World Youth Day Celebration, 12-26 Jan 2024

HIV AIDS Awareness Campaign and Survey with the theme “Community Leadership and Collaboration” by volunteers of Red Ribbon Club for support staff of AUMP

(12-26 Jan 2024)

As part of AUMP's National Youth Day Celebrations, the Red Ribbon Club held an AIDS awareness survey and competition program. Madhya Pradesh AIDS Control Society, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare had issued guidelines vide letter IEEC/RRC/2023-24/105, dated 10.1.2024, which were followed by the Red Ribbon Club of AUMP. From January 23 to 25, a comprehensive HIV/AIDS awareness campaign was held in the AUMP campus. Employees including all support staff, security guards and contract staff were the intended audience. The survey was organized with the aim to understand people's perception, attitude and knowledge about HIV AIDS. Our goal was to fill the knowledge gaps and create a supportive, healthier, happier staff and student interaction in the AUMP campus.

One of the most likely responses given to the RRC volunteers was that the public knew very little about HIV/AIDS, with some individuals learning about it through volunteer awareness campaign. The volunteers felt pleased to educate them and make them aware about HIV AIDS. After speaking with almost every member of the campus staff, RRC succeeded in raising awareness and educating people about HIV/AIDS. We view this study as a critically important step toward the welfare of society through RRC.

The security guards, peons, gardeners, and support staff at AUMP appreciated the work of the Red Ribbon Club volunteers. They also shared their knowledge in addition to being advised on precautions against HIV/AIDS. The RRC volunteers were happy to share their survey experiences with one another. All of the AUMP support staff and the volunteers from the Red Ribbon Club got along well.

Honorable Pro Chancellor, Lt Gen V K Sharma AVSM (Retd) highly appreciated this effort of the Red Ribbon Club volunteers of AUMP. He reiterated that there is an urgent need for education and to create awareness and a culture of care about people HIV/AIDS. Honorable Pro Vice Chancellor Dr. Anil Vashishth said that such activities are required to enhance the belongingness of the staff in AUMP.

Cultural evening to represent various states of the county as well as the cultural heritage of Madha Pradesh was the event most cherished by the volunteers after the tiring activities of donation of labor and other activities of the camp including cooking of breakfast, tea, lunch, dinner, cleaning and physical training. Awareness campaigns was also organized on the same day on proper nutrition for good ophthalmic health along with the eye checkup camp in Chakraipur. The volunteers gave the villagers a thorough explanation of the numerous ocular disorders, as well as general care, remediation, etc. The village's common residents were made aware by the volunteers of the need for caution when it came to eye health. A team of 6 doctors and staff of Shivani Hospital, Morar, Gwalior examined the eyes of 123 patients with various ailments and diseases and advised them case specific remedial measures. With the highest possible attendance from the community, the villagers also responded to the efforts of NSS volunteers and doctors, promising to continue being watchful for their ocular health going forward. The campaign was launched at 09:30 by 15 NSS volunteers, and it ended at 15:30.
