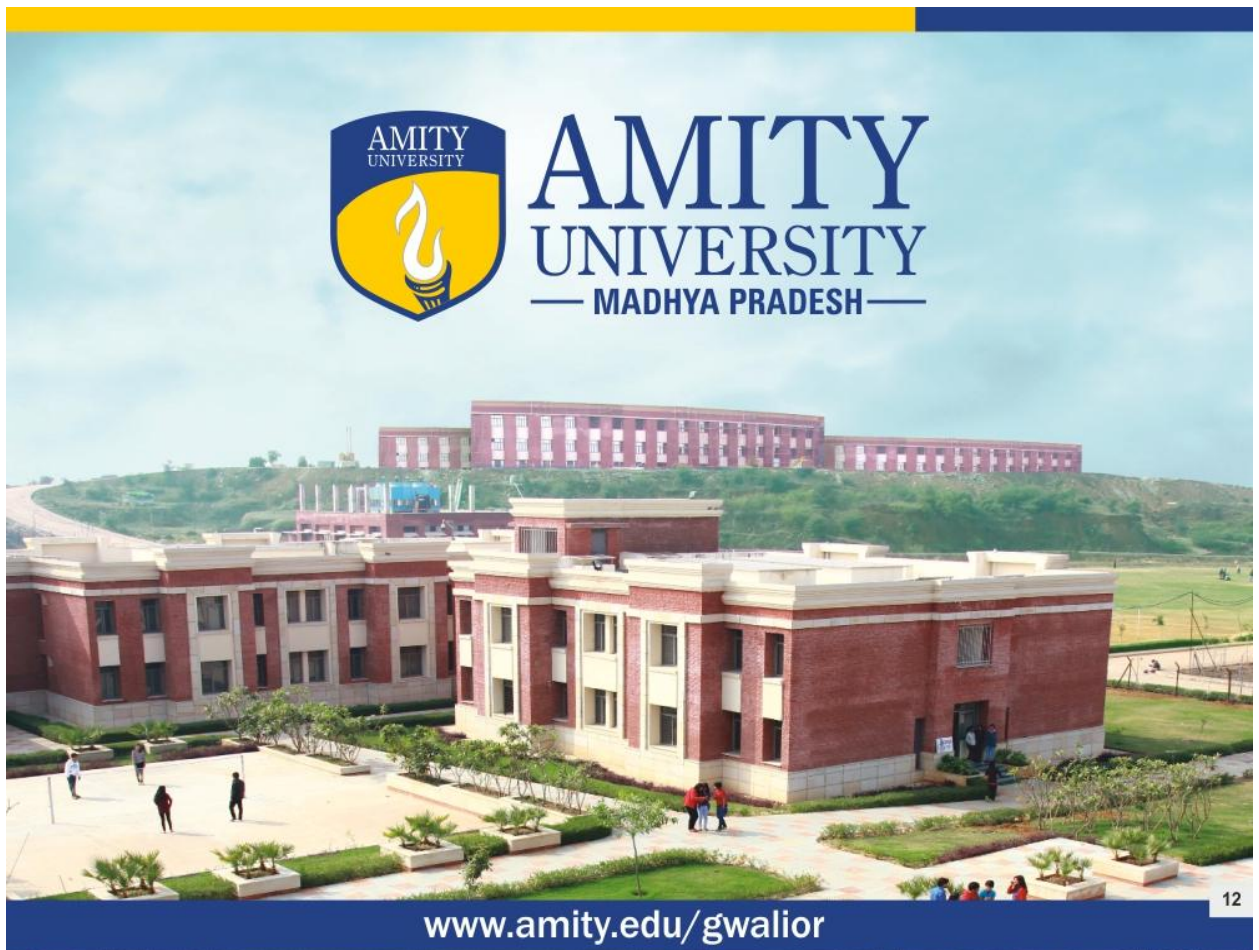

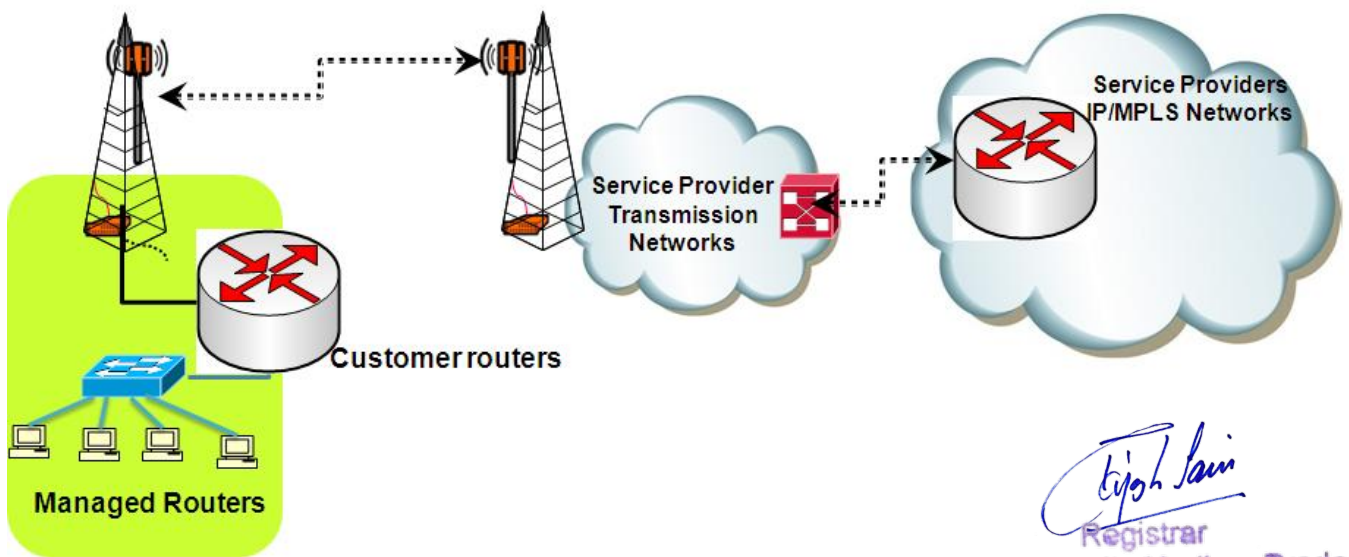

# HOSTELS

The University has two large hostels one for boys and one for girls with capacity of 240 each. Separate facilities for boys and girls, caring wardens, and tight security ensure a pleasant stay for students. The mantra of Amity hostel staff is to create a home away from home for all hostel students. This is achieved by ensuring 24 hours power and water supply, clean, well-lit, spacious rooms, common rooms with television, geysers in bathrooms, and window with wire mesh to keep out mosquitoes. Each student is provided with a separate bed, mattress, pillow and study table.

All hostels are Wi-Fi enabled, and the students can access the net 24/7 from their rooms. The students are provided a free laundry service, and have 24 hours access to the Medical Room.

Each hostel is surrounded by a boundary wall and entry to the hostel is restricted to only those students who are staying in hostel. The hostellers are required to show their identity cards to the security personnel posted at hostel gates and also sign their entry using bio-metric device installed in each hostel.

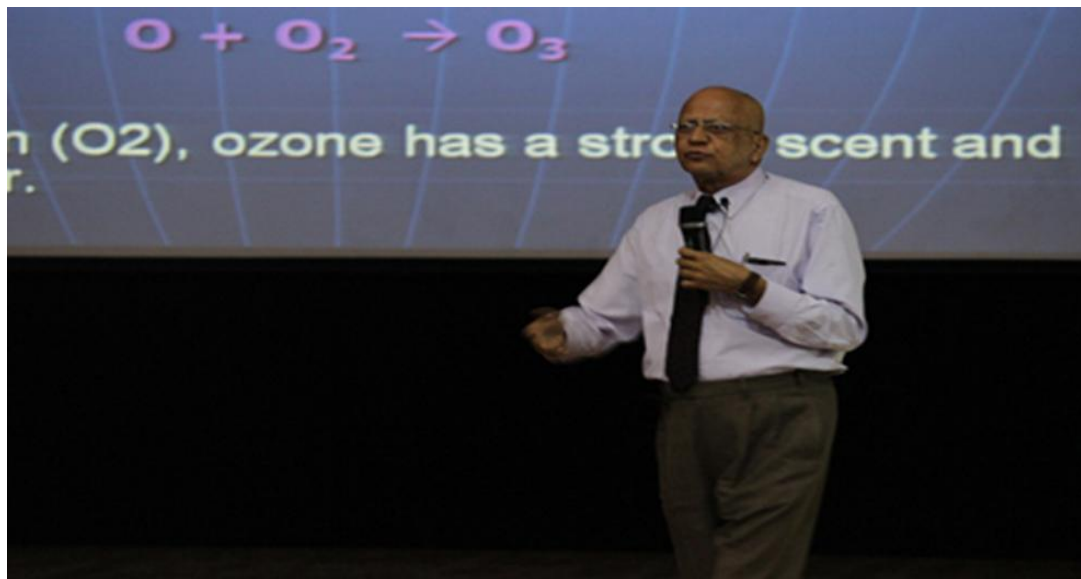
