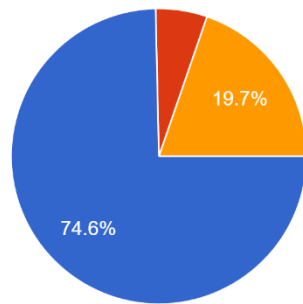

Which of the following best represents the "three pillars of sustainability"?

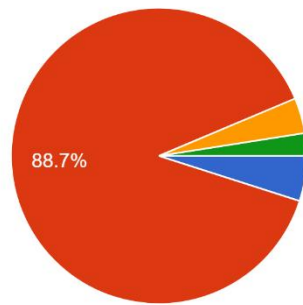

What is a major cause of climate change?

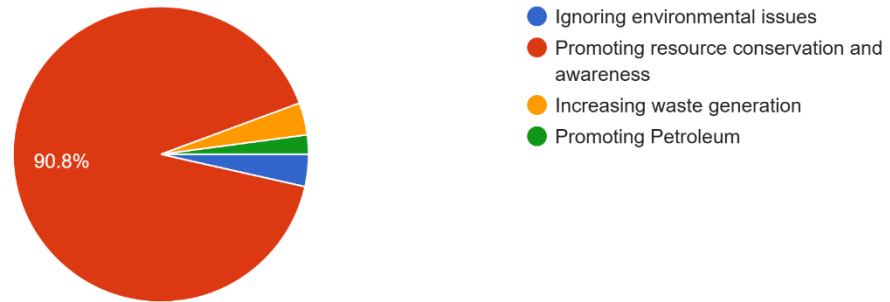

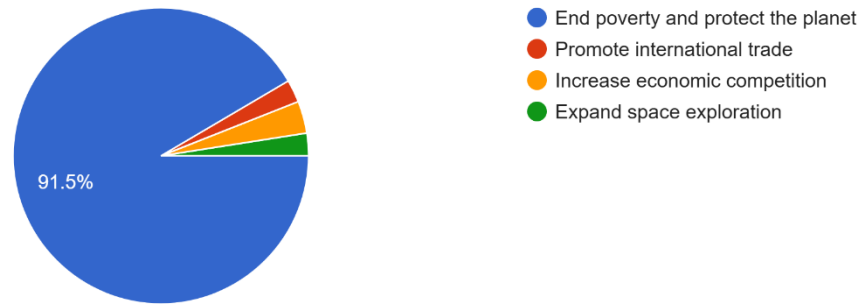
Which of the following actions can contribute to sustainability in a university?

What is the primary goal of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)?

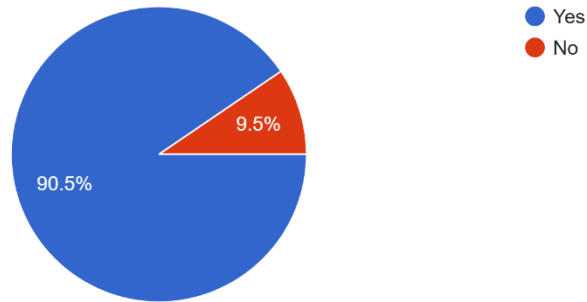

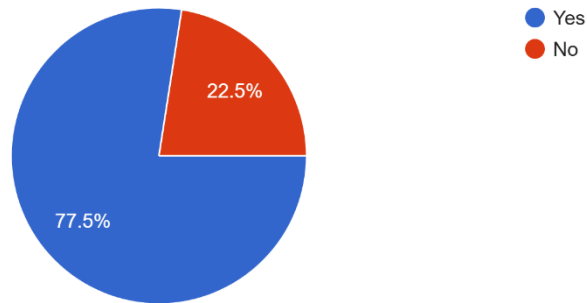
Are you aware of any sustainability policies or practices implemented by our university?

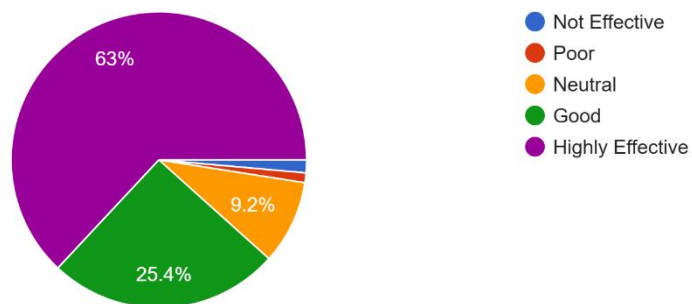
Have you participated in any sustainability-related events, training, or campaigns at the university?

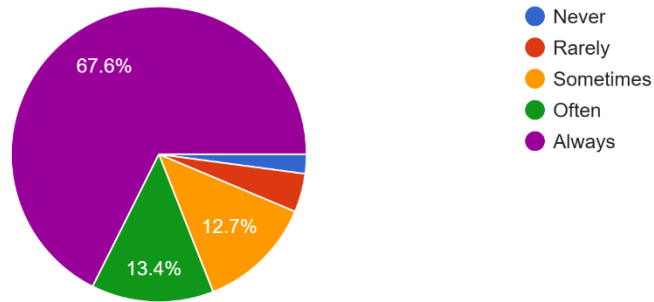
How effective do you think the university is in promoting sustainability among staff and students?

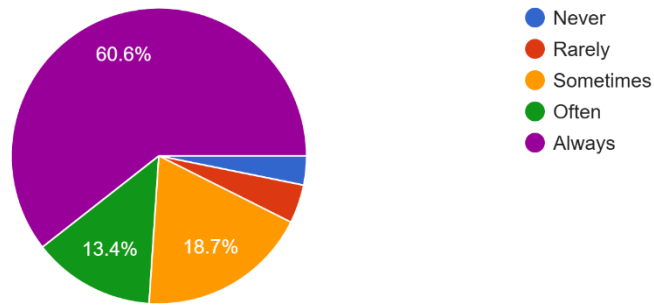
Does your department integrate sustainable practices in its daily operations?

Are sustainability topics discussed during staff meetings or departmental planning?

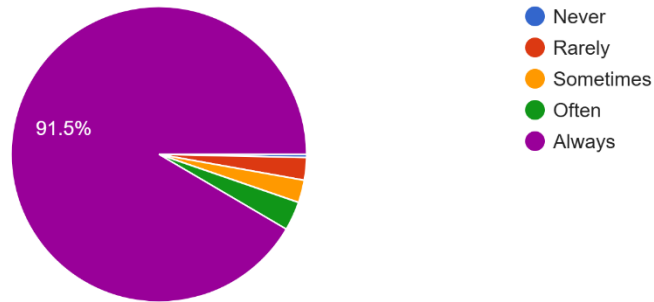

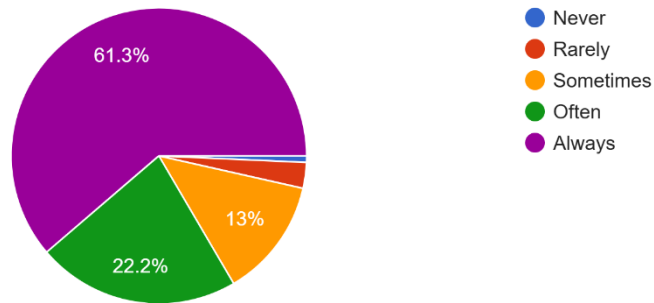
Do you regularly switch off lights and equipment when not in use?

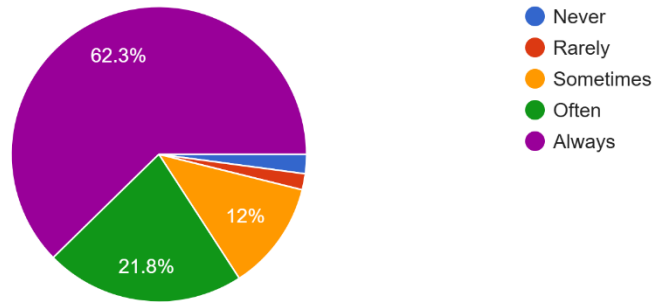
How often do you use digital alternatives to reduce paper usage?
