## **ESTABLISHMENT OF AMITY UNIVERSITY MADHYA PRADESH**

### **About AUMP**

Amity University Madhya Pradesh (AUMP) was established by Ritnand Balved Education Foundation (RBEF) at Gwalior by Madhya Pradesh Niji Vishwavidyalaya (Sthapna Avam Sanchalan) Adhiniyam – 2007 and Dwitiya Sanshodhan Adhiniyam (No. 27 of 2010) vide State Government Notification No. 7692-406 dated 30 Dec 2010, with the view to promote professional, industry-oriented education in the state of Madhya Pradesh. Amity University Madhya Pradesh, Gwalior located on a sprawling campus of 102 acres of land opposite Gwalior Airport, imparts modern, practical and research-oriented courses which lead to the development of professionals who are employable and industry ready. This in turn drives the socio-economic upliftment of the region.

Amity University Madhya Pradesh (AUMP) imparts education in almost all areas including Management, Engineering, Architecture, Biotechnology, Law, Journalism & Mass Communication, Behavioral Science, Psychology, Fashion, Social Science and Liberal Arts, Pharmacy etc.

AUMP has state of the art infrastructure with modern amenities which matches with the best across the country and is of international standards. The whole campus is wi-fi enabled. Electricity is available 24X7 and all the buildings are airconditioned.

The University has its own intranet named AMIZONE (Acronym for Amity Intranet Zone), which is equipped to store all the academics and administrative data of the University, thus promoting digitalization. Session Plans, Lesson Plans, Examination Details, Fee Details, Payment Details, Attendance Report, Grievance Redressal, and other administrative details are all available on AMIZONE. The students can access study material and tutorials anytime, anywhere which is a step towards beyond classroom teaching. Mentor-Mentee system is in place in the campus with the objective of mentoring and recognizing the potential of students and to help improve their self-esteem and confidence. Apart from this trained counsellors have been appointed to provide prompt assistance on issues related to health and emotional wellness.

The courses offered by AUMP are evaluated regularly to achieve the course objectives based on the feedback on placement, employability and latest development in technology to keep pace with the changing times. Faculties and students of AUMP are encouraged to carry out industry oriented, cutting edge research work in the University. The faculties of AUMP have been

successful in getting several sponsored projects from various state and national funding agencies.

Grooming and etiquette, Communication Enhancement Classes, Behavioural Science, One Foreign Language, Pre-placement Training Classes, and Aptitude Training Classes are a part of curriculum, which helps in overall development of the students. The University offers a Choice Based Credit System, wherein a student can select any one of the 36 minor tracks across disciplines. This encourages inter-disciplinary learning. Amity University Madhya Pradesh has been witnessing stellar placements year after year which are a testimony to the trust of the recruiters in our brand. Our placements over last 3 years i.e 2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20 have been ranging between 90.82%, 98.85% & 93.38% respectively. The faith of marquee recruiters like Coca-Cola, Hitachi Consulting, AMAZON, S&P Global, TCS, INFOSYS, WIPRO, ZYCUS, TEK Systems, Asian Paints, Direct i among others was reflected by the increase in the number of offers rolled out. The increase in the number of unique roles and profiles offered by the companies showcased the unwavering support that Amity University Gwalior enjoys and this sets the stage for a mutually beneficial association between the participants and the recruiters in the forthcoming years.

The University was ranked under Top 200 in the University Category by National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) India Ranking 2020 and Amity Institute of Engineering Technology was all India ranked 154<sup>th</sup> in the year 2021 and 162<sup>nd</sup> in the year 2020 in Engineering Category.

Amity University Madhya Pradesh was awarded as the Best Private University in Madhya Pradesh in the year 2014 by CMAI Association of India and in years 2017, 2018 and 2019 by Dialogue India Group. Amity University Madhya Pradesh was also awarded Excellent Higher Education University in India by CMAI Association of India in 2017. The University was awarded “Utkrisht Vishwavidyalaya Samman” by Madhya Pradesh Private University Regulatory Commission, Bhopal in 2018. The University has been bestowed with ‘Excellent University Award 2020’ by Zee News. AUMP has been awarded a Five Star Rating under “Eat Right Campus” Competition conducted by Food Standard, Safety Authority of India under the aegis of “Eat Right India” campaign launched by Govt. of India. The University has been accredited as “Premier University” by Accreditation Service for International Colleges (ASIC), UK. Three (03) faculty members of Amity University Madhya Pradesh have been awarded Young Scientist Award by Madhya Pradesh Council of Science and Technology, Govt of Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal. The Journal of Content, Community & Communication (JCCC) published by AUMP is a Scopus Indexed and ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> best media journal in India. The University has established following five Centres of Excellence:

- a) Centre for Excellence for Chemical Biological Radiological and Nuclear (CBRN) Mitigation

- b) Centre of Excellence in Nanobiotechnology and Alternative Medicine
- c) The Centre of Excellence for Gwalior as a Smart City
- d) Centre for Excellence in Detection of Fake News and Disinformation
- e) Centre for Excellence for Environmental Conservation & Biodiversity

The University has established a Meditation Cell of Amity Law School (ALS). In addition to opening Legal Aid Centres, Judges/Judicial officers are also being trained in Mediation so that out of court settlement specially in family related court cases, can be resorted to. These twin measures initiated by the Apex Court, High Courts and District Courts will go a long way and will stand in good stead to dispense justice to the poor, which is cheap and quick

The University was shortlisted for the National Swachhta Ranking Awards for the years 2017, 2018 and 2019 and an Inspection Team constituted by UGC-MHRD visited the University for Assessment for all the three years.

Amity University Madhya Pradesh is a leading innovation & research driven university and has played a significant role in education by providing world class education to the society, thus out performing in the area of Private Education in the state of Madhya Pradesh.

Amity University Madhya Pradesh has been established by the Ritnand Balved Education Foundation (RBEF), New Delhi which is a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and was established by the **Madhya Pradesh Legislature through an amendment in Madhya Pradesh Niji Vishwavidyalay (Sthapna Avam Sanchalan) Adhiniyam – 2007 as Madhya Pradesh Act (No. 27 of 2010) vide State Government Notification No. 7692-402-इक्कीस-अ-प्रा dated 30.12.2010, and is recognized by UGC vide letter No. 8-33/2010 (CPP-I/PU) dated 24.08.2011.**

The First Statutes of the University were published in Madhya Pradesh Gazette on 28.12.2012 vide Notification No.52 and the First Ordinances of the University were published in Madhya Pradesh Gazette on 05.04.2013 vide Notification No. 14.

There are more than 40 laboratories where students can get first-hand learning experience in different areas like Mechanical, Electronics, Information Technology, Welding, Construction, Biotechnology, Fashion, Design, Communication Skills, Photography, Pharmacy etc.



**Computer Laboratories:** Amity University has 11 computer labs with more than 500 computers with latest configurations. All computer labs are well maintained by a dedicated IT staff and have latest hardware and licensed softwares available on the system. The softwares take care of the needs of all the students. As an ongoing process, these labs are upgraded regularly with software as per syllabi of the students.

E-Resources: The Library of AUMP is enriched with more than 500,000 e- materials like e- Books, e- Magazines, Conference Proceedings, & Audio-visual Lectures etc. via our own domain i.e., Amizone.net, where all e-resources are available for AUMP users.

Beside this the central Library along with six departmental Libraries are fully Automated by KOHA Library management (Software). All these libraries are running under the supervision of fully trained and knowledgeable library staff.

The University also has the membership of very reputed Learning & Reading platforms like DELNET, All India Reporter (AIR), Supreme court cases Online (SSC Online), World E- Books Library (WEL), South Asian Archives and National Digital Library. The University has also signed an MoU with Shodhganga (INFLIBNET).

The Research scholars & student can use the e-material of AUMP not only from the library they can also access the e-materials from their home via remote access through amizone.net



## Hostels

The University has three large hostels; two for boys and one for girls with capacity of 240 each totaling to 720. Separate facilities for boys and girls, caring wardens, and tight security ensure a pleasant stay for students. The mantra of Amity hostel staff is to create a 'home away from home' for all hostel students.



This is achieved by ensuring 24 hours power and water supply, clean, well-lit, spacious rooms, common rooms with television, geysers in bathrooms, and windows with wire mesh to keep out mosquitoes. Each student is provided with a separate bed, mattress, pillow and study table. Each hostel is surrounded by a boundary wall and entry to the hostel is restricted to only those students who are staying in hostel. The hostellers are required to show their identity cards to the security personnel posted at hostel gates and also sign their entry using bio-metric device installed in each hostel. All hostels are Wi-Fi enabled, and the students can access the net 24/7 from their rooms. The students are provided a free laundry service and have 24 hours access to the Medical Room.

**Cafeterias:** In addition to the students' Mess located in the hostels, the University has 04 cafeterias and 01 Milk parlor. Each academic block has one cafeteria, which serves hot, hygienic and good quality food at highly subsidized rates. The cafeteria makes a vibrant & informal meeting place for the students where friendships for a lifetime are nurtured. The quality of the food is monitored on a regular basis by a committee comprising University officials and students.



**Auditorium:** A State-of-the-art auditorium with a combined seating capacity of over 600 persons acts as a common ground for students, faculty and corporate personalities for regular interfaces, conferences and other events. This auditorium facilitates in bringing students face to face with global thought leaders, academic gurus and corporate heads to share their experiences.



**Seminar Halls:** Amity has 02 Seminar Halls with a seating capacity of 300 each. Extremely well designed, the Seminar Halls have all the audio-visual facilities for conducting seminars, conferences and guest lectures for a large gathering of students.



**Conference Halls:** There are 02 Conference Halls in the University, one each in Academic Blocks A & B. These conference halls are equipped with audio-visual aids and can be used for video/audio conferencing as well as presentations.



**Moot Court:** Amity has a state-of-the-art moot court which is constantly engaged in providing a hands-on learning experience to the students of Law.

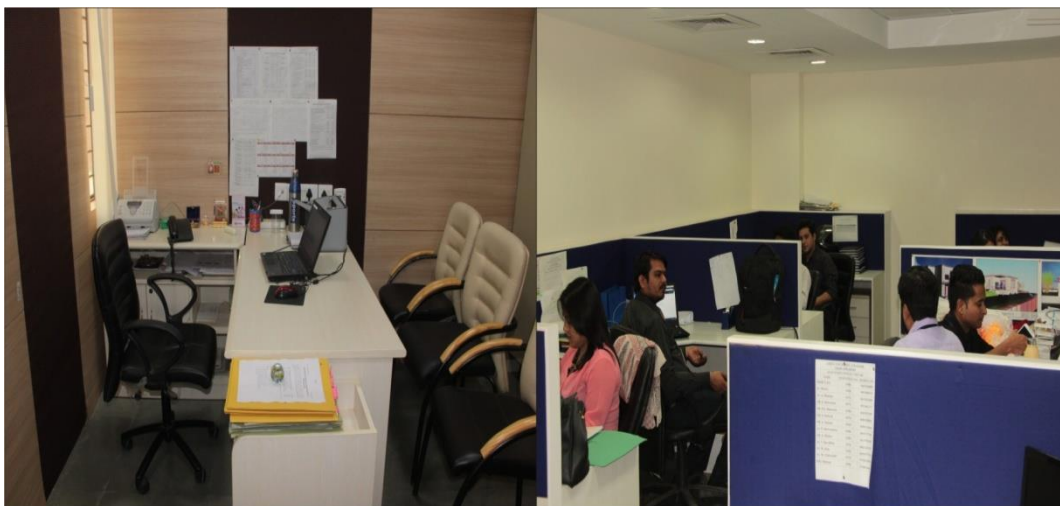

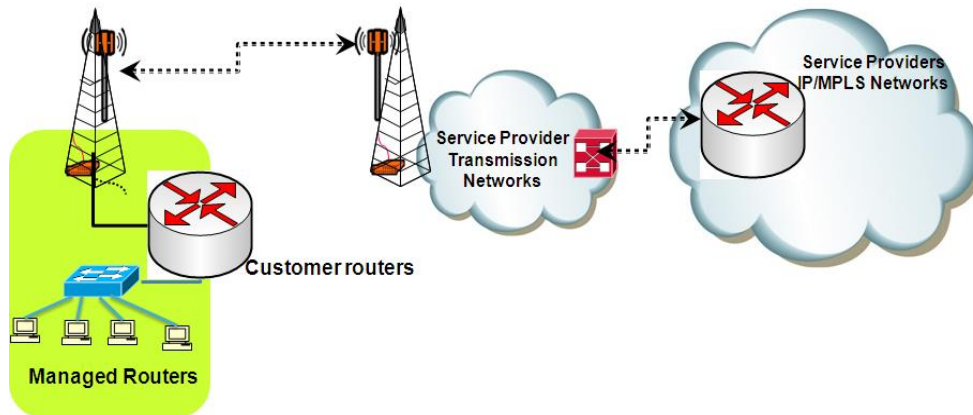


**Offices and Faculty Rooms:** Amity is committed to the welfare of its staff and students. To enable a harmonious teaching-learning environment, the teaching faculty and staff members are accommodated in 49 staff cabins and 178 work stations which are spread across all Academic Blocks.



**Institutional Networking:** Entire Campus including Hostel is Wi-Fi enabled. Additionally, telephones with networking facility to connect to other Amity Universities and Delhi Office have also been provided. A dedicated bandwidth of 300 MBPS is available.

**Studio Type Accommodation for Faculty:** Amity provides studio type accommodations to its faculty and staff. 10 such well furnished studio apartments are available in the campus.



**Stationary Shop:** Amity University Madhya Pradesh also has a stationery shop in its campus and is managed by a contractor. Students/faculty members/Staff can avail the facility during the working hours. Apart from the stationery items it also facilitates photocopy (both color and black & white), Scanning, Printing, Lamination and Internet facilities.



**ATM (Automated Teller Machine):** In order to facilitate the students, staff of Amity University ATM Facility is available at prime location in the University campus.



**Medical Facility:** The medical room is located within the hostel so that the students can easily avail medical care. For emergencies and major medical problems an ambulance is available to ferry the sick to multi-specialty hospitals. A male as well as female Medical Assistant for boys and girls promote the necessary medical care.



# SPORTS

Sports and games are important for all-round development and are an important part of our routine. Moreover, along with routine education, they help to shape our personalities. Also, they keep our bodies strong, healthy, and fit. They give us a change from the same old routine and relax our mind and body. Moreover, they are important because they are a useful means of entertainment as well as a way to do physical activity. Furthermore, they build character and give a huge amount of energy and strength.



## **SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT**

1. Solid waste is generated by all the staff, students and visitors who visit the campus regularly. This waste is generated in the form of packing materials, unserviceable/retrieved maintenance items, stationery paper, food items and dry leaves fallen from trees on the roads/ parking.
2. The stationery paper waste and other food items is collected in the waste bins (both degradable and non-degradable) installed in the academic blocks in sufficient numbers. The waste generated in the academic blocks is transported to the central waste rooms and further segregated into sellable and other unusable. And finally, both the sellable and unused waste is lifted by the local vendor for which he pays monthly charges.
3. The waste retrieved from maintenance items are sold quarterly/half yearly to the local vendor by Board of Staff ordered by Dir Admin.
4. The dry leaves fallen on the roads/parking, is collected by housekeeping staff and are transported to the compost pits available in the campus wherein they are dumped into the pits for making compost naturally.

## **LIQUID WASTE MANAGEMENT**

1. Liquid waste is generated by all the staff, students and visitors visiting the campus regularly. This waste is generated in the form of sewerage and wastewater from toilets and cafeterias. This liquid is channelized to manhole's installed outside the blocks and further transported to the collection chambers and further lifted/raised through sewage pumps to the STPs installed in the campus.
2. 02 STPs of capacity 2.1 LLPD and 1.6 LLPD are installed for taking care of liquid waste generated in the campus. This waste is further treated with various process at STPs and finally treated water is used in toilets for flushing (in hostels) and for horticulture purposes.

## **WASTE RECYCLING SYSTEM**

1. Liquid waste generated in academic blocks and hostels is transported to STPs through sewerage pipeline. And this waste is further treated with various process at STPs and finally treated/recycled water is used in toilets for flushing (in hostels) and for horticulture purposes.
2. The dry leaves/cutting waste obtained from hedge cutting/ tree trimming are further recycled/converted into compost naturally. And this compost is utilized in Campus horticulture.

## **RAIN WATER HARVESTING SYSTEM**

1. The University has 10 Nos of Borewells in the campus. The borewells dug in the campus do not have enough ground water to yield water continuously. Half of the borewells dry up during continuous pumping. To recharge these existing borewells and to restrict the out-flow of rainwater Amity University has constructed 10 Water Harvesting Pits of capacity 30,000 ltrs at various locations (Water Catchment Area) 10 conserve rainwater. These pits have been provided enough filter media to restrict the mud/silt during rains.
2. The above has brought sea change in saving of rainwater and has thus improved the water level, of our borewells which helps us in meeting our water requirement in peak summers.
3. This has also been applauded by Hon'ble High Court Gwalior MP Local Newspaper.

## GREEN INITIATIVE

With an aim to promote clean and green energy, the University has successfully installed roof top solar panels in its 03 Academic Blocks with a total capacity of 305 KW. The electricity bill has been reduced by its earlier amount approximately 10% per month of the total bill amount.

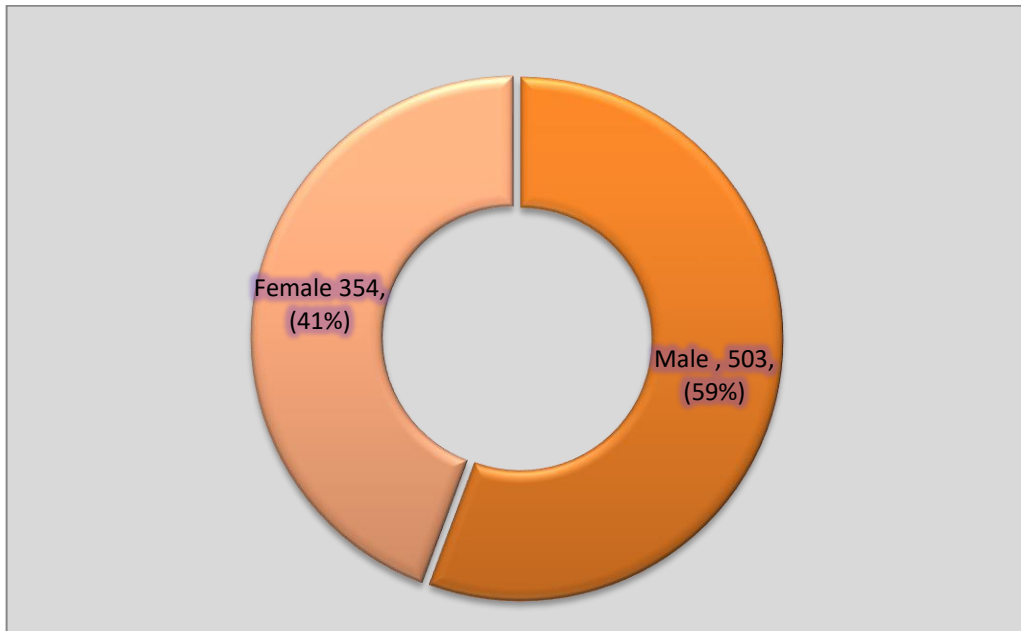

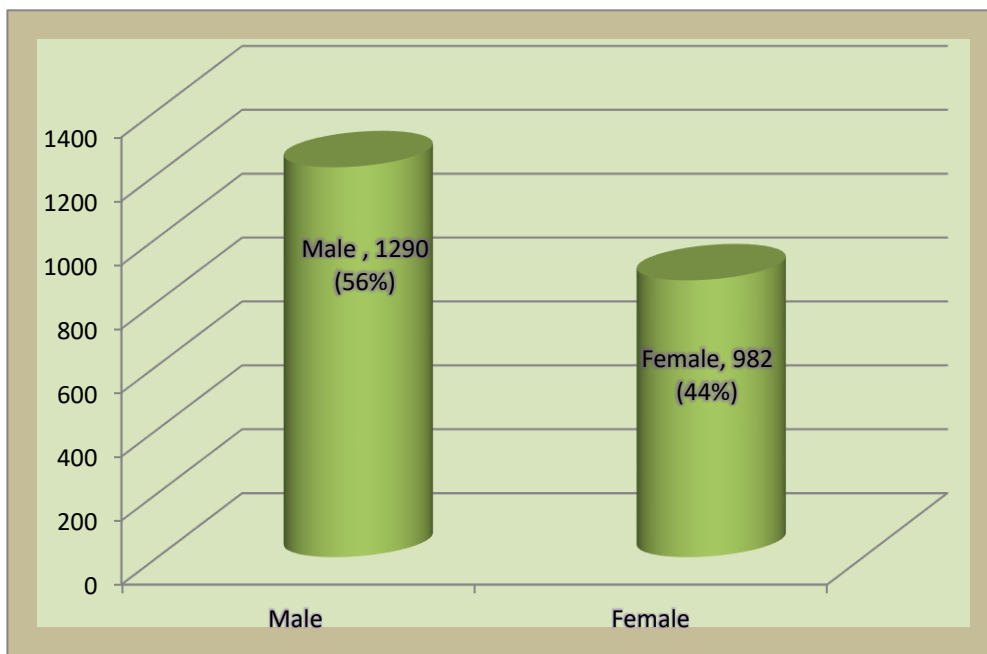

**a) Gender Wise Strength of Students Admitted in 2020-21: (Total)**

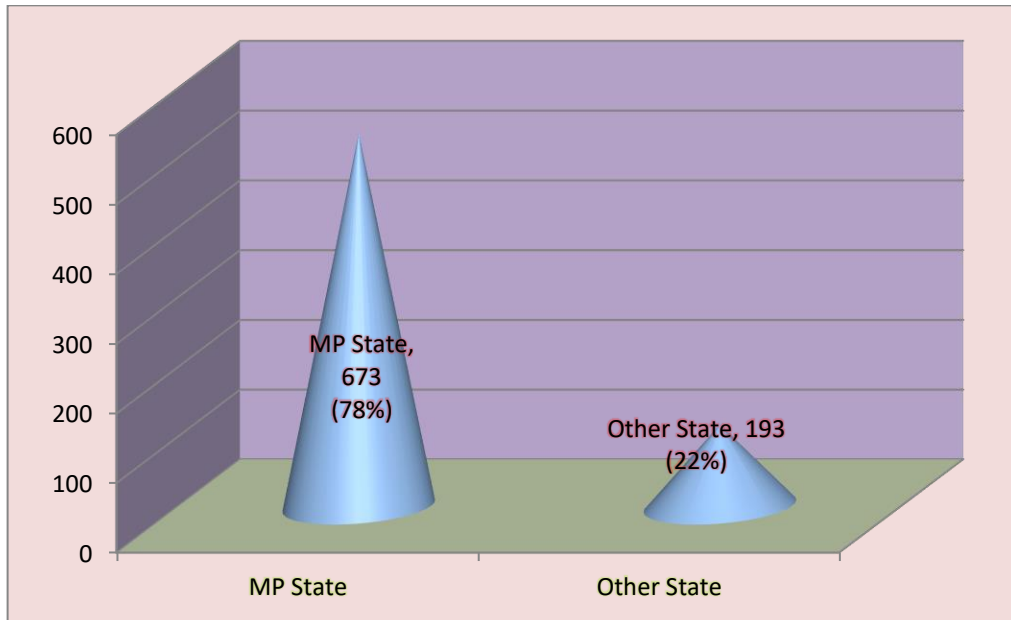


**(b) Total Gender Wise Strength of Students (Total: 2020-21)**

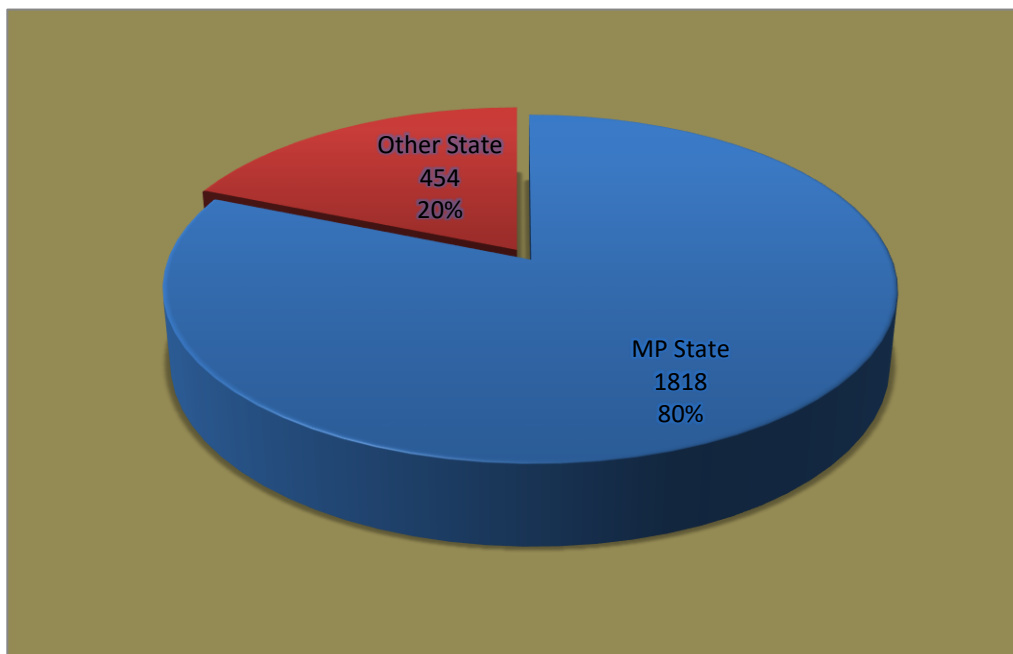




**c) State Wise Strength of Students Admitted in 2020-21**

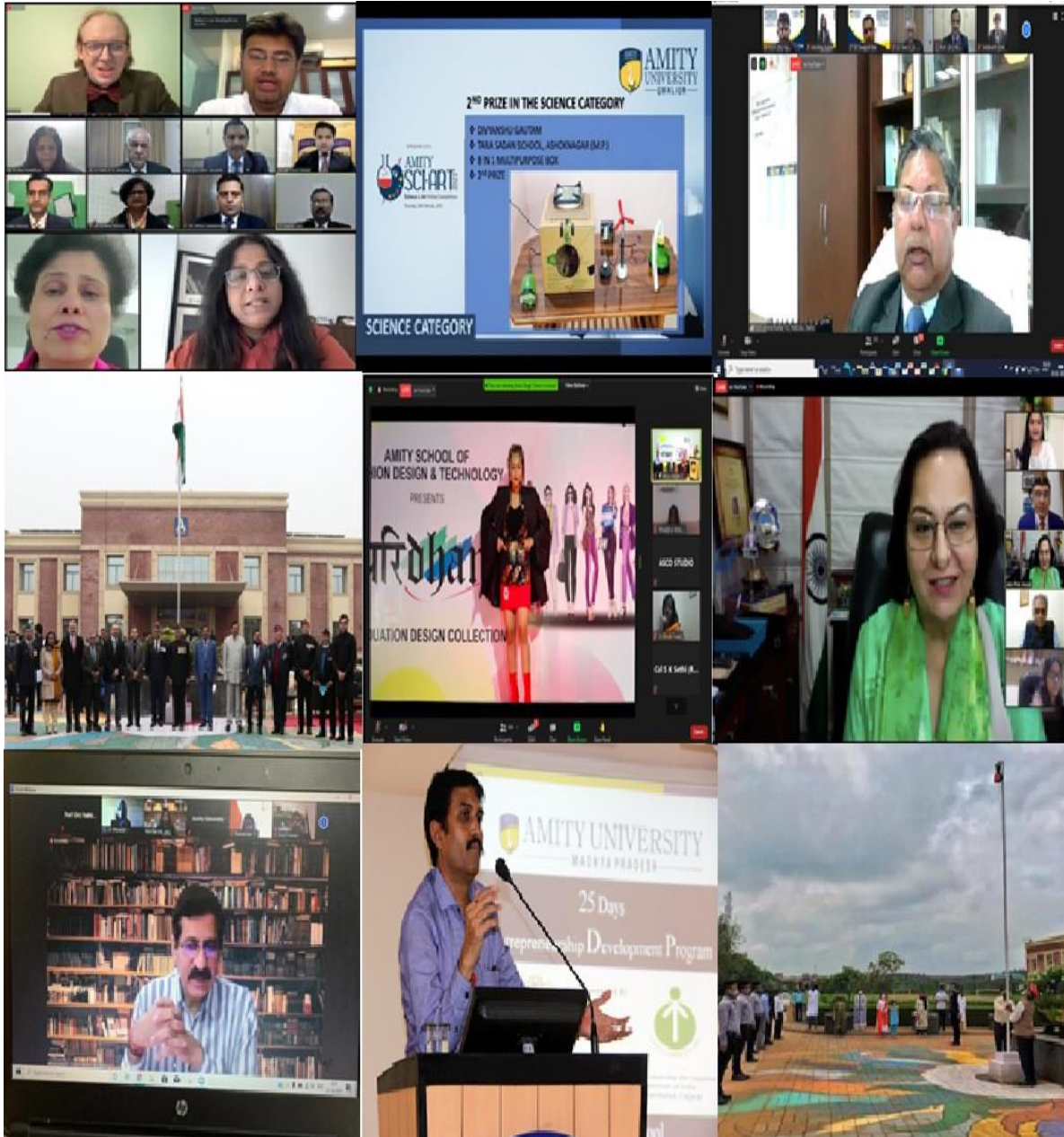


## Commencement OF NCC

## **INCENTIVES FOR FACULTY MEMBERS & STAFF**

1. **Performance Based Annual Increment.** In Amity University Madhya Pradesh, performance based annual increments are given to all the staff and faculty members. Percentage of increment to the faculties are linked to their Annual Performance Indicator (API plus) and their overall performance and in respect of other employees, it is performance based on written recommendations of their HoIs/HoDs.
  
2. **Financial Assistance for Attending Seminars/ Conferences/Workshops.** Faculty members are provided financial assistance for attending national and international conferences/seminars/workshops in accordance with University policy. Members of faculty AUMP have been provided financial assistance for attending national and international seminars/workshops/conferences/FDP.
  
3. **Fee Concession and Special Increments for Ph.D.**50% fee concessions are being provided to the faculty members who have registered for Ph.D. degree at AU MP. On successful completion of Ph.D., a faculty member is given two increments as an incentive. If the faculty member continues to serve in the University for a period of 3years, after the completion of Ph.D. then the balance of 50% fee paid by him/her is also reimbursed.
  
4. **Medical Insurance for Staff and Faculty Members.** All the staffs and faculty members of AU MP are covered under Medical Insurance Scheme and the premium is paid by the University. Three renowned hospitals of Gwalior named RJN Spectra Super specialty Hospital, BIMR Hospital, Govil Hospital, Kalyan Hospital and Shree Diagnostic have been associated with AUMP where cashless treatment is available to the employees of AUMP.



## **Initiatives taken by the University for Quality Mandate and Implementation of National Education Policy 2020**

The following actions with regard to Quality Mandate and NEP 2020 have been initiated and implemented at Amity University Madhya Pradesh:

### **1. Induction programme for students - Deeksharambh**

Induction programme for the new entrants is in place at Amity University Madhya Pradesh, to help students to get accustomed to the new environment, inculcate in them the culture of the institution and assist them to build relationship with the faculty and other students.

### **2. Learning outcome-based curriculum framework (LOCF)**

Amity University Madhya Pradesh is a student centric institution, which has been following choice based credit system (CBCS). The curriculum has been revised by adopting learning outcome-based curriculum framework (LOCF) to maintain the academic standards, which would assist the graduates to compete at the global level.

### **3. Adoption of ICT based learning tools for effective teaching-learning process**

For effective teaching-learning process, ICT based learning tools such as learning management system (LMS), Amity internet zone (Amizone) etc. have been adopted. It is mandatory for all the students to choose a few subjects referred to as 'minor track subjects' from other disciplines offered in the institution. However, an option is given to a student wherein he/she can select MOOC/SWAYAM courses instead of minor track subjects. Due to prevailing pandemic situation, the classes (both theory and laboratory courses) are conducted through online mode using Microsoft Team (MS Team) – one of the robust and user-friendly online platforms. The faculty members customize the pedagogy and assessment methods using various means for learners, to make the teaching-learning process effective.

### **4. Imparting life skills to students – Jeevan Kaushal**

Life skills are being imparted to the students as it addresses the students' needs, improves their self-confidence, interpersonal, social and emotional skills required for leading a professional life.

### **5. Social and Industry connect: University social responsibility**

Inputs are taken from the industry experts while preparing the curriculum, so that the students get familiarized with the cutting-edge technologies and are industry ready. Summer Internship Programme (SIP) is in place wherein students of B.Tech course visit the industry for a period of 4 to 6 weeks (during the 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> semester summer holidays) so that they an exposure to enhance his/her technical skills further.

## **6. Evaluation reforms**

Students are evaluated on the basis of continuous assessment and grading system is followed. Some of the assessment methods used are seminars, assignments, project-based evaluation, presentation of a case study etc. Standards are maintained while setting question papers and evaluation of answer scripts. The entire examination system is automated and has been used effectively. Due to the prevailing pandemic situation, end semester exams are conducted through two types of online mode namely Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) and Open Book Examination (OBE)

## **7. Tracking of the student progress after completion of course**

Every department as an alumni coordinator to monitor the progress of the students after they complete their course. The alumni coordinator contacts them regularly and communicates to them the important events of the department/university.

## **8. Faculty development – Gurudakshata**

Amity University Madhya Pradesh maintains standards at the time of recruitment of faculty. Faculty induction programme for the newly joined faculty is conducted and ample opportunities are provided to the faculty to participate in faculty development programmes/refresher course organized by the institutions of national importance.

## **9. Quality research and creation of new knowledge**

Amity University Madhya Pradesh is a research and innovation driven university wherein faculty is expected to do quality research. Faculty members are motivated to publish research papers only in the journals that are indexed in Scopus or Web of Science. Incentives are being provided to the faculty who publish quality research papers, carry out research projects and consultancy assignments, file/publish a patent etc.

## **Unique Selling Propositions (USPs) of Amity University Madhya Pradesh for Quality Education**

### **1. Mentor-Mentee System.**

An important and significant feature of Amity is the Mentor-Mentee System. As part of this, each student who joins the University is assigned a Faculty member who works as the mentor of the student till the student passes out.

The objective of mentoring is to recognize the potential of students and help improve their self-esteem and confidence. One hour is fixed every week for the students to come and meet the mentor, and share his/her problems/difficulties which may be both academic and personal. Each student, under this system, can pace his/her learning.

This system is also the same for the newly us recruited staff/faculty member, wherein a Senior Staff/Faculty Member is nominated to become the mentor of the new joinees to help them familiarize with the environment, duties and activities to be carried out.

### **2. Placement.**

Amity University Madhya Pradesh achieved overall placement of 98.4% for the year 2019 and 92% for the year 2020 (the recruitment process is slightly delayed due to COVID-19 and still continue). The Overall Average Annual package of University has improved in last 2 years from INR. 3.50 Lac to currently INR. 5.40 Lac. Similarly the Highest Annual CTC of the University has gone up by 60% from INR 7.50 Lac in 2019 to INR 12.40 Lac in 2020. Regular recruitment from companies such as Hitachi Consulting, AMAZON, FLIPKART, S&P Global, TCS, ZYCUS, TEK Systems, Asian Paints, Direct I, HDFC Bank, DCB Bank shows the trust and faith of these recruiters in our students and brand. Highest Package offered last year at Campus was 30.20 Lac by Direct i.

### **3. Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).**

The students of AUMP are offered a total of 36 CBCS subjects to choose from apart from the traditional subjects of their syllabus, depending on their interest. The broad area of the CBCS subjects are from Journalism and Mass communication, Management, Advance Engineering, Law, Environment, Languages, Psychology, Fashion Management and Biotechnology. **An app developed by faculty member of AUMP has been exclusively used for allotment of CBCS subjects to the students in a seamless and efficient manner.**

### **4. Amizone.**

The university has a full fledged INTRANET system which is called AMIZONE (AMITY INTRANET ZONE). The system has been built to fully cater to the need of the Academic Institutions. All the aspects like Academics, University Administration, Human Resource Management, Grievance

Redressal, Examination etc are included in AMIZONE. The facility provides the student access to study materials, class presentations, video lectures, library resources and many other learning tools, thus encouraging the beyond class room learning.

#### **5. Examination.**

Conduct of examinations has been streamlined by organizing the same in three groups, reducing the number of examinations by combining exams for value-added courses and subjects having lesser credit points. Error free results are being declared in record time of less than 15 days from the end of examinations.

#### **6. National Services Scheme(NSS).**

Amity University Madhya Pradesh has 02 Units of NSS in its campus comprising of 200 students (100 each in a unit).A total of 139 students of NSS were awarded with 'B' Certificate

#### **7. Student Teacher Ratio.**

The University has been maintaining a very good Student Teachers' Ratio i.e 1:14.

#### **8. UDO (University Duty officer).**

The University has a system of Weekly University Duty Officer (UDO) who is given special tasks by the Vice Chancellor and reports directly to the Vice Chancellor at the end of his/ her weekly term. Surprise checks of administrative installations (to include hostels and mess), academic blocks, security etc. are being carried out.

#### **9. Military Training.**

A 7-day compulsory Military Training Camp is an integral part of the personality development module at Amity. Students get to participate in many activities such as parasailing, trekking, and shooting amongst others which help in testing their mental and physical agility.

#### **10. Foreign Language.**

Amity University Madhya Pradesh provides students an international advantage through their foreign language programmes. Students can opt for one of the many world languages including French, German, Spanish, Japanese and Chinese, according to their proclivity and prospective career focus.

#### **11. Counseling.**

Amity believes that each student should be happy and enjoy his/her stay on the campus. To achieve this goal, trained counselors have been appointed to provide prompt assistance on issues related to health and emotional wellness.

The Counselors address the students' needs through one-on-one counseling. They help the students build confidence, optimism, hope and resilience. The students can seek the services of the Counselors on their own. At times, they are referred to by faculty members when they notice sudden changes in the academic performance of students, withdrawal from others, inexplicable changes in behavior etc.

#### **12. Single Window Clearance System.**

Dean Student Welfare has been given the responsibility of addressing the students' needs/suggestion/grievances through a single window clearance system, wherein students can approach and get the matter resolved promptly through this system.

#### **13. Medical Insurance for students, Staff and Faculty Members.**

All the students & staffs and faculty members of AU MP are covered under the Medical Insurance Scheme and the premium is paid by the University. AUMP has tie-up with four prestigious hospitals named Apollo Spectra Multi Specialties Hospital, BIMR Hospital, Govil Hospital and Kalyan Memorial Hospital in Gwalior where cashless treatment is available to the employees of AUMP.

#### **14. Amity Scholarships.**

The scholarship is given to students who have performed academically well in their qualifying examinations. The scholarship is given at the time of taking the admission in the University and it continues if the student performs equally well as per the laid down criteria of AUMP. The various scholarships offered by AUMP are:

- (a) On admission Scholarship
- (b) Continuation of on admission scholarship
- (c) Merit Scholarship
- (d) Merit cum Means Scholarship

#### **15. Medical Facility (Boys & Girls).**

The medical room is located within the hostel so that the students can easily avail medical care. For emergencies and major medical problems an ambulance is available to ferry the sick to multi specialty hospitals. The University also has a male as well as female Medical Assistant for boys and girls respectively.

#### **16. Facility of add on classes on Soft Skills, Skill Development, Personality Development.**

The Corporate Resource Centre (CRC - Training and Placement Cell) of the University is a crucial interface between the stages of completion of academic program of the students and their entry into suitable employment and plays a pivotal role in counseling and guiding the students for their successful career placement. In addition to campus placements, the CRC department along with Amity System of Communication Enhancement and Transformation (ASCENT) organizes Professional Development Programs like mock interviews, group discussions, pre-placement talks, and interactive sessions with Industry experts, case studies and Personality Development Programs

covering communication skills, presentation skills and career planning. This enables the students to acquire the necessary traits to become industry worthy.

### **17. Entrepreneurship.**

Amity University Madhya Pradesh has established or a Entrepreneurship Development Cell to motivate and train the students and develop an entrepreneurial culture amongst them. The aim of the cell is to motivate the students to take up entrepreneurship and be a job provider rather than a job seeker. The ED Cell of the University has undertaken several Entrepreneurship Development Programs.

### **18. Establishment of Centre of Excellence.**

The university has established following five Centre of Excellence:-

- (a) Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear Mitigation (CBRN).
- (b) Nano-Biotechnology and Alternative Medicine
- (c) Centre for Environmental Conservation & Biodiversity of Madhya Pradesh
- (d) Gwalior as Smart City
- (e) Centre for Detection of Fake News and Disinformation

### **19. Clean & Green Campus.**

The University campus is charismatically clean & green and all efforts are made to make it environmental friendly. Some of the initiatives undertaken by Amity University Madhya Pradesh are Rain Water Harvesting to improve the ground water table, waste sewage water treatment plant etc. There are two sewage water treatment plants with a combined capacity of 3.7 lakh litre water treatment per day. The treated water is used for Horticulture and Toilet Flushing.

With an aim to promote clean and green energy, the University has successfully installed roof top solar panels in its 03 Academic Blocks with a total capacity of 307 KW.

### **20. Connectivity.**

The whole campus is 24X7 WiFi enabled with bandwidth of 300 mbps and student can access internet from anywhere whether in classrooms or at hostels. The supply of electricity is 24X7 and the campus has got a total of 04 electricity generator of 750 KVA and 01 of 250 KVA to meet electricity requirement in case of a power failure.

## **Best Practices Followed by the University During Lockdown**

### **(Optimal Operations and Effectiveness of Online Classes at AUMP in the Lockdown Scenario)**

In view of Government orders, all Higher Education Institutions were during closed the lockdown with effect from 16<sup>th</sup> March 2020 till further orders, as a precautionary measure against COVID-19. During such crucial period following best practices are being followed at AUMP to overcome the situation so that the students' academic progression was not hampered.

Amity University Madhya Pradesh is committed to extend its services to the learners through various modes by actively engaging them to ensure the effective progression in their respective courses and timely completion of their syllabus in online mode.

Apart from this the University has also evolved an effective campus management for administration using online tools, monitoring and daily reporting system.

**The practices followed at Amity University Madhya Pradesh are as follows:**

### **Teaching Learning Methodologies**

1. The Online Classes are being ensured for students of all the courses through Microsoft Team as per the time table and attendance is being marked on AMIZONE on daily basis by the respective faculty members. The Microsoft Team app is extensively used by the faculty member of the University for Online teaching, sharing assignment, quizzes, assessment etc. Overall the feedback of online classes has been very positive.
2. Daily reporting of online classes, progress, sharing and resolving the difficulties is being done by the respective HoI, Dean Academics, Pro-Vice Chancellor and Vice Chancellor, through online meetings, telecon, WhatsApp messaging and through vide email.
3. In case of any class being not engaged by the faculty member online, it is reported to the respective HoIs who is responsible to effectively engage the class or sort out the technical issue faced by the faculty member. The IT team remains on stand by for resolving any technical issue arising during the Online Classes.
4. The Office of the Pro-Vice Chancellor compiles the daily CDC data received from various institutions which is uploaded on the CDC portal by the Office of the Registrar for perusal of Head Office.
5. Respective HoIs, Dean Academics, Pro-Vice Chancellor and Vice Chancellor are added in the participants list of every class and meeting schedules, so that they can monitor the class in real time.
6. The power point presentation, reference materials, assignment and quizzes are uploaded on AMIZONE/Learning and Management System before class, so that the student can go through the same and clear their doubt during the online class.
7. The faculty members have been told to complete their internal evaluation online and report of completion is to be submitted by the HoI by 10<sup>th</sup>April, 2020.

## **General & Campus Management System**

1. All the faculty members and majority of non teaching staff members have been asked to work from home in this scenario and remain active on phone, WhatsApp, email and respond to any query, observation, suggestion at the earliest but no later than 24 hours in case of email and 60 minutes in case of call and WhatsApp on its receipt.
2. The necessary information / advisories and protocol to be followed are regularly posted through various modes by the Vice Chancellor / Pro-Vice Chancellor / Registrar / Dy Director HR, to keep the faculty and staff members updated and well versed with the situation.
3. Functioning of the essential staff in campus has been to a reduced in great extend. However, minimum required essential staff, to include Catering staff, Security staff, Housekeeping staff, Nursing staff, Facilities staff (to ensure continuous provision of essential services like electricity, running water etc.) have been asked to be available on campus and mark attendance regularly (through ID card/ Biometric Scanners/ Attendance Registers). In case the prevailing situation restricts the movement, the aforementioned essential staff shall be accommodated on campus.
4. Most of the students have left the hostel, however the hostellers staying in the campus are updated with the prevailing scenario and instructed timely to take necessary precautionary measures. Issue of out pass to the student has been stopped and outside movement / meeting prohibited.
5. Staff and faculty members residing in the campus are not allowed to go out until the lockdown period as a precautionary measure. No residents of hostel are allowed who have come from outside.
6. Any person coming from outside for maintenance is screened and allowed entry only after found fit.
7. A review online meeting with Pro VC, Dy Pro VC, Deans, Registrar, all HoIs and HoD chaired by Vice Chancellor through Microsoft Team is conducted daily at 1715 hrs. Necessary instructions for further action by the concerned are also given by the Vice Chancellor during the review meeting, so that the functioning of AUMP remain smooth.
8. The classes are held online and being monitored regularly. AUMP uses blended learning and ICT based teaching learning methods.
9. As per the Govt order the End Semester Examinations are being conducted through Open Book Examinations (OBE) method.
10. As per Govt order, dispensation has been given to the students for attendance.
11. Tele counseling cell to counsel the students, faculty and staff members has been formulated at Institute and Central Level
12. 'Remain in Touch' campaign run by Mentors/Class Coordinators/Programme Coordinators.
13. Daily monitoring of active/recovered COVID positive cases of faculty, staff and their family members.
14. A kind initiative has been taken by Hon'ble Chancellor to procure a few Oxygen Concentrators for the campus.
