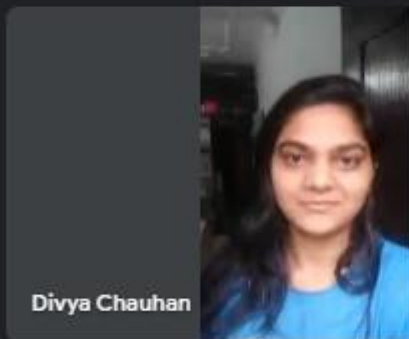

The lecture was aimed at providing professional insight to the students of U.G., P.G. And MPhil of AIBAS about the Biological, Psychological and Social aspects of mental health.

Dr Atul Agrawal (Professor, Department of Psychiatry, G. R. Medical College, Gwalior) addressed various topics ranging from the historical development of Psychiatry, to Biological, Psychological and Social factors which contribute to mental health problems among people. Dr Agarwal enlightened students as to how the multidisciplinary approach is beneficial for mental health and rehabilitation.
